2.1 安全

2.2 听力保护

使用耳机时请遵守下列原则：

- 调整至合适的音量，切勿长时间使用耳机。

- 特别需要注意，切勿将音量调至耳朵所能承受的范围之外。
- 切勿将音量调至盖过周边环境的声音。
- 在危险情况下请小心或暂停使用耳机。
- 在驾驶汽车、骑自行车、玩滑板时，切勿使用耳机。否则会导致交通意外，且违反相关法律法规。

2.3 有关安全与有效操作的重要警告

2.4 RF 射频操作特性

您的无线对讲机包含一个发射装置和一个接收装置，当开机时，它能接收和发送无线电射频信号，它的频率操作范围在409MHz至410MHz之间。

2.5 无线电辐射的安全性

双向无线对讲机所产生的任何杂散或机壳的射频非电离辐射，对人体没有危害。为确保最佳的通话效果，并确保暴露的射频能量在规定的安全范围内。

2.6 天线使用注意

只能使用由飞利浦原配的或经认可的天线部件。
未经认可的天线，经改装或增添了附件的天线可能会损坏对讲机或违反信息产业部无线电管理局的规定。
在使用时，不要用手去拿天线，握住天线会影响无限对讲机的有效通话范围。

2.7 对讲机操作

使用无线对讲机通话时，该无线对讲机维持垂直位置，麦克风距离嘴部 5~7 厘米。

2.8 电磁干扰 / 兼容性

备注：绝大部分现代化的电子设备是能屏蔽射频信号的，但是可能会有某些电子设备不能够屏蔽您所使用的对讲机发出的射频信号。

- 使用公众对讲机，其通信质量不受无线电机保护，应承受其它正常工作的无线电业务可能产生的干扰。
- 禁止与公众电话网、公众移动通信网及其他电信网互联。
- 使用对讲机时，不得对各种合法无线电业务产生有害干扰，

一旦发现有害干扰，应立即停止使用，并采取措施消除干扰后方可继续使用。

- 不得擅自更改发射频率，加大发射功率（包括额外加装射频功率放大器），不得擅自外接天线或改用其它发射天线。

2.9 设备

为了避免电磁干扰 / 兼容性的冲突，在某些场所贴有通知要求您关闭对讲机时，请遵守。在医院或医疗场所所使用的仪器对外来无线电的射频信号非常敏感，请关闭对讲机。
禁止在机场或飞行器上使用。

2.10 医学设备

心脏起搏器

建议对讲机与心脏起搏器之间的最小距离为 15 厘米。
带有心脏起搏器的人应该遵循以下规定：

- 当无线对讲机开机时应该时刻保持无线对讲机与心脏起搏器之间距离在 15 厘米以上。
- 不要将无线对讲机放置在前胸的口袋中。
- 为减少潜在干扰，请使用耳机。
- 如果您怀疑无线对讲机与心脏起搏器之间有干扰产生，请立即关闭无线对讲机。

2.11 助听器

无线对讲机可能会干扰一些助听器。在这种情况下，您可以与您的助听器生产商协商讨论替代物。

2.12 其他医疗设备

如果您还使用其它个人医疗，请与制造商咨询决定它是否有足够的射频屏蔽。您的医生可以帮助您得到这些信息。

2.13 安全驾驶

查看您开车所在地使用对讲机的法律与规定并遵循。

当驾驶时使用对讲机，请遵循以下规定：

- 全神贯注地驾驶与注意路况。
- 如果可能，尽量使用免持功能进行发话和收话。
- 若有规定禁止驾驶时使用对讲机，请先将车开至路边停下，再进行通话。

2.14 操作注意事项

附安全气囊的汽车

不要把对讲机或其它物品放在气囊上方或气囊展开范围内，气囊充气时会带来很大的力量。若放在气囊展开后能触及的区域，当气囊展开时，对讲机或其它物品可能受很大的力量而抛出，会造成汽车内乘客严重受伤。

