

- The supply unit contains a transformer. Do not cut off the supply unit to replace it with another plug, as this causes a hazardous situation.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. 


When the battery is almost empty, the battery status indicator flashes orange.

Note: The battery status indicator goes out automatically after 30 minutes.




Charge the appliance before you use it for the first time and when the battery status indicator indicates that the battery is almost empty.

Charging takes approx. 1 hour. A fully charged appliance has a cordless operating time of up to 50 minutes

**3** After charging, remove the supply unit from the wall socket and pull the small plug out of the appliance.

# Using the appliance

Always check the appliance and all accessories before use. Do not use the appliance or any accessory if it is damaged, as this may cause injury. Always replace a damaged part with one of the original type.

Note: This appliance is for cordless use only.

- Use this appliance for its intended household use as described in this user manual.



- For hygienic reasons, the appliance should only be used by one person.

You can use the appliance wet or dry to shave hair on all parts of your body below the neckline. Trimming is easier when the skin and hairs are dry. Note: Switch off and clean the appliance after each use.

This symbol indicates that the shaver can be used in the bath or shower.



## Switching the appliance on and off



1 To switch the appliance on or off, press the on/off button once.

## Removing or attaching trimming combs





2 To attach a comb, snap the front part of the comb onto the teeth of the shaving unit and push the projection at the back of the comb into the appliance ('click').



3 To detach a comb, carefully push it upwards off the appliance and then remove the comb from the shaving unit.

## **Trimming**

## Trimming tips

- If you are trimming for the first time, be careful.
   Do not move the appliance too fast. Make smooth and gentle movements.
- Since all hairs do not grow in the same direction, you may want to try different trimming positions (i.e. upwards, downwards, or across). Practice is best for optimum results.
- Always make smooth and gentle movements and make sure that the surface of the comb always stays in contact with your skin.
- Body hair can be trimmed wet or dry. However, trimming dry hair is preferable because wet hair tends to stick to the body.
- When you trim sensitive areas, always use a trimming comb.

### Trimming with comb

Note: When you trim for the first time, start with the longest comb to familiarize yourself with the appliance.

Use a trimming comb attached to the shaving unit to trim parts of your body below the neckline. The appliance comes with 3 trimming combs. The hair length settings are indicated on the combs. The settings correspond to the remaining hair length after trimming.

Comb	mm	inch
Trimming comb	3mm	1/8in.
Trimming comb	5mm	3/16in.
Trimming comb	7mm	9/32in.

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- 1 Attach a comb onto the shaving unit (see 'Removing or attaching trimming combs').
- **2** Switch on the appliance (see 'Switching the appliance on and off ').
- 3 Move the appliance against the direction of hair growth,.
  - Note: Make sure that the flat part of the trimming comb is always fully in contact with the skin.
- **4** Switch off and clean the appliance after each use

## Shaving

## Shaving tips

This product is only intended for shaving and trimming body parts below the neckline. Do not use it to shave or trim facial or scalp hair.


- When shaving sensitive areas for the first time, you may experience some discomfort, irritation or reddening of the skin. This is normal as your skin needs time to adjust to shaving.
- If your hair is longer than 10mm, trim hair to a length of 3mm first for optimum shaving results.
- For dry use, make sure that your skin is clean and dry before you use the shaving unit.
- For wet use, prepare your skin with lathered soap or shaving foam before you use the appliance.

### Shaving with shaving unit

Use the shaving unit without comb to shave body hair.









- 3 Stretch your skin taut with your free hand. Gently press the shaving unit onto the skin and move it slowly and smoothly against the direction of hair growth.
- Do not press too hard. Too much pressure can distort the foil and cause skin irritation.
- Make sure that the shaving unit is always in full contact with your skin.
- The shaver is bi-directional, which means that you can shave by moving the appliance up and down. Shave against the direction of hair growth for optimal performance.
- **4** Switch off and clean the appliance after each use.

# Cleaning and maintenance

Regular cleaning guarantees better shaving results.

Never clean, remove or replace a shaving or cutting unit while the appliance is switched on.

Always check if the water is too hot, to prevent burning your hands.

Never dry cutting units or shaving foils with a towel or tissue, as this may cause damage.

Never use compressed air, scouring pads, abrasive cleaning agents or aggressive liquids such as petrol or acetone to clean the appliance.

## Cleaning the appliance

Clean the appliance after every use (see 'Cleaning and maintenance').

- Switch off the appliance and disconnect it from the wall socket.
- **2** Remove the trimming comb from the appliance and rinse it under the tap.
- **3** Remove the shaving foil from the shaving unit. Hold the shaving foil by the plastic housing only.

Note: The foil is delicate. Handle the shaving foil with care.

**4** Rinse the shaving foil under a warm running tap.

- **5** Rinse the hair chamber under a warm running tap to remove any residue.
- **6** Carefully shake off excess water and let all parts air dry completely.

Never dry cutting units or shaving foils with a towel or tissue, as this may cause damage.

**7** After cleaning, snap the shaving foil back into the shaving unit.









# Replacement



For maximum shaving performance, we advise you to replace the shaving foil every year. Replace a damaged shaving foil immediately. Always replace the shaving foil with original Philips TT2000 shaving unit.

- 1 Switch off the appliance and disconnect it from the wall socket.
- 2 Pull the shaving foil out of the shaving unit.



**3** Snap the new shaving foil into the shaving unit ('click').



**4** Make sure the shaving foil is firmly attached before you use the appliance.



# **Storage**



1 Undo the strap, put the appliance in the pouch and fasten the strap.



- **2** Put the combs in the pouch.
  - Note: Make sure that the appliance and its attachments are dry before you store them.
- **3** Hang or put the pouch in a safe place.
