Danger



- Keep the supply unit dry.

Warning

 To charge the battery, only use the detachable supply unit (HQ80) provided with the appliance.

- The supply unit contains a transformer. Do not cut off the supply unit to replace it with another plug, as this causes a hazardous situation.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- Always unplug the shaver before you clean it under the tap.
- Always check the appliance before you use it.
 Do not use the appliance if it is damaged, as this may cause injury. Always replace a damaged part with one of the original type.
- Do not open the appliance to replace the rechargeable battery.

Caution



- Never immerse the cleaning system or the charging stand in water and do not rinse it under the tap.
- Never use water hotter than 60°C to rinse the shaver.
- Only use this appliance for its intended purpose as shown in the user manual.
- For hygienic reasons, the appliance should only be used by one person.
- Never use compressed air, scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents or aggressive liquids such as petrol or acetone to clean the appliance.

- If your shaver comes with a cleaning system, always use the original Philips cleaning fluid (cartridge or bottle, depending on the type of cleaning system).
- Always place the cleaning system on a stable, level and horizontal surface to prevent leakage.
- If your cleaning system uses a cleaning cartridge, always make sure the cartridge compartment is closed before you use the cleaning system to clean or charge the shaver.
- When the cleaning system is ready for use, do not move it to prevent leakage of cleaning fluid.
- Water may drip from the socket at the bottom of the shaver when you rinse it. This is normal and not dangerous because all electronics are enclosed in a sealed power unit inside the shaver.
- Do not use the supply unit in or near wall sockets that contain an electric air freshener to prevent irreparable damage to the supply unit.

Electromagnetic fields (EMF)

 This Philips appliance complies with all applicable standards and regulations regarding exposure to electromagnetic fields.

General



- This shaver is waterproof. It is suitable for use in the bath or shower and for cleaning under the tap. For safety reasons, the shaver can therefore only be used without cord.
- The appliance is suitable for mains voltages ranging from 100 to 240 volts.
- The supply unit transforms 100-240 volts to a safe low voltage of less than 24 volts.

The display

Note: Remove any sticker or protective foil from the display before using the product.

Charging

Note: If you press the on/off button during charging, the 'unplug for use' symbol flashes white to remind you that you have to disconnect the product from the wall outlet.

Quick charge: When the battery is empty and you connect the product to an electrical outlet, the lights of the battery charge indicator light up one after the other repeatedly. When the product contains enough energy for one shave, the bottom light of the battery charge indicator starts flashing slowly.



While the product continues to charge, first the bottom light of the battery charge indicator flashes and then lights up continuously. Then the second light flashes and then lights up continuously, and so on until the product is fully charged.

Battery fully charged

Note: This product can only be used without a cord.



When the battery is fully charged, all lights of the the battery charge indicator light up white continuously.

Note: When the battery is full, the display switches off automatically after 30 minutes.

Remaining battery charge



The remaining battery charge is shown by the lights of the battery charge indicator that light up continuously.

Battery low



When the battery is almost empty, the bottom light of the battery charge indicator flashes orange.

'Unplug for use' reminder



The 'unplug for use' symbol flashes to remind you that you have to disconnect the product from the power outlet before you can switch it on.

Cleaning reminder



Clean the shaver after every shave for optimal performance. When you switch off the product, the cleaning reminder flashes to remind you to clean the product.

Travel lock

You can lock the appliance when you are going to travel. The travel lock prevents the appliance from being switched on by accident.

Activating the travel lock

1



1 Press the on/off button for 3 seconds to enter the travel lock mode.



While you activate the travel lock, the travel lock symbol lights up continuously. When the travel lock is activated, the travel lock symbol flashes.

Deactivating the travel lock

1 Press the on/off button for 3 seconds. The travel lock symbol flashes and then lights up continuously. The appliance is now ready for use again.



Replacing shaving heads



For maximum shaving performance, replace the shaving heads every 2 years. The product is equipped with a replacement reminder which reminds you to replace the shaving heads. The shaving unit symbol lights up and the arrows flash to indicate that you have to replace the shaving heads.

Note: After replacing the shaving heads, you need to reset the replacement reminder by pressing the on/off button for 7 seconds.

Charge meter

Charge Meter monitors amount of remaining battery power available. Remaining battery capacity is based on the amount of power consumed shaving per minute and is dependent

upon your skin and beard type, whether you use pre-shave lotion, and how often the styler is used. Initially your shaver may need to go through 2 or 3 full charge/recharge cycles before remaining battery capacity indicators begin to display your accurate battery power left.

