Mains fuse(/56)

This TV is fitted with an approved moulded plug. Should it become necessary to replace the mains fuse, this must be replaced with a fuse of the same value as indicated on the plug (example 10A).

- 1. Remove fuse cover and fuse.
- The replacement fuse must comply with BS 1362 and have the ASTA approval mark. If the fuse is lost, contact your dealer in order to verify the correct type.
- 3. Refit the fuse cover.

Safety

Risk of electric shock or fire!

- Never expose the TV to rain or water.
 Never place liquid containers, such as vases, near the TV. If liquid is spilt on or into the TV, disconnect the TV from the power outlet immediately. Contact Philips Consumer Care to have the TV checked before use.
- Never place the TV, remote control or batteries near naked flame or other heat sources, including direct sunlight.
 To prevent the spread of fire, keep candles or other flames away from the TV, remote control and batteries at all times.



- Never insert objects into the ventilation slots or other openings on the TV.
- When the TV is swivelled ensure that no strain is exerted on the power cord. Strain on the power cord can loosen connections and cause arcing.
- To disconnect the TV from the mains power, the power plug of the TV must be disconnected. When disconnecting the power, always pull the power plug, never the cord. Ensure that you have full access to the power plug, power cord and outlet socket at all times.




4 Use Your TV

This section helps you perform basic TV operations.

(The following operations are all based on the remote control button operation. For the control panel operation, please refer to the "Control Panel" operation instructions.)

Switch TV on/off



To switch on

- Plug in the power plug.
 - » If the standby indicator is lights up, press (Standby-On) on the remote control.

To switch to standby

- Press () (Standby-On) on the remote control
 - The TV will switch into standby status.



Though your TV consumes very little power when in standby mode, energy continues to be consumed. When not in use for an extended period of time, disconnect the TV power cable from the power outlet.

Watch connected devices




Switch on the device before selecting it as an external signal source.

Use the Source button




- 1. Press **SOURCES** key.
 - » The source list appears.
- 2. Press **▲**/**▼** key to select a device.
- 3. Press **OK** key to select.
 - The TV switches to the selected device

Switch channels



- Press Channel Control +/- key on the remote control.
- Enter a channel number using the numeric buttons on the remote control.
- switch and return to the previous channel.

Adjust TV volume



To increase or decrease volume

 Press Volume Control +/- key on the remote control.

To mute or unmute the sound

- Press ◀² (Mute).
- Press

 again to restore the sound.

Date and time

Connect DTV signal, the clock displays synchronize with the time in current code stream. Press key to check current time, current time will be displayed in program information.

Time zone

Set time zone information according to the following steps:

- 1. Press 🏚 key.
- 2. Choose the following pass: Time--> Time Zone.
- 3. Choose one time zone, press **OK** key to confirm.
- 4. Press **W** (**EXIT**)key to close it.

5 TV Operation

Some functions are valid under a specific source. (Because the product is constantly updated, the software is upgraded at any time, if the software operation is different from the actual operation, please refer to the actual product.)

Channel Settings

Press \clubsuit key, and press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ key to select **Channels**, then press **OK** key to enter the channel submenu.

Auto Tuning

Press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ key to select **Auto Tuning**, and press **OK** key to enter submenu.

Press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ key to select tune type, and press **OK** key to enter submenu. Press $\blacktriangle/\blacktriangledown$ key to select country, and press **OK** key, then the TV will start auto tuning.

• During auto tuning, press **\(\sigma** key to exit it.

DTV Manual Tuning

Select DTV signal in source menu.

Press ▲/▼ key to select DTV Manual Tuning,
and press OK key to enter submenu. Press

◄/▶ key to select channel and press OK key to
search.

ATV Manual Tuning

Select ATV signal in source menu.

Press ▲/▼ key to select ATV Manual Tuning, and press OK key to enter submenu. Press ▲/▼ key to select Sound System, Color System, Current Channel, Fine-Tune. Press ◀/▶ key to adjust these items. Select Search and press ◀/▶ key to search for the TV.

Programme Edit

Press \triangle/∇ key to select **Programme Edit**, and press **OK** key to enter submenu.

- **Delete**: Press **Red** key on the remote control to delete the selected channel.
- Favorite: After choosing a channel, press
 Yellow key on the remote control to set
 your favorite channel. Press Yellow key again
 to cancel it.
- Skip: After selecting channel, press Blue key on the remote control to skip the channel, Press Blue key again to cancel it.

Lock

- Set password: Set a new password for your TV.
- Block Program: Press Green key on the remote control to lock your program in the program list.
- Parental Guidance: This function helps parents to set channels available for children of different age groups.



 Please input "3448" in lock system, if you have forgotten your password by watching TV.

Time Setting

- Auto Sync: Press ▲/▼ key to select to turn on or off the auto sync
- Clock: Press ▲/▼ key to set the time and date.

 - Channels list copy: Press OK key to enter Channels list copy and press
 ▲/▼ key to select copy to USB or copy to TV.
 - Hearing Impaired: Press OK key to enter Hearing Impaired: and press
 - **▲**/**▼** key to turn on or off this function.
 - Shop Mode: Press OK key to enter

- Shop Mode, and press \triangle/∇ key to turn on or off this function.
- Software info: Press OK key to view the software information.
- Factory Setting: Press OK key to enter Factory Setting. By this function you will reset all your personal settings, but the channel installation remains unchanged.
- Restore Default: Press OK key to enter Restore Default. ALL setup and channels will be reset.
- Software Update(USB): Update TV software (For maintenance personnel).



