



4 开始使用

4.1 开 / 关机



注意

- 第一次使用机器时,请对该机器充电三小时以确保机器有 电工作!
- (1) 当机器处于开机状态, 电源开关拨到"①"位置3秒后, 本机立即自动关机。
- (2) 当机器处于关机状态,电源开关拨到"①"位置3秒后, 本机立即自动开机,然后显示"PHILIPS",如下图所示。



然后直接进入语音模式,短按"菜单键"进入语音模式设置。 长按"菜单键"进入应用选择设置。

4.2 充电方法

- (1) 使用 USB 数据线将本机与 PC 相连接。
- (2) 使用专用充电器充电。

当采用以上方法连接后,本机进入充电状态。电量指示标志 由空到满循环变化,表示本机现正处于充电状态,充电指 示灯橙色灯常亮。一般情况下,充满电需要3小时左右。 充满电时,电池符号显示满格,橙色灯灭。

4.3 连接电脑

录音笔可作为大容量的 USB 存储设备,并可方便地对文件进行存储、备份和移动。可使用 USB 数据线将录音笔与电脑相连,且无须安装软件,录音笔会自动显示为 VTR5101。

4.4 按键锁定





6.1 录音类型

在停止状态下,短按"菜单键"进入菜单列表选择录音类型,如下图所示:



按 荟 或 爻 键选择录音类型,按"菜单键"确认。 PCM录音: WAV 格式,高品质,比特率为 1536kbps。 降噪录音: WAV 格式,高品质,比特率为 384kbps。 立体声录音: MP3 格式,立体声,比特率为 128kbps。 标准录音: MP3 格式,标准,比特率为 32kbps。 长时间录音: MP3 格式,长时间,比特率为 8kbps。

6.2 声控设置

声控功能一旦被启用,录音过程中,当机器检测到有声音时,录音笔会自动开始录音;当未检测到声音时,将自动暂停录音; 再次检测到声音时,录音笔又会自动开始录音。在停止状态下,短按"菜单键"进入菜单列表选择声控设置,如下图所示:



在停止状态下,短按"菜单键"进入菜单列表选择定时录音 定时录音功能: 先预设一个时间,当系统时间到达预设时间时, 系统将会自动录音。

6.4.1 定时设置

在定时录音功能选项中,按 云 或 爻 键选择定时设置,短按"菜

单键"讲入定时设置,如下图:



在此状态下,按"AB键或者FW键"在年、月、日、时、分之间切换,设置状态下数字闪烁,再按 云 或 爻 键加减数值。按"菜单键"保存当前设置的时间。

6.4.2 录音音源



按 云 或 爻 键选择 "FM 录音" "MIC 录音",按"菜单键"确认。

6.4.3 录音时长

用于设置定时录音的时间长度,达到预设的时间长度自动保存录音。在定时录音功能选项中,按 云 或 爻 键选择录音长度短按"菜单键"讲入录音长度设置,如下图:



按 袤 或 爻 键选择录音时间长度设置,按"菜单键"确认。

6.5 分段录音

分段录音功能打开时,录音过程中到预设的分段时间会自动保 存并且开始下一段录音。

在停止状态下,短按"菜单键"进入菜单列表选择分段录音,如下图所示:



6.6删除

在停止状态下, 短按"菜单键"讲入菜单列表选择删除或删除 全部, 如下图所示:





按 云 或 爻 键选择 "YES" 或 "NO", 按 "菜单键"确认。

6.7 A-B 复读

在播放过程中,短按"AB复读键"(▲B)进入A-B复读模式, 并且确定复读起点 A, 此时屏幕显示 A \rightarrow B, 并且 B 闪烁, 如图 1; 再按一下"秦或圣键"确定复读终点B, 屏幕显示A→B, 开始复读, 如图 2: 再次按下 "AB 复读键" (\triangle **B**) 取消复读, A \rightarrow B 显示 消失,回到正常播放(如果不按"音量键"(√7)取消复读, 复读完5次后自动退出复读模式)。



6.8 循环模式

支持四种播放模式的切换, 包括目录播放、目录循环、单曲循 环和随机播放。在播放过程中,按"菜单键"在这四种播放模 式之间切换。

- : 目录播放,从当前文件播放到最后一个文件自动停止。
- 1 : 日录循环,表示当前文件夹内,全部文件重复播放。
- 11: 单曲循环, 只对当前播放的文件讲行重复播放。
- ※ : 随机播放, 当前文件播放完, 系统自动随机选择歌曲播放。

6.9 变速播放

播放 / 播放暂停状态下短按"菜单键"弹出列表, 再按"泵 或 翌 " 选择变速播放按菜单键确认, 弹出变速播放调整界面, 如下图。在此界面按"云 或爻"键选择变速播放的值,按"菜 单键"确认。



