


Important safety information

Read this important information carefully before you use the appliance and its accessories and save it for future reference. The accessories supplied may vary for different products.

Danger



- Keep the supply unit dry.

Warning

- To charge the battery, only use the detachable supply unit (HQ8505) provided with the appliance.
- The supply unit contains a transformer. Do not cut off the supply unit to replace it with another plug, as this causes a hazardous situation.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Always unplug the shaver before you clean it under the tap.
- Always check the appliance before you use it.
 Do not use the appliance if it is damaged, as this may cause injury. Always replace a damaged part with one of the original type.
- This appliance contains batteries that are nonreplaceable.
- Do not open the appliance to replace the rechargeable battery.

Caution

- Never use water hotter than 60°C to rinse the shaver
- Only use this appliance for its intended purpose as shown in the user manual.
- For hygienic reasons, the appliance should only be used by one person.
- Never use compressed air, scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents or aggressive liquids such as petrol or acetone to clean the appliance.
- If your shaver comes with a cleaning system, always use the original Philips cleaning fluid (cartridge or bottle, depending on the type of cleaning system).
- Water may drip from the socket at the bottom of the shaver when you rinse it. This is normal and not dangerous because all electronics are enclosed in a sealed power unit inside the shaver.
- Do not use the supply unit in or near wall sockets that contain an electric air freshener to prevent irreparable damage to the supply unit.

Electromagnetic fields (EMF)

This Philips appliance complies with all applicable standards and regulations regarding exposure to electromagnetic fields.

General



- This shaver is waterproof. It is suitable for use in the bath or shower and for cleaning under the tap. For safety reasons, the shaver can therefore only be used without cord.
- The supply unit is suitable for mains voltages ranging from 100 to 240 volts.
- The supply unit transforms 100-240 volts to a safe low voltage of less than 24 volts.

The display

Note: Remove any sticker or protective foil from the display before using the product.

Start-up sequence



When you press the on/off button for the very first time, all display indications light up in sequence.

The shaver now contains enough energy for one shave

Charging

Quick charge: When the battery is empty and you connect the shaver to the wall socket, the lights of the battery charge indicator light up red one after the other repeatedly. When the battery contains enough energy for one shave, the bottom light of the battery charge indicator starts flashing red slowly.



While the shaver continues to charge, first the bottom light of the battery charge indicator flashes red and then lights up red continuously. Then the second light flashes and lights up continuously, and so on until the shaver is fully charged.

Battery fully charged



Note: This shaver can only be used without a cord.

When the battery is fully charged, all lights of the battery charge indicator light up red continuously.

Note: When you press the on/off button during or after charging, you hear a sound to indicate that the shaver is still connected to the wall socket.

Note: When the battery is full, the display switches off automatically after 30 minutes.

Battery low



When the battery is almost empty, the bottom light of the battery charge indicator flashes red.

Remaining battery charge



The remaining battery charge is shown by the lights of the battery charge indicator that light up continuously.

Personal comfort settings



The shaver has a feature that allows you to personalize your settings. Depending on your personal shaving needs, choose between three settings, from low to high: comfort, dynamic or efficiency. When you press the button on the left or right of the display, the segment of the personal comfort settings bar that lights up shows the currently selected setting. To select a lower or higher setting, press the button on the left or right of the display.

Cleaning reminder



Clean the shaver after every use for optimal performance (see 'Cleaning and maintenance'). When you switch off the shaver, the cleaning reminder flashes to remind you to clean the shaver.

Travel lock



You can lock the shaver when you are going to travel. The travel lock prevents the shaver from being switched on by accident.

Replacement reminder



For maximum shaving performance, replace the shaving heads every two years. The shaver is equipped with a replacement reminder which reminds you to replace the shaving heads. The replacement reminder lights up and the arrows flash to indicate that you have to replace the shaving heads.

Note: After replacing the shaving heads, you can reset the replacement reminder by pressing the on/off button for 7 seconds. If you do not reset the replacement reminder, the shaver resets automatically after 9 shaves.

Notification symbol

Overheating



If the shaver overheats during charging, the notification symbol flashes. When this happens, the shaver switches off automatically. Charging continues once the temperature of the shaver has decreased to the normal level.



Blocked shaving heads

If the shaving heads are blocked, the notification symbol flashes and the shaver beeps. Clean the shaver thoroughly before you continue to shave (see 'Cleaning the shaver under the tap'). After cleaning, if the notification symbol flashes and the shaver beeps, immediately replace the shaving heads

Charging


Charge the shaver before you use it for the first time and when the display indicates that the battery is almost empty.

Charging takes approx. 1 hour. A fully charged shaver has a shaving time of up to 60 minutes.

Note: You cannot use the shaver while it is charging.