2.15 爆炸危险区

除非是危险地区专用的对讲机，否则在潜在爆炸危险区内务必关机。不要在该地区将对讲机中电池取出、安装或更换。在这种地区即使您的电池发出微小的火花也可能引起爆炸或火灾，造成意外的伤害或甚至死亡。



注意

- 以上所指的潜在爆炸危险区包括：燃料，船舶甲板下方，燃料，或化学制品运输或储存设施，能够闻到燃料气味的地方（例如，汽车或房间里发生了汽油 / 丙烷泄露），空气中含有化学物质或其它颗粒（如含有颗粒，灰尘、金属粉末等）的地区，以及建议您关闭汽车引擎的任何其它地区。潜在爆炸危险区通常没有明显的标示。

2.16 雷管区

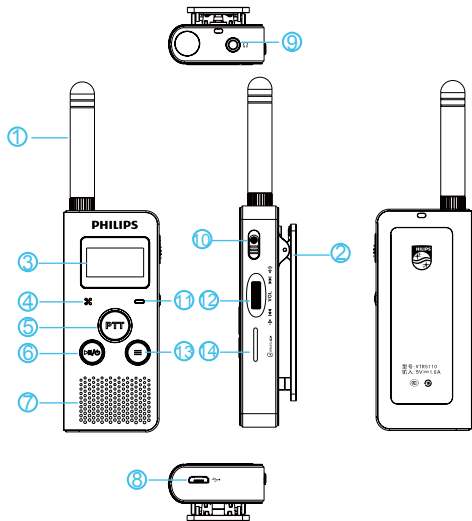
为避免干扰爆破作业，在电动雷管附近或“爆破区”、或标示“请关闭无线对讲机”的地区，务必关闭您的对讲机。如有其它类似的标语或指示，也请您遵守。

2.17 操作警告

- 天线：不可使用任何天线损坏的无线对讲机。损坏的天线与皮肤接触时，可能会造成轻微的灼伤。
- 防止磁化：对讲机扬声器的外磁性很弱，但请保持您的对讲机与电视机，电脑显示器等屏幕之间的距离大于10厘米，以免被磁化。

4 开始使用

4.1 开 / 关机

注意

第一次使用机器时，请对该机器充电三小时以确保机器有电工作！

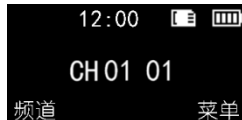
- (1) 长按“▶||/⏻”键，对讲本机自动开机。显示“PHILIPS”，如下图所示。
然后进入对讲机界面，如下图所示。

注意

- 此后，本机的开机 / 关机由“播放”键控制，具体如下。
- 关机：在开机状态下，长按“播放”键直到显示“PHILIPS”关机。
- 开机：在关机状态下，长按“播放”键开机，直至屏幕上显示开机画面“PHILIPS”。

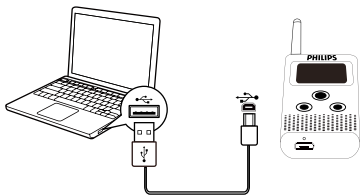

- 本机使用内置锂电池供电，如果长时间不使用本机，请关闭电源。
- 如果本机无法正常工作，请确认机器是否已没电。
- 当电量指示标志为“”时，请及时充电。

4.2 充电方法

(1) 使用 USB 数据线将本机与 PC 相连接，如下图所示。



(2) 使用专用充电器充电。当采用以上方法连接后，本机进入充电状态。电量指示标志由空到满循环变化，表示本机现正处于充电状态，一般情况下，充满电需要2小时左右。充满电时，电池符号显示满格，机器显示已充满，如下右图所示。



提示

- 使用专用充电器充电，机器还可正常工作。

4.3 连接电脑

当插入 TF 卡时，本机可作为大容量的 USB 存储设备，并可方便地对文件进行存储、备份和移动。可使用 USB 数据线将本机与电脑相连，且无须安装软件，本机会自动显示为可移动设备，连接电脑图标如下图所示。





