## Which CPAP masks are compatible with DreamStation Go?

All CPAP masks are compatible with DreamStation Go. It gives you the freedom to choose the mask you want.<sup>1</sup>



## Does size matter?

Of course. But finding the right balance of size and durability is important. Small things can be less durable over time, leading to reliability and noise issues down the road.



## Does DreamStation Go have any unique travel features to help improve my travel experience?

DreamStation Go is the only travel CPAP with an integrated USB port that allows for easy charging of mobile devices.<sup>4</sup> And, it comes with a 12 mm micro-flexible tubing, which is our smallest and lightest tubing ever.



## Does DreamStation Go offer humidification?

DreamStation Go's optional heated humidifier uses tap, bottled or distilled water,<sup>2</sup> so you don't have the inconvenience of packing or purchasing distilled water when you arrive at your destination.



## Is DreamStation Go HSA and FSA eligible?

Payments for CPAP devices and masks are qualifying expenses for HSAs and FSAs.<sup>3</sup> Patients should consult their specific plan for eligibility.



## Does DreamStation Go have an optional overnight battery option to allow me to travel to places without power?

Yes. DreamStation Go has its own battery option. DreamStation Go's optional overnight battery can help you stay committed to your therapy when you are off the grid. DreamStation Go, set at 10 cm of pressure, displayed an average run time of 13 hours<sup>5</sup> when running with the DreamStation Go overnight battery. Be careful — not all Travel CPAPs have their own, modular battery option.