Charging with the supply unit

- Make sure the shaver is switched off.
- 2 Put the small plug in the shaver and put the supply unit in the wall socket.
 - The display of the shaver indicates that the shaver is charging.
- **3** After charging, remove the supply unit from the wall socket and pull the small plug out of the shaver



Always check the shaver and all accessories before use. Do not use the shaver or any accessory if it is damaged, as this may cause injury. Always replace a damaged part with one of the original type.





This symbol indicates that the shaver can be used in the bath or shower.

- Use this shaver for its intended household use as described in this manual.
- For hygienic reasons, the shaver should only be used by one person.

Note: This shaver is waterproof. It is suitable for use in the bath or shower and for cleaning under the tap. For safety reasons, the shaver can only be used without cord.

Switching the shaver on and off



1 To switch on the shaver, press the on/off button once.

The battery charge indicator lights up for a few seconds and the notification symbol flashes.

2 To switch off the shaver, press the on/off button once.

The battery charge indicator lights up for a few seconds and shows the remaining battery charge.

Shaving

Skin adaptation period

Your first shaves may not bring you the result you expect and your skin may even become slightly irritated. This is normal. Your skin and beard need time to adapt to any new shaving system. To allow your skin to adapt to this new appliance, we advise you to shave regularly (at least 3 times a week) and exclusively with this appliance for a period of 3 weeks.

Shaving tips

- For the best results on skin comfort, pre-trim your beard if you have not shaved for 3 days or longer.
- Select your personal comfort setting.

Dry shaving

- 1 Switch on the shaver.
- 2 Move the shaving heads over your skin in circular movements to catch all hairs growing in different directions. Make sure each shaving head is fully in contact with the skin. Exert gentle pressure for a close, comfortable shave.
 - Note: Do not press too hard, as this can cause skin irritation.
- **3** Switch off and clean the shaver after each use (see 'Cleaning and maintenance').
 - The display lights up for a few seconds to show the battery status.

Wet shaving

For a more comfortable shave, you can also use this shaver on a wet face with shaving foam or shaving gel.

1 Apply some water to your skin.



2 Apply shaving foam or shaving gel to your skin.





- **3** Rinse the shaving unit under the tap to ensure that the shaving unit glides smoothly over your skin.
- 4 Switch on the shaver.
- **5** Move the shaving heads over your skin in circular movements to catch all hairs growing in different directions. Make sure each shaving head is fully in contact with the skin. Exert gentle pressure for a close, comfortable shave.

Note: Do not press too hard, this can cause skin irritation.

Note: Rinse the shaving unit regularly to ensure that it continues to glide smoothly over your skin.

- 6 Dry your face.
- **7** Switch off the shaver and clean it after each use.

Note: Make sure that you rinse all foam or shaving gel off the shaver.

Using click-on attachments

Removing or attaching the click-on attachment

- 1 Make sure the shaver is switched off.
- 2 Pull the attachment straight off the shaver.
 Note: Do not twist the attachment while you pull it off the shaver.





3 Insert the lug of the attachment into the slot in the top of the shaver. Then press down the attachment to attach it to the shaver ('click').

Using the cleansing brush attachment

Note: For better shaving results, use the click-on cleansing brush attachment before shaving.

Use the rotating cleansing brush with your daily cleansing cream. The cleansing brush removes oil and dirt, contributing to a healthy and oil-free skin. We advise you to use it no more than twice a day.

Do not use the appliance on damaged or irritated skin or on wounds.

- 1 Place the attachment on the attachment holder
- **2** Attach the attachment to the appliance ('click').



3 Moisten the attachment with water.

Note: Do not use the appliance with a dry cleansing brush attachment, as this can irritate the skin.



- **4** Moisten your face with water and apply a cleanser to your face.
- **5** Place the attachment on your cheek.
- **6** Switch on the appliance.





7 Gently move the brush across your skin from the nose towards the ear. Do not push the brush too hard onto the skin to make sure that the treatment remains comfortable.

Note: Do not cleanse the sensitive area around your eyes.



8 After approx. 20 seconds, move the appliance to your other cheek and start cleansing this part of your face.



9 After approx. 20 seconds, move the appliance to your forehead and start cleansing this part of your face. Gently move the brush head from left to right.

Note: We advise you to not overdo the cleansing and to not cleanse any zone longer than 20 seconds.





11 After the treatment, rinse and dry your face. Your face is now ready for the next step of your daily skincare routine.

Travel lock

You can lock the shaver when you are going to travel to prevent it from switching on accidentally.

Activating the travel lock



1 Press the on/off button for 3 seconds to use the travel lock mode.



2 While you activate the travel lock, the indications on the display light up briefly and the shaver produces a short sound. When the travel lock is activated, the travel lock symbol flashes

Deactivating the travel lock



- 1 Press the on/off button for 3 seconds.
 - While you deactivate the travel lock, the indications on the display light up briefly. When the travel lock is deactivated, the travel lock symbol flashes and the shaver switches on. The shaver is now ready for use again.

