

Put It To The Test

Like many new products, your Philips Norelco Hair Clipper may take a little getting used to. If you are using an electric Clipper for the first time, or if you've been using a different brand, take the time to acquaint yourself with your new Hair Clipper.

Your Hair Clipper features an extra strong motor and stainless steel cutter blades to comfortably clip even the toughest hair.

Throw your scissors away and put your new Hair Clipper to the test. We guarantee precise, professional results or Philips Norelco will refund you the full purchase price as long as the request is received within 45 days of purchase.

To Charge/Recharge

- Fully charge Clipper before using for the first time or after non-use for a long period of time.
- Charging, recharging, or using Clipper at temperatures below 40°F or higher than 95°F adversely affects lifespan of the battery.
 Do not charge/recharge or use Clipper corded
- 1 Be certain Clipper is OFF.

until fully dry.

- Insert the appliance plug directly into the Clipper and plug the adapter into any 120VAC outlet (fig 1). Use only the cord provided.
- The Charging Light on the appliance will blink green to indicate the Clipper is charging (fig. 2).
- It will take approximately 1 hour to fully charge the Clipper for a cordless clipping time of up to 60 minutes.
- 4 When the battery is fully charged, the Charging Light lights up green continuously. NOTE: After 30 minutes the Charging Light goes out to save energy.
- Disconnect the cord and unplug from electrical outlet.

Corded Hair Clipping

- Clipper does not recharge during corded clipping.
- 1 Connect cord provided to clipper and plug clipper into electrical outlet (fig. 1).
- 2 If battery is completely empty, wait a few minutes before switching clipper ON.
- 3 Slide ON/OFF switch ON to begin clipping.
- 4 Turn clipper OFF and unplug.

Cordless Hair Clipping 1 Charge according to directions. Unplug

- Clipper from outlet and remove cord.

 2 Slide ON/OFF switch ON to begin clipping.
- Is slide ON/OFF switch ON to begin clipping.
- If the charge runs low while clipping, the green Charging Light will turn orange.
- 4 If the charge runs out while clipping, connect cord provided to Clipper and outlet. Wait a few seconds and then turn Clipper ON to continue clipping.

Hair Clipping Use this Clipper for

- Use this Clipper for its intended household use as described in this manual.
 Make sure that the appliance is fully charged
- Make sure that the appliance is fully charged before you start clipping hair.
- Before you start clipping, make sure that the head of the person whose hair you are cutting is at the same level as your chest so that all parts of his/her head are clearly visible and
- within easy reach.
 Only use the appliance on clean, dry hair.
 Do not use on freshly washed hair.
 Before you begin, comb the hair in the direction of growth (fig. 3).
 To achieve optimal clipping results, always move the appliance slowly through the hair against the direction of hair growth.

Clipping with small or large comb

- 1 Be certain the Clipper is in the OFF position.
- 2 Select the comb attachment. The table shows the remaining hair length after clipping at the
- different settings of the small or large comb.

 3 Slide the selected comb into the guiding
- 3 Slide the selected comb into the guiding grooves on both sides of Clipper and push until you hear it 'click' into place (fig. 4).
- 4 Turn the Zoom Wheel Hair Length Setting Selector to the desired setting (fig. 5). See Table 1 for settings.

 —The small comb cuts hair to a length of
 - 1/8in/3mm to 55/64in/22mm -The large comb cuts hair to a length of 7/8in/23mm to 1 23/32in/42mm
- The selected setting number will appear on the display on the Clipper.

 When you are clipping for the first time, start at
- the maximum clipping length setting (55/64in/22mm using small comb or I 23/32in/42mm using large comb) to familiarize yourself with the appliance and prevent accidentally trimming hairs too short. As you become familiar with the settings, adjust the Zoom Wheel Hair Length Setting Selector to desired trimming length.
- NOTE: The display automatically lights up when attaching a comb or by turning the Zoom Wheel Hair Length Setting Selector (Fig. 6).

- 6 Make sure that the flat part of the comb is always in full contact with the scalp to obtain an even result (fig. 7).

Make overlapping passes over the head to ensure that all hair that should be cut has been cut.

Tor best results with curly, sparse or long

hair, use a styling comb to guide the hair towards the Clipper.III Turn the Clipper off regularly during clipping

and remove the hair comb to blow and/or shake out hair that has accumulated.

TIP: Write down the settings you have used to create a certain hairstyle as a reminder for future clipping sessions.

Contouring without a comb

- Use the Clipper without a comb to clip hair very close to the skin (3/64 in./1mm) or to contour the neckline and area around the ears.
- 1 Remove the hair comb by pulling it off the Clipper (fig. 9).
- Be careful when you are clipping without combattachment as when the Clipper is turned on it will remove every hair it touches.
- 2 To contour the hairline around the ears, comb the hair ends over the ears.
- 3 Tilt the Clipper in such a way that only one edge of the cutter blades touches the hair ends when you shape the contours around the ears (fig. 10).

 4 To contour the nape of the neck or sideburns, turn the Clipper and hold it with
- the cutter blades pointing downwards (fig. 11).

 5 Move the Clipper slowly and smoothly

Cleaning

During Use:

▶ If cut hairs have accumulated in the comb area, remove hairs by shaking, blowing or using cleaning brush provided. Remember to adjust the clipping length back to your selected setting when you replace the comb on Clipper.

After Each Use:

- 1 Make sure the Clipper is switched OFF and disconnected from the electrical outlet.
- 2 Remove any comb and rinse it under warm water.
- Water.

 3 Push the center top end of the cutter
- 3 Push the center top end of the cutter blade upwards with your thumb until it opens (fig. 12).
- 4 Clean the appliance under warm water to remove the cut hair that has accumulated in the clipping attachment (fig. 13).
- Let the appliance and clipping attachment air dry completely.
- This Clipper has no other user-serviceable parts.

Storage

be cut or damaged. Do not place or store Clipper where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink, water

or other liquid while plugged in. Battery Removal This Philips Norelco Clipper contains a

rechargeable Lithium-Ion battery which must be disposed of properly (fig. 14). Battery may only be removed when Clipper is to be discarded.

4 Remove any comb and clipping attachment

from the handle.

Check if there are any screws in the back or front of the appliance. If so, remove them.

6 Remove the back and/or front panel of the appliance with a screwdriver. If necessary, also remove additional screws and/or parts until you see the printed circuit board with

the rechargeable batteries. If necessary, cut the wires to separate the printed circuit board and the rechargeable

batteries from the appliance. Be careful, the battery strips and housing parts are very sharp.

8 Do not attempt to replace battery. Insulate battery ends by covering with tape and/or place battery in a small plastic bag.

9 Discard your Clipper. Do not attempt to plug electrical cord into the outlet or
