2 Getting started

Installing the filter

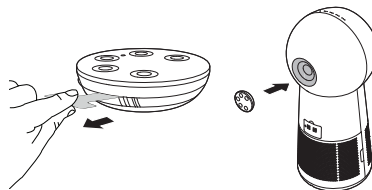
Note: Make sure the appliance is unplugged from the electrical outlet before installing the filter.

The air quality does not improve even though the appliance has been operating for a long time.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check whether the packing material is removed from the filter. • Check whether the filter is installed in the appliance. • Clean the sensor cover surface with mop or vacuum cleanser; Do not open sensor cover or touch inside. • Room size is too large, or the outdoor air quality is poor. For optimum purification performance, close the doors and windows when operating the appliance. • There are indoor pollution sources. Examples include cigarette smoke, cooking fumes, incense, perfume and alcohol. • Filter has reached end of life. Replace the filter with a new one.
The appliance produces a strange smell.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The first few times you use the appliance, it may produce a plastic smell. This is normal. • If the appliance produces a burning smell, immediately unplug it and turn it upside down to check whether any foreign objects have fallen into the appliance.