在文件移入或移出本机时，请不要断开本机与电脑的连接。

5 对讲设置

当您初次使用对讲机时，请注意本节中的内容说明。

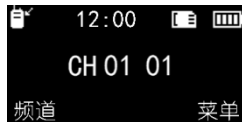
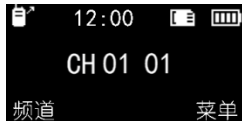


(1) 按住 PTT 键，与麦克风保持 5 到 7 公分距离，以正常语速通话。当显示屏的图标  出现时，可以发送信息，如下左图。为了避免切断了您的通话内容，按下 PTT 按钮稍微停顿后，然后再开始说话。当你完成通话时，松开 PTT 键。你可以接收到来自其他人的呼叫，当接收到信号时，图标  会在屏幕上显示，如下右图。

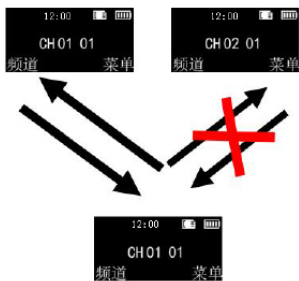


注意

- 在对讲机界面，请不要使用其他耳机，务必使用随机配送的专用耳机，防止损坏对讲机。



开机状态下同频道的对讲机才可以进行对讲。
使用前请预先将要通信的 2 台机器设置为同样的频道以及相同的亚音码。如下图。



(2) 你可以通过机器侧面的上下滚动键调节对讲机音量。首先把音量键往里按压一下，则会弹出音量调节界面，然后通过上下拨动音量键来加减音量，参考界面如下图：



(3) 在对讲机界面，短按 PLAY 键，可进行频道设置。向上或向下拨动音量键选择你需要的频道及亚音码即可。一共 20 组频道，99 个亚音码可选择。当亚音码数字为 00 时，关闭亚

音码。如下图。

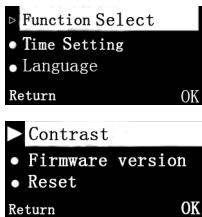

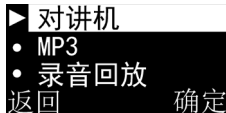

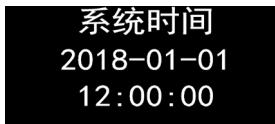

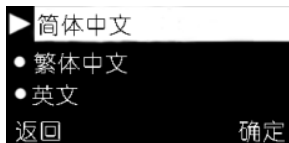

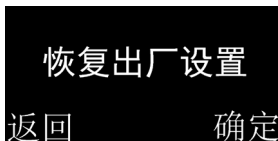

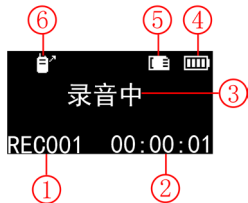
6 对讲录音

- (1) 在对讲机界面把录音键拨到录音状态开始录音，请将内置麦克风对准音源。
- (2) 在录音状态下，当您按下 PTT 按键或接收到其他人的信号时，机器会自动开始录音，否则会暂停录音。若要保存录音文件，只需向下推动录音键即可，并回到对讲机界面

提示

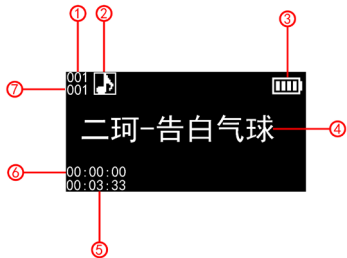

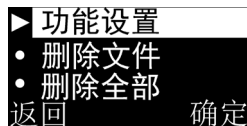

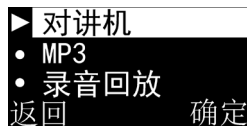

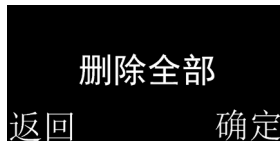

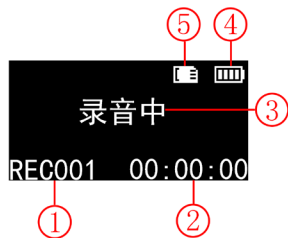

2.Important

2.1 Safety

- To avoid a short circuit, do not expose the product to rain or water.
- Do not expose the device to excessive heat caused by heating equipment or direct sunlight.
- Protect the cables from being pinched, particularly at plugs.
- Support Quick Charge (5VIA)



