IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using an electrical appliance, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

Read all instructions before using this appliance.

DANGER

To reduce the risk of electric shock:

- Do not reach for a corded Trimmer that has fallen into water. Unplug immediately.
- Use Trimmer only in a dry condition. Do not use while bathing or in a shower.
- Do not place or store Trimmer where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink. Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid
- Always unplug this Trimmer from the electrical outlet immediately after (re)charging.
- Unplug and remove power supply cord from Trimmer before cleaning.

WARNING

To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock or injury to persons:

- Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children or invalids.
- Use this Trimmer for its intended household use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by Philips Electronics North America Corporation.
- Never operate this Trimmer if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped, damaged, or dropped into water. For assistance call 1-800-243-3050.
- Keep the Trimmer, cord, charging plug and any attachments away from heated surfaces.
- 5. Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- Do not use the adapter in or near a power outlet that contains an electric air freshener to prevent damage to the adapter.
- Do not operate, charge, clean or plug in Trimmer outdoors or where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- Always check cutters, cutting unit and combs before using the Trimmer. Do not use the Trimmer if cutters, cutting unit and combs are damaged, as injury may occur.
- Always attach plug to Trimmer first, then to outlet. To disconnect, turn on/off switch to "OFF" position, then remove plug from outlet.
- Only use the cord provided. To prevent possible damage to the cord, do not wrap cord around the Trimmer.
- 11. Never put Trimmer in direct sunlight or store at a temperature above 140°F (60°C).
- 12. Never immerse the Trimmer in water or rinse under the tap.
- 13. This Trimmer is for use on human hair only. Do not use this Trimmer for any other purpose.
- 14. Always store your Trimmer, attachments and power plug in a moisture-free area. Make sure the cord is disconnected from the Trimmer.
- 15. Only use the power plug supplied with the appliance.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: The power plug contains a transformer. Do not cut off the power plug to replace it with another plug as this will cause a hazardous condition.

To Charge/Recharge


- ▶ Fully charge Trimmer before using for the first time or after non-use for a long period of time.
- Charging, recharging or using Trimmer at temperatures below 40°F (4°C) or higher than 95°F (35°C) adversely affects lifespan of the battery.
- ▶ Continuously recharging Trimmer will reduce lifespan of battery.
- 1 Be certain Trimmer is OFF (fig. 1).
- Connect appliance plug directly into the Trimmer and plug adapter into any 120V AC outlet (fig. 2). Use only the cord provided.
- An adaptor plug may be necessary for cord usage in some foreign countries. Use an attachment plug adaptor of the proper configuration for power outlet.
- The charging light lights up to indicate the Trimmer is charging (fig. 3).
- It will take approximately 10 hours to fully charge the Trimmer for a cordless trimming time of up to 45 minutes (BT1300/BT1200) or 30 minutes (BT1100).
- 4 Disconnect the cord and unplug from electrical outlet.

Optimize the working life of the battery

- After the Trimmer has been charged for the first time, do not recharge the Trimmer between trimming sessions. Continue using it until the battery is completely empty.
- Do not charge for more than 24 hours.
- Do not keep cord permanently plugged in.
- Discharge/run down the battery completely twice a year by letting the motor run until it stops.
 If the Trimmer hasn't been used for a long period of time it must be
- If the Trimmer hasn't been used for a long period of time, it must be recharged for a full 8 hours.

Cordless Trimming

- Use this Trimmer for its intended household use as described in this manual.
- Always comb the beard and/or moustache with a fine comb before you start trimming.
- ▶ If you are trimming for the first time, be careful. Do not move the Trimmer too fast. Make smooth and gentle movements.
- Make sure that the Trimmer is fully charged before you start trimming.

- 1 Charge according to directions. Unplug Trimmer from outlet and remove cord.
 - 2 Slide ON/OFF switch ON to begin trimming.
- 3 When finished, turn Trimmer OFF.