Charging


Charge the shaver before you use it for the first time and when the display indicates that the battery is almost empty.

Charging takes approx. 1 hour. A fully charged shaver has a shaving time of up to 50 minutes.

Note: You cannot use the appliance while it is charging.

Charging with the supply unit





3 After charging, remove the supply unit from the wall socket and pull the small plug out of the appliance.

Using the appliance

Note: This appliance can only be used without cord

Switching the appliance on and off



- To switch on the appliance, press the on/off button once.
- 2 To switch off the appliance, press the on/off button once

Shaving

Skin adaptation period

Your first shaves may not bring you the result you expect and your skin may even become slightly irritated. This is normal. Your skin and beard need time to adapt to any new shaving system. To allow your skin to adapt to this new appliance, we advise you to shave regularly (at least 3 times a week) and exclusively with this appliance for a period of 3 weeks.

Dry shaving

- **1** Switch on the appliance.
- 2 Move the shaving heads over your skin in circular movements to catch all hairs growing in different directions. Exert gentle pressure for a close, comfortable shave.

Note: Do not press too hard, this can cause skin irritation.

3 Clean the appliance after use.

Wet shaving

For a more comfortable shave, you can also use this appliance on a wet face with shaving foam or shaving gel.

To shave with shaving foam or shaving gel, follow the steps below:

1 Apply some water to your skin.







2 Apply shaving foam or shaving gel to your skin.



- 3 Rinse the shaving unit under the tap to ensure that the shaving unit glides smoothly over your skin.
- 4 Switch on the appliance.



5 Move the shaving heads over your skin in circular movements to catch all hairs growing in different directions. Exert gentle pressure for a close, comfortable shave.

Note: Do not press too hard, this can cause skin irritation.

Note: Rinse the shaving unit regularly to ensure that it continues to glide smoothly over your skin.

- 6 Dry your face.
- 7 Clean the appliance after use.

Note: Make sure you rinse all foam or shaving gel off the appliance.

Using the click-on attachments

Note: The accessories supplied may vary for different products. The box shows the accessories that have been supplied with your appliance.

Removing or attaching the click-on attachments

1 Make sure the appliance is switched off.



2 Pull the attachment straight off the appliance.
Note: Do not twist the attachment while you pull it off the appliance.



3 Insert the lug of the attachment into the slot in the top of the appliance. Then press down the attachment to attach it to the appliance ('click').



Note: Attach the click-on cleansing brush attachment on the attachment base first, before placing it on the appliance.

Using the cleansing brush attachment

Note: For better shaving results, use the click-on cleansing brush attachment before shaving.

Use the rotating cleansing brush with your daily cleansing cream. The cleansing brush removes oil and dirt, contributing to a healthy and oil-free skin. We advise you to use it no more than twice a day. Start with the lowest personal comfort setting to familiarize yourself with the attachment.

Do not use the appliance on damaged or irritated skin or on wounds.

- 1 Place the attachment on the attachment base.
- 2 Attach the attachment to the appliance ('click').





3 Moisten the attachment with water.

Note: Do not use the appliance with a dry brush attachment, as this can irritate the skin.



- **4** Moisten your face with water and apply a cleanser to your face.
- 5 Place the attachment on your cheek.
- **6** Switch on the appliance.



7 Gently move the attachment across your skin from the nose towards the ear. Do not push the attachment too hard onto the skin to make sure the treatment remains comfortable.

Note: Do not cleanse the sensitive area around your eyes.



8 After approx. 20 seconds, move the appliance to your other cheek and start cleansing this part of your face.



9 After approx. 20 seconds move the appliance to your forehead and start cleansing this part of your face. Gently move the brush head from left to right.

Note: We advise you to not overdo the cleansing and to not cleanse any zone longer than 20 seconds.

- 10 After the treatment, rinse and dry your face. Your face is now ready for the next step of your daily skincare routine.
- **11** Clean the attachment after use (see 'Cleaning and maintenance').

Using the beard styler attachment with comb

You can use the beard styler with the comb attached to style your beard at one fixed setting, but also at different length settings. You can also use it to pre-trim any long hairs before shaving for a more comfortable shave.

The length settings on the beard styler attachment correspond to the remaining hair length after cutting and range from 1 to 5mm.