Note: The shaver unlocks automatically when it is connected to wall socket.

Cleaning and maintenance

Regular cleaning guarantees better shaving results.

Never clean, remove or replace the shaving unit while the shaver is switched on.

Do not apply pressure to shaving head combs.

Do not touch shaving heads with hard objects as this may dent or damage the precision-made slotted combs.

Do not use abrasives, scourers or aggressive liquids such as gasoline or acetone to clean the shaver.

Cleaning the shaver under the tap

Clean the shaver after every shave for optimal performance.

Always check if the water is too hot, to prevent burning your hands.

Never dry the shaving unit with a towel or tissue, as this may damage the shaving heads.

While rinsing the shaving unit, water may drip out of the base of shaver. This is a normal occurrence.

- 1 Switch on the shaver.
- 2 Rinse the shaving unit under a warm tap.



3 Switch off the shaver. Pull the shaving head holder off the bottom part of the shaving unit.

4 Rinse the hair chamber under the tap.



- **5** Rinse the shaving head holder under a warm tap.
- **6** Carefully shake off excess water and let the shaving head holder air-dry completely.



7 Attach the shaving head holder to the bottom part of the shaving unit ('click').

Thorough cleaning

We advise you to clean the shaving heads thoroughly once a month or when the shaver does not shave as well as it used to.



Note: The shaving heads are locked by a blue or an orange retaining ring.



Follow the correct instructions

1 Switch off the shaver.



2 Pull the shaving head holder off the bottom part of the shaving unit.



3 Rinse the hair chamber and shaving head holder under the tap.



4 Turn the retaining ring anticlockwise and lift it off the shaving head.



Repeat this process for the other retaining rings. Place them aside in a safe place.



5 Remove the shaving heads from the shaving head holder. Each shaving head consists of a cutter and guard.

Note: Do not clean more than one cutter and guard at a time, since they are all matching sets. If you accidentally put a cutter in the wrong shaving guard, it may take several weeks before optimal shaving performance is restored.



- 6 Clean the cutter and guard under the tap.
- 7 Shake off excess water.
- 8 Put the cutter back into the guard.



9 Place the shaving heads in the shaving head holder

Note: Make sure the notches on both sides of the shaving heads fit exactly onto the projections in the shaving head holder.



10 Blue retaining ring: Place the retaining ring on the shaving head and turn it clockwise to reattach the retaining ring.



Place the arrows on the ring in line with the projections in the shaving head holder. Turn the ring clockwise until it clicks to indicate that the ring is fixed.



 Orange retaining ring: Place the retaining ring on the shaving head and turn it clockwise to reattach the retaining ring. Repeat this process for the other retaining rings.



Each retaining ring has two recesses that fit exactly into the projections of the shaving head holder. Turn the ring clockwise until your hear a click to indicate that the ring is fixed.

Hold the shaving head holder in your hand when you reinsert the shaving heads and reattach the retaining rings. Do not place the shaving head holder on a surface when you do this, as this may cause damage.

11 Attach the shaving head holder to the bottom part of the shaving unit ('click').

Cleaning the cleansing brush attachment

Clean the cleansing brush attachment after each use.

1 Switch off the appliance.



- 2 Detach the brush head from the attachment holder
- **3** Clean the parts thoroughly with warm water and soap.
- **4** Dry the cleansing brush attachment with a towel.

Replacement

Replacing the shaving heads

For maximum shaving performance, we advise you to replace the shaving heads every two years. Replace damaged shaving heads immediately.



Always replace the shaving heads with original Philips shaving heads (see 'Ordering accessories').

Replacement reminder



The replacement reminder indicates that the shaving heads need to be replaced. The replacement reminder lights up and the arrows flash when you switch off the shaver.



1 To replace the shaving heads, remove the shaving heads from the shaving head holder one by one. See 'Thorough Cleaning' for the instructions on how to remove the retaining rings and shaving heads.

Note: The shaving heads are locked by a blue or an orange retaining ring. Follow the correct instructions.



2 To reset the replacement reminder, press and hold the on/off button for approx. 7 seconds.

Storage



Store the shaver in the pouch.

Note: Always let the shaver dry completely before you store it in the pouch.



Put the protection cap on the cleansing brush attachment to protect it from dirt accumulation.

Take any necessary safety precautions when you handle tools to open the shaver and when you dispose of the rechargeable battery.

Be careful, the battery strips are sharp.

- Insert the screwdriver into the slot between the front and back panel in the bottom of the appliance. Remove the back panel.
- 2 Remove the front panel.
- **3** Unscrew the two screws at the top of the inner panel and remove the inner panel.
- 4 Bend aside the battery lips, which hold the battery, by placing a screwdriver between the battery and the lips.
- **5** Remove the battery.