Trimming with a Comb

- ▶ The fixed combs have 3 lengths that are indicated on each comb.
- The adjustable comb has 5 hair length settings from 1/8–9/32 in./ 3–7mm in steps of 3/64 in./1mm.
- ▶ The indications on the combs correspond to the remaining hair length after trimming.
- 1 Be certain Trimmer is OFF (fig. 1).
- 2 Slide the comb onto the cutting element by pressing down until it is fixed into place (fig. 4).

NOTE: When you slide the adjustable comb all the way down, you have selected the 1/8 in./3mm setting. Push the comb up to select another length setting. Each click is a step of 3/64 in./1mm.

- ▶ If you are trimming for the first time, start by using the comb at the maximum trimming length setting to prevent accidentally trimming hairs too short.
- 3 Switch the Trimmer ON (fig. 5).
- 4 To trim in the most effective way, move the Trimmer upwards against the direction of hair growth. Make sure the surface of the comb always stays in contact with the skin (fig. 6).

Trimming Without a Comb

Remove comb if you are:

- Defining hair lines
- ▶ Trimming nape of neck
- Removing single, unwanted hairs
- 1 Be certain the Trimmer is OFF (fig. 1).
- 2 Push the back of the comb upwards until the comb slides off the Trimmer (fig. 7).
- 3 Switch the Trimmer ON (fig. 5).
- 4 Make well-controlled movements. Touch the hair/skin lightly with the Trimmer.

-For a comfortable trim close to your skin, place the flat side of the trimming head against your skin and make strokes against the direction of hair

-For contouring, hold the cutting element perpendicular to your skin and move the Trimmer upwards or downwards with gentle pressure (fig. 9).

Be careful when you are trimming without the comb as when the Trimmer is turned on it will trim every hair it touches.

Styling/Contouring with Detail Trimmer (BT1300)

- Use the detail trimmer to contour or style your beard, moustache, sideburns or neckline to a length of 1/32 in./0.5mm
- The detail trimmer gives you more precise detailing of sideburns and areas around the mouth and nose.
- 1 Remove the cutting element from the handle by gently pushing the teeth of the cutting element upwards until it releases (fig. 10).
- 2 Attach the detail trimmer onto the appliance making sure the projection on the back of the detail trimmer fits exactly into the recesses in the hair chamber (fig. 11).
- 3 Switch the Trimmer ON (fig. 5).
- 4 Make careful and controlled movements while touching hair lightly (fig. 12).

Cleaning

- ▶ Clean the Trimmer after each use.
- Always switch Trimmer OFF, unplug and remove power supply cord from Trimmer before cleaning.
- Never immerse the Trimmer in water or rinse under the tap.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents, scourers or aggressive liquids such as alcohol, gasoline, or acetone to clean the Trimmer and
- Never clean, replace or remove Trimmer comb with motor ON.
- Do not apply pressure to cutters.
- Do not touch cutters with hard objects as this may damage them.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean Trimmer handle.

After Each Use:

For optimal trimming performance, clean and lubricate the cutting element after each use.

- 1 Make sure the Trimmer is switched OFF and disconnected from the electrical outlet.
- 2 Remove the trimming comb and clean with the brush (fig. 13).
- 3 Remove the cutting element from the handle by gently pushing the teeth of the cutting element upwards until it releases (fig. 10).
- 4 Clean the cutting element with the cleaning brush (fig. 14).
- 5 Clean the hair chamber with the cleaning brush (fig. 15).
- 6 Push the cutting element back into place making sure the projection on the back of the cutting element fits exactly into the recesses in the hair chamber (fig. 16).
- 7 For optimal trimming performance, lubricate the cutting element teeth with a drop of the oil supplied every 6 weeks (fig. 17).

- ▶ Be sure Trimmer is turned OFF. Remove cord from outlet and Trimmer before storing in a safe, dry location where it will not be crushed, banged, or subject to damage.
- Do not wrap cord around Trimmer when storing.
- Store cord in a safe location where it will not be cut or damaged.
- Do not place or store Trimmer where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink, water or other liquid.