• Press \(\bigsize \) key to return to the previous menu.

EPG

Press **TV GUIDE** key on the remote control to access TV program guide list. (It is available in DTV Mode)

- Record: Press Red key on the remote control to record the program, then the recorder menu will show on TV. You can select channel and record mode, set the start time and end time; then press OK key to confirm. Finished record program, the new task will be appeared in schedule list.
- Info: Press Green key on remote control to view the program information.
- Schedule: Press Yellow key on remote control to view the program information of the recorded and reminded.
- Remind: Press Blue key on remote control to remind your program.

Recording Option

In DTV mode, press red point key • key on the remote control. Record option menu will show on the screen, and the TV system begin recording now.

Press ■ key on the remote control to stop and quit the recording.

Press ♠ key, and press ▲/▼ key to select PVR, then press OK key to renter PVR submenu.

Press **△**/**▼** key to select **Recorded List**, and press **OK** key to enter submenu. Select the file that you want to play, and press **OK** key to play it.



- This function need to be connected with USB device, the USB of FAT32 format must be used. The USB of NTFS format does not support recording The duration
- does not support recording. The duration of each recording should be no longer than 6 hours.
- You can find these files in recorded list (Utilities-- > Recorded List)

Recording options menu introduction

- ▶ Play: Play the current video.
- **◄** FB: Fast back for the video, press ▶ (play) key to play normally.
- ►► FF: Fast forward for the video, press ► (play) key to play normally.
- **▼** FB30S: Play backward 30 seconds.
- ► FF30S: Play fast forward 30 seconds.
- Pause: Pause the video.
- Stop: Stop recording and quit the recording function.

Time-shift Option

In DTV mode, press II key on the remote control, time-shift option menu will show on the screen, and the program is in suspended status. press II key on the remote control to stop and quit time-shift function. When you leave program for a short time, time-shift function can suspend and cache the playing program to U disk. When you resume playing, the program can

continue to be played.

Time-shift options menu introduction

- ▶ Play: Play the current video.
- **◄** FB: Fast back for the video, press ▶ (play) key to play normally.
- ►► FF: Fast forward for the video, press ► (play) key to play normally.
- **▼** FB30S: Play backward 30 seconds.

- Pause: Pause the video.
- Stop: Stop and quit time-shift function.

USB Media Function

Please insert a USB device into the USB interface of the TV, press **SOURCES** key to display the source menu. Press ▲/▼ key to select USB, and press **OK** key to enter USB menu.

Note: USB device file format are NTFS, FAT or FAT32. When connecting the USB port to an external device which current is exceeded 500mA, it will cause damage of the TV. If the USB device is working, do not pull out immediately, it will cause damage of the TV system or the USB device system.

Media player UI icon introduction

- Picture player menu options
 - (A): Play the previous picture.
 - Play the next picture.
 - (II)/ (•): Pause/play lantern slide.

- Press OPTIONS key on remote control to show option menu of the Picture, you can adjust these items by your desire.
- Music player menu options

7 Troubleshooting

This section covers common problems and their accompanying solutions.

General issues

The TV cannot be switched on:

- Disconnect the power cable from the power outlet. Wait for one minute before reconnecting it.
- Check that the power cable is securely connected.

The remote control is not working properly:

- Check that the remote control batteries are correctly inserted according to the +/orientation.
- Replace the remote control batteries if they are flat or weak.
- Clean the remote control and TV sensor lens.

The TV menu is in the wrong language:

 Change the TV menu to your preferred language.

When turning the TV On/Off or to Standby, you hear a creaking sound from the TV chassis:

 No action is required. The creaking sound comes from the normal expansion and contraction of the TV as it cools down and warms up. This does not impact its performance.

Channel issues

Previously installed channels do not appear in the channel list:

 Check that the correct channel list is selected.

Picture issues

The TV is on, but there is no picture:

Check that the antenna is properly

- connected to the TV.
- Check that the correct device is selected as the TV source.

There is sound but no picture:

 Check that the picture settings are correctly set.

Poor TV reception from the antenna connection:

- Check that the antenna is properly connected to the TV.
- Loudspeakers, unearthed audio devices, neon lights, high buildings and other large objects can influence reception quality. If possible, try to improve the reception quality by changing the antenna direction or moving devices away from the TV.
- If the reception on one particular channel is poor, please fine tune this channel.

There is poor picture quality from connected devices:

- Check that the devices are connected properly.
- Check that the picture settings are correctly set

The picture does not fit the screen; it is too big or too small:

Try using a different picture format.

The picture position is incorrect:

 Picture signals from some devices may not fit the screen correctly. Please check the signal output of the device.

Sound issues

The pictures are showing but sound quality is poor:

- Check that all cables are properly connected.
- Check that the volume is not set to 0.
- Check that the sound is not muted.
- Check that the sound settings are correctly set.

The pictures are showing but sound comes from one speaker only:

 Verify that sound balance is set to the centre.

HDMI connection issues

There are problems with HDMI devices:

- Please note that HDCP (High-bandwidth Digital Content Protection) support can delay the time taken for a TV to TV content from a HDMI device.
- If the TV does not recognize the HDMI device and no picture is displayed, please try switching the signal source to another device before switching it back again.
- If there are intermittent sound disruptions, please check that output settings from the HDMI device are correct.