Note

- Please use the charger appointed by the manufacturer for charging; adopting unqualified charger or charger exceeding the parameter specification of 5VIA for charging will damage the device!!!Attention! Before using the device please read this User Manual carefully. The company shall not be liable for any data loss due to erroneous operation or causes of a force majeure nature. Special attention should be given to careful operations and prepare backup of files.

2.2 Hearing Protection

Observe the following guidelines when using your headphones:

- Adjust to suitable volume; do not use the earphones for a long time.
- Please do not turn the volume up beyond your tolerance.
- Do not turn up the volume so high that you cannot hear what's around you.
- When in dangerous conditions, please carefully use the earphones or stop using.
- Do not use the earphones when driving, cycling and skateboarding to avoid traffic accident and violating laws and regulations.

2.3 Hearing Protection

Please read these warnings before using your wireless intercom.

Please refer to relevant operational consideration in case of using in dangerous circumstance.

2.4 Operating characteristics of RF (radio frequency)

Your wireless intercom includes a transmitting device and a receiving device. When it is turned on, it can receive and transmit radio frequency signal. The operating range of its frequency is between 409MHz to 410MHz.

2.5 Safety of wireless radiation

The stray radio frequency arising out of two-way wireless intercom is not ionizing radiation and is harmless to human body. To ensure the best communication effect and ensure the exposed radio frequency energy is within the prescribed safety limits, the operation of wireless intercom shall follow the following steps:

2.6 Notice for use of antenna

Only use the original Philips antenna component . Unapproved antenna, refitted antenna or antenna added with attachment may damage the intercom or When using the device, do not hold the antenna with your hand, which will

influence the effective range of wireless intercom.

2.7 Operation of intercom

When using the intercom, keep it in vertical position with the microphone 5~7cm away from your mouth.

2.8 Electromagnetic interference/compatibility



Note

- most modern electronic equipment can block radio frequency signals, but there may be some electronic equipment which cannot block the radio frequency signals transmitted by your intercom.
- Using public intercom of which the communication quality is not protected by radio service will have to bear the interferences generated by other radio services which are normally operating.
- It is prohibited to interconnect with public telephone network, public mobile communication network and other telecommunication networks.
- Do not change the transmitting frequency or increase

the transmitting power (including equipping the additional radiofrequency power amplifier) without authorization; do not use external antenna or other transmitting antennas.

2.9 Equipment

To avoid conflict of electromagnetic interference/ compatibility, if you receive an announcement of requiring you to turn off the intercom somewhere, please observe. The instruments used in hospital or medical location are very sensitive to radiofrequency signals from external radio, please turn off the intercom.

It is prohibited to use on the airport or an aircraft.

2.10 Medical equipment

Cardiac pacemaker

It is suggested that the minimum distance between the intercom and the cardiac pacemaker is 15cm.

Persons with cardiac pacemaker shall follow the following rules:

- When the intercom is turned on, it shall be always kept at least 15cm away from cardiac pacemaker.
- Do not put the intercom in your breast pocket.
- To reduce potential interference, please use earphones.
- If you suspect that there is interference between the

intercom and the cardiac pacemaker, turn off the intercom immediately.

2.11 Hearing-aid

The intercom may interfere some hearing-aids. Under this condition, you may negotiate a substitute with your hearing-aid manufacturer.

2.12 Other medical equipment

If you are using other personal medical services, please consult with the manufacturer to determine whether it has adequate radiofrequency shielding. Your doctor can help you get such information.

2.13 Safe driving

Review and follow the local laws and regulations of where you drive for using intercom.

