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

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



## **Installation instructions**

## Pre-install instructions

- 1. Please prepare the following tools before installation, including cutting pliers, hammer, Phillips screwdriver, 10~14# wrench, utility knife, tape measure, insulating gloves, insulating tape, marker, etc.
- 2. Choose a proper location for installing the drying rack and decide the direction of host.

## Fix expansion screws


- 1. If the chosen location is installed with lamp, turn it off and remove it
- 2. Measure dimension and mark the location for installation on ceiling. 3. As shown in Figure 1, stick installation template on marked location on
- ceiling, and mark out four holes. 4. As shown in Figure 2, drill 4  $\phi 10 \times 80$  mm holes, fix and tighten expansion screws with a wrench. Loosen nuts of two expansion screws at one side and keep about 5 mm distance between washer and nut. Remove nuts and washers of 2 expansion screws on the other side.






## Install host

- 1. As shown in Figure 3, carefully hold the host and fix it with expansion screws, washers and fasten nuts.
- 2. Connect power cables correctly, (Note: connect brown wire of host power cable to live wire, blue to neutral wire, yellow and green to grounding wire), then wrap the connected wires with insulating tape and put it in the gap between host and the ceiling.



1. As shown in Figure 4, buckle pulley of scissor frame into the chute of mounting plate and lock it with screws.


 $\mathbf{2.}\;$  As shown in Figure 5, pass the wire rope through positioning ring, then place the end part of wire rope in retainer and lock it with retainer




## Install clothes rod and bed sheet rod

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- 1. As shown in Figure 6, remove screws from rod seat, align positioning holes on rod with rod seat, then fix with screws.
- 2. As shown in Figure 7 (SDR601-FA0 on the left, SDR601-FB0 on the right), unfasten end cover assembly of rods and mount each part in following order, screw plug, rod cover (clothes rod, bed sheet rod or adjustable rod), joint bar and fasten all with screw plug cap.



- 3. As shown in Figure 8, take bed sheet rod down when you need to dry
- 4. As shown in Figure 9, when the bed sheet rod is not needed, it can be folded and put back to rod seat.



## Remote control programming instruction

- ◆ Program the remote control before use it.
- Programming: unplug host power and replug it after 10 seconds, after which there will be a long beep. Following the beep, press "Up" and "Down" simultaneously and there will be 3 continuous beeps, indicating successful programming.
- Delete single code: unplug host power and replug it after 10 seconds, after which there will be a long beep. Following the beep, press "Down" and "Stop" simultaneously and there will be 3 continuous beeps, indicating the code has been deleted successfully.
- Delete all codes: unplug host power and replug it after 10 seconds, after which there will be a long beep. 10 seconds within the beep, press "P2" after which there will be 3 continuous beeps. Press "Stop" and there will be another 3 beeps indicating all codes of the remote control have been successfully deleted.

 $\bigwedge$  Attention: the "P2" button is inside battery box of the remote control. Remove battery cover to use it.

## **Function test instructions**

- Down: press "Down" and observe whether the drying rack stops running automatically after it descends about 1.1m.
- Up: press "Up" and observe whether the rack stops running automati-cally after it reaches to the top.
- Lighting: press "Lighting" and observe whether the LED lamp can turn on and off normally.  $\ \, \ \, \ \,$  Disinfection: press "Disinfection" and observe whether the UVC lamps work normally.
- Soft push to lift: push rod or rod seat of the drying rack with your hand, then let go and see whether the drying rack will rise.
- ♦ Hold to stop: when the drying rack is descending, hold up the rod or rod seat of the drying rack to observe whether it stops immediately.