1 Attach the attachment to the appliance ('click').



2 Slide the comb straight into the guiding grooves on both sides of the beard styler ('click').



3 Press the length selector and then push it to the left or right to select the desired hair length setting.



4 Switch on the appliance.



- 5 Move the appliance upwards while you exert gentle pressure. Make sure the front of the comb is in full contact with the skin.
- **6** Clean the attachment after use (see 'Cleaning and maintenance').

Using the beard styler attachment without comb

You can use the beard styler attachment without the comb to contour your beard, moustache, sideburns or neckline to a length of 0.5mm.



- Pull the comb off the beard styler.
 Note: Grab the comb in the center to pull it off the beard styler. Do not pull at the sides of the comb.
- **2** Switch on the appliance.



- **3** Hold the beard styler attachment perpendicular to the skin and move the appliance downwards while you exert gentle pressure.
- **4** Clean the attachment after use (see 'Cleaning and maintenance').

Cleaning and maintenance

Note: The accessories supplied may vary for different products. The box shows the accessories that have been supplied with your appliance.

Cleaning the shaver under the tap

Clean the shaver after every shave for optimal performance.

Be careful with hot water. Always check if the water is not too hot, to prevent burning your hands.

Never dry the shaving unit with a towel or tissue, as this may damage the shaving heads.

- 1 Switch on the appliance.
- 2 Rinse the shaving unit under a warm tap.



3 Switch off the appliance. Pull the shaving head holder off the bottom part of the shaving unit.



4 Rinse the hair chamber under the tap.



- **5** Rinse the shaving head holder under a warm tap.
- **6** Carefully shake off excess water and let the shaving head holder air dry.



7 Attach the shaving head holder to the bottom part of the shaving unit ('click').

Cleaning the click-on attachments

Never dry trimmer or beard styler attachments with a towel or tissue, as this may damage the trimming teeth.

The accessories supplied may vary for different products. The box shows the accessories that have been supplied with your appliance.

Cleaning the cleansing brush attachment

Clean the cleansing brush attachment every time you have used it.

- 1 Switch off the appliance.
- 2 Detach the brush head from the attachment base
- **3** Clean the parts thoroughly with warm water and soap.
- 4 Dry the cleansing brush attachment with a towel

Cleaning the beard styler attachment

Clean the beard styler after each use.

- 1 Pull the comb off the beard styler.
 - Note: Grab the comb in the center to pull it off the beard styler. Do not pull at the sides of the comb.
- **2** Switch on the appliance.





- **3** Rinse the beard styler and the comb separately under a warm tap.
- 4 After cleaning, switch off the appliance.
- **5** Carefully shake off excess water and let the beard styler and comb air dry.

6 For optimal performance, lubricate the teeth of the attachment with a drop of sewing machine oil regularly.

Replacement


Replacing the shaving heads



For maximum shaving performance, we advise you to replace the shaving heads every two years. Replace damaged shaving heads immediately. Always replace the shaving heads with original Philips shaving heads (see 'Ordering accessories'). Replacement reminder



The replacement reminder indicates that the shaving heads need to be replaced. The shaving unit symbol and arrows light up when you switch off the appliance.





2 Pull the shaving head holder off the bottom part of the shaving unit.



3 Turn the retaining rings anticlockwise and remove them. Place them aside in a safe place.



4 Remove the shaving heads from the shaving head holder.

Discard the used shaving heads immediately to avoid mixing them with the new shaving heads.



5 Place the new shaving heads in the shaving head holder.

Note: Make sure the notches on both sides of the shaving heads fit exactly onto the projections in the shaving head holder.



6 Place the retaining rings back onto the shaving heads and turn them clockwise to reattach the retaining ring.



 Each retaining ring has two recesses that fit exactly into the projections of the shaving head holder. Turn the ring clockwise until your hear a click to indicate that the ring is fixed.



Note: Hold the shaving head holder in your hand when you reinsert the shaving heads and reattach the retaining rings. Do not place the shaving head holder on a surface, as this may cause damage to the shaving heads.

- **7** Attach the shaving head holder to the bottom part of the shaving unit ('click').
- **8** To reset the replacement reminder, press and hold the on/off button for approx. 7 seconds.

Storage

Storage



- Store the appliance in the pouch supplied.

Note: Make sure the appliance is dry before you store it in the pouch.



- Put the protection cap on the cleansing brush attachment to protect it from dirt accumulation.

2 Bend the hooks aside and remove the power unit



3 Break the snap hooks and remove the front panel of the power unit.



4 Take out the battery holder and cut the battery tags with a pair of cutting pliers.