In case of using intercom when driving, please follow the following rules:

- Concentrate on driving and pay attention to the traffic condition.
- Use the hands-free function to make and receive messages

if possible.

- If it is prohibited to use intercom during driving, please drive to the side of the road prior to communication.

2.14 Operation cautions

For cars with airbags

Do not place the intercom or other items on top of the airbag or within the range of the expansion of the airbag, because the inflation of the airbag will bring a great power. If it is placed in the area that can be reached after the airbag is inflated, when the airbag expands, the intercom or other items may be thrown away by a large amount of power which will cause serious injury to the passengers in the car.

2.15 Explosive dangerous zone

Unless it is a special intercom for dangerous area, it must be turned off in potential explosive dangerous zone. Do not take out, install or change the battery of the intercom. In such zone, even tiny sparks arising out of your battery may cause explosion or fire which will cause accidental injury or even death.



Note

- The above-mentioned potential explosive dangerous zone includes: **fuel, below ships' deck, fuel**, or a facility for transporting or storing chemical products, a place where you smell fuel (e.g. gasoline/ propane leakage occurs in the car or room), an area where there are chemicals or other particles (such as particles, dust and metal powder) in the air, including any other areas where it is suggested to turn off your car engine. The potential explosive dangerous zone could have no obvious marks.

2.16 Detonator zone

To avoid interfering blasting work, in areas such as nearing electric detonator, or "blast area", or marked with "Please turn off wireless intercom", you must turn off your intercom. If there are other similar slogans or instructions, please follow.

2.17 Warnings for operation

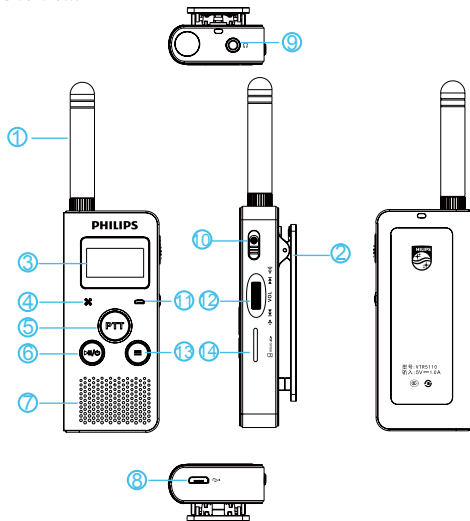
- Antenna: do not use any intercoms with broken antenna.

When a broken antenna touches the skin, it may cause slight burn.

- Prevent magnetization: although the external magnetism of the intercom loudspeaker is weak, please keep your intercom at least 10cm away from sensitive devices like debit/credit cards to avoid magnetization.

4.Start to Use

4.1 Power On/Off



Note

- Please recharge the device for three hours before using it for the first time!

1.Press the “ ” button until the device starts and displays “PHILIPS”, as shown below.



2.At this moment, the device's On/Off is controlled by the Play button as follows:

Switch Off: When in the power-on state, press down the Play button until the “**PHILIPS**” is displayed, then the device is switched off.

Switch On: When in the power-off state, press down the Play button until the startup logo “**PHILIPS**” is displayed.

After a few seconds the device enters the intercom mode, as shown below



Hint:

- The device has a built-in lithium battery. If the device shall be idle for a long time, please slide the power switch to OFF position.
- If the device cannot work normally, please make sure the device is not out of electricity.
- When the battery indicator “” is displayed, please charge the device promptly.

4.2 Battery Charging

1.Connect the device to PC through USB cable, **as shown below.**

2.Use USB-Charger to recharge, **as shown below.**
when using the above methods to recharge, the device

enters the charging status. The battery indicator shows a battery icon turning from empty to full repeatedly, indicating that the device is recharging. Under normal circumstance, the device can be fully recharged in around 2 hours. When the device is fully charged, the battery icon is full which indicates that it is fully recharged, **as shown below.**



Hint:

- Using special charger to recharge, the device can also work properly.



