

Danger

- Keep the adapter dry.

Warning

- The adapter contains a transformer. Do not cut off the adapter to replace it with another plug, as this causes a hazardous situation.





Charging

Battery charge indicator





 If you leave the appliance connected to the mains, the charging process continues. To indicate that the appliance is charging, the battery charge indicator flashes slowly.

Battery fully charged



Note: You can also use this appliance directly from the mains.

Note: When the battery is full, the display switches off automatically after 30 minutes.

 When the battery is fully charged, the light of the battery charge indicator lights up continuously.

Battery low



 When the battery is almost empty, the battery charge indicator flashes orange.





Activating the travel lock

Replacing shaving heads



For maximum shaving performance, we advise you to replace the shaving heads every two years.

 The appliance is equipped with a replacement reminder (S5130/04, S5110/04, S5013/04 only) which reminds you to replace the shaving heads. The replacement reminder lights up white continuously.

Note: After replacing the shaving heads, you need to reset the replacement reminder by pressing the on/off button for 7 seconds.

Charging


Skin adaptation period

Your first shaves may not bring you the result you expect and your skin may even become slightly irritated. This is normal. Your skin and beard need time to adapt to any new shaving system. We advise you to shave regularly (at least 3 times a week) with this shaver for a period of 3 weeks to allow your skin to adapt to the new shaver.

Note: You can also use the shaver directly from the mains.

- 1 Switch on the appliance.
- 2 Move the shaving heads over your skin in circular movements.

Note: Do not make straight movements.





Using the click-on attachments

Removing or attaching the click-on attachments