While moving files into or out of the device, please do not disconnect the device from the computer.


4.3 Connect to Computer

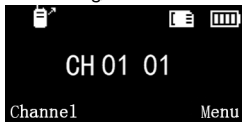
When TF card is inserted, the device can be used as a USB mass device storage to conveniently store, back up and move files. The “Connect to Computer” icon is as shown below.


5.WALKIE TALKIE Setting

Please note the instructions in this chapter for the first use of the intercom.



I. Press the PTT button, keep 5~7cm distance away from the microphone, and speak normally. The icon  indicates that you are transmitting, as shown below.



To avoid cutting off your speech, press the PTT button for a second prior to start speaking. Release the PTT button to end the transmission. When receiving a message, the icon  will be displayed as shown below.



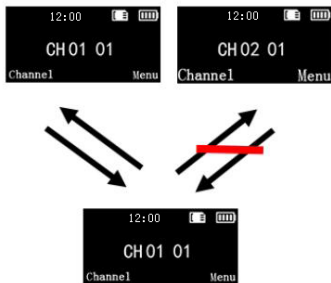

- Please use the original earphones to avoid damaging the intercom.

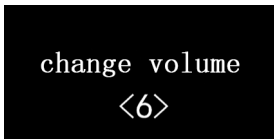


Please set the 2 devices to be used for communication into same frequency channel and same Continuous Tone-Coded Squelch System (CTCSS) in advance before using. **As shown**

below.



2. You can adjust the walkie talkie volume through the up-and-down scroll button on the side of the device, as shown below.

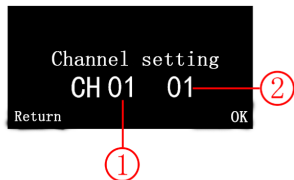


3. In walkie talkie interface, short pressing the PLAY button can set the frequency channel. Move the volume button upward or downward to choose the frequency channel

and CTCSS you need. There are 20 frequency channels and 99 CTCSSs you can choose. When the figure of CTCSS is 00, the CTCSS will be turned off.



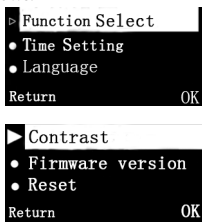
Setting interface information:



1. Frequency channel
2. CTCSS (00 means turn off the CTCSS)

In walkie talkie interface, short pressing the Menu button can enter into the system menu. The menu options are as follows: function setting, time setting, language, contrast ratio,

firmware version, and restore factory setting. The referencing interface is as follows:



(1) Function Setting

Choose “Function Setting” menu and pressing Menu button will enter the Function Setting option menu where you can choose the function you need.

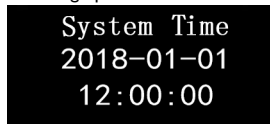


Walkie-Talkie: enter the walkie talkie mode.
MP3: play the music files in your TF card.

Record Replay: play your recording files.

(2) Time Setting

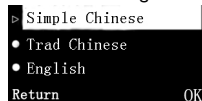
Choose “Time Setting” menu and pressing Menu button will enter the Time Setting option menu.



Move the volume button upward or downward to adjust the date, short press PLAY button to choose the next setting item and short press Menu button to confirm the setting.

(3) Language

Choosing “Language” and pressing Menu button will enter the Language menu. The referencing interface is as follows:



(4) Contrast Ratio

Choosing "Contrast Ratio" button and pressing Menu button will enter the Contrast Ratio Setting menu.



Move the volume button upward or downward to adjust the proper contrast ratio, short press PLAY button or Menu button to confirm the setting.

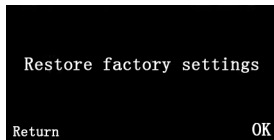
(5) Firmware Version

Choose "Firmware Version" menu and press Menu button will enter the Firmware Version.



(6) Restore Factory Setting

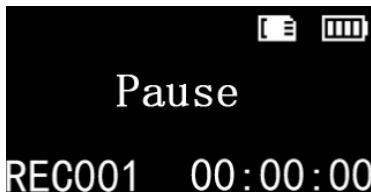
Choose "Restore Factory Setting" menu and pressing Menu button will enter the restore factory setting interface.



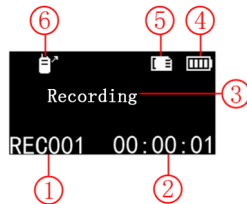
Short press PLAY button to cancel "Restore Factory Setting". After short press Menu button, the parameters of the device will be restored to factory setting and the data of your settings will be reset.

6.WALKIE TALKIE Recording

- 1.In walkie talkie interface, move the Record button to recording status to start recording. Please direct the built-in microphone to the audio source.
- 2.In recording status, when you press the PTT button or receive messages from others, the device will start to record automatically, otherwise the recording will be paused. If you wish to end recording push the Record button downwards. This will save the audio file and the device will return to walkie talkie interface.



Recording interface information:



- ① File name of recording
- ② Length of recording(hh:mm:ss)
- ③ Recording status
- ④ Battery indicator
- ⑤ TF card is inserted
- ⑥ Intercom status indicator

Note

- If the battery indicator displays empty, it represents low battery. The system will be automatically turned off when battery is too low. If it is recording, the system will automatically save the recording file prior to turn-off. When the battery is low, please recharge promptly. The icon displayed when the battery is low and the system will be turned off is as follows:

Low quantity of electricity



Hint:

- If the recording time exceeds the usable capacity of the device or the number of files reaches the limit of 200, the recording stops. Please delete part of recording or delete files from the device's memory
- When the device is in the recording mode, please do not turn off the power, otherwise it will cause the device failure, recording file loss or recording file damage.
- Please charge battery in advance if you need to record for a long time.

7.MP3 Mode

Under the intercom interface, you can short press the Menu button, choose “Function Setting” and choose “MP3”, short press the Menu button to confirm .



Short press PLAY button to confirm



- ① Current file number
- ② Intercom/play mode indicator
- ③ Battery indicator
- ④ File name
- ⑤ Total time of current file

7.1 Play Mode

1. Press the “PLAY” button to start playing.
2. Move the volume button upward or downward to adjust the volume.
3. Long press the “PLAY” button to stop playing. In the state of stop, short press Menu button to enter the Music Menu Setting interface.
4. When playing, press “PLAY” button to pause playing and resume playing by pressing PLAY button again.
5. When playing, keep **pressing “◀◀” or “▶▶” button** to fast forward or backward the current playing file.
6. In music playing interface, you can use the intercom function but cannot set frequency channel. When you need to communicate, press the “PTT” button of the device to start. When playing, the device will automatically pause the music if receiving a call. After the end of

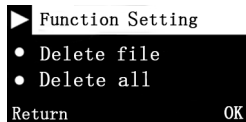
communication, if you need to continue playing music, press the “PLAY” button again to continue playing music.



Hint:

- When the earphone plug is inserted into the jack, the loudspeaker of the device will be turned off.
- Please make sure to use the original earphone.

In music pause/stop interface, short press the “PLAY” button to play, short press the “Menu” button to pop up the following list of menus: function setting, delete file and delete all. The referencing interface is as follows:



(1) Delete File

Choosing “Delete File” menu in music menu list and pressing the Menu button to delete the current file.



Short press PLAY button to cancel deleting file and press Menu button to delete the current file.

If you do not set anything for a long time, it will automatically exit the delete interface.

(2) Delete All

Choose "Delete All" menu in music menu list and pressing the Menu button to delete all files.



Short press PLAY button to cancel deleting files and press Menu button to delete all files.
If you do not set anything for a long time, it will automatically exit the delete interface.

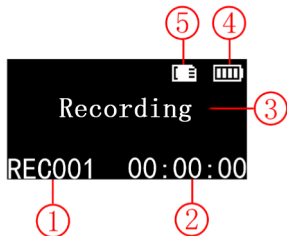
8.Audio Recording Mode