6. 10 音量调节

播放状态短按"音量键"进入音量调节,此时屏幕显示音量调节界面,如下图: 再按 荟 或 爻 键增加或减小音量,同时屏幕上的音量值也会相应的增减。



6.11 跟读语音

播放状态下短按 "FW键" 进入跟读语音界面,此时屏幕显示如图 1 所示: 在跟读语音界面录制跟读内容,录制完后按"播放键" 会自动回放跟读录制的内容,播放跟读语音界面如图 2 所示。播放完 后会自动停止,并回到语音播放界面继续播放当前文件。如图 3 所示。







跟读语音录制为 30 秒,录制过程中想提前中止录制时也可以按 "播放键"退出录制,进入跟读。

7 音乐模式

在语音模式的停止状态下,长按菜单键进入应用菜单界面,再按 ♂ 或 爻 键切换至音乐模式,按"菜单键"确认,如图所示。



在语音模式的停止状态下,长按"音量键"切换文件夹,按一下切换一个文件夹(A, B, C, D, music)。



音乐文件只能放在"MUSIC"文件夹里面进行播放。

- (10) 停止状态下,长按"菜单键"进入主菜单界面,短按"音量键" (▽)返回语音模式。

8 FM 模式

在音乐模式 / 语音模式的停止状态下,长按"菜单键"进入应 用菜单界面。短按 중 或 爻 键切换至收音机模式如图所示。



在 FM 模式界面,按"菜单键"确认。进入调频模式,调频模式 如图所示:

8.1 自动搜台

在调频模式下短按菜单键进入列表选择自动搜台,系统将会搜索电台,当一个电台被检测到时,这个电台将会被自动保存在 列表中。自动搜索完成,如下图所示:

8.1.2 切换电台

在FM收听切换保存电台,先短按"FW键",界面右上角会显示"CH" 图标表示可以进行保存电台间的切换了,接着按"泵/∑键" 切换保存电台。

8.2 保存电台

在调频模式下短按菜单键进入列表选择保存电台,手动保存电台,如下图所示:



按 云 或 爻 键选择要保存的电台,按"菜单键"确认。

8.3 音量

短按音量键"▽"进入音量调节界面,然后按 荟 或 爻 键调节音量。

8.4 FM 录音

在菜单列表选择 FM 录音,系统将会执行电台录音功能。电台录音的录音类型为默认的立体声录音类型。FM 录音界面,如下图 所示:



8.5 删除

在菜单列表选择删除电台功能,可以删除当前保存的某一电台, 或选择删除全部电台功能,可以删除所有保存的电台如下图所 示。



9.1 背光时间

背光时间有五种时长可供选择: 常亮, 15 秒, 30 秒, 45 秒, 60 秒。 如果在设定的时间内没对机器做任何操作, 背光将会自动关闭。 如果洗择"常亮", 背光常亮。

选择背光时间,短按"菜单键"确认,进入背光时间设置界面,如下图:



9.2 对比调节

用于设置屏幕对比度,可调范围 1-5,对比度值越大,背景显示越白:对比度值越小,背景越黑。

选择对比度调节,短按"菜单键"确认,进入对比度调节界面,如下图:



按 云 或 爻 键增减对比度数值,按"菜单键"确认。

9.3 自动关机

如果在设定的时间内没对机器做任何操作,系统将会自动关机,有五个选项可选择: 5 分钟、15 分钟、30 分钟、60 分钟和关闭。选择自动关机,短按"菜单键"确认,进入自动关机设置界面,如下图:



9.4 录音灯

选择录音灯,短按"菜单键"确认,进入录音灯设置界面,如下图:







4.1 Power On/Off



Note

- (1)When the machine is switched on, slid to '①' position for 3 seconds, the device will turn off automatically.
- (2)When the machine is turned off, slid to '() ' position for 3 seconds, the device will start automatically and then displays 'PHILIPS', as shown below.

- When the device is recording, please do not cut off the power, otherwise damaged file or malfunction may be resulted.
- When the battery indicator displays '——, please recharge the device promptly; when the battery is low, the indicator displays as below:



4.2 Battery charging

- (I) Connect the device to PC through USB cable.
- (2) Use dedicated charger to recharge.

When using the above methods to recharge, the device enters the charging status. The battery indicator shows a battery icon turning from empty to full repeatedly, indicating that the device is recharging, with the color of the indicator light being orange. Under normal circumstance, the device can be fully recharged in around 3 hours. The orange charging indicator will turn off and the battery icon displays full power, the device is fully recharged.

4.3 Connection to computer

The device can be used as a USB mass storage to conveniently store, back up and move files. Link the device to a computer with a USB cable, the voice recorder can automatically be recognized as VTR5101 without installing any software.



- While moving files into or out of the device, please do not disconnect the device from the computer.
- Connect the device to the computer via the USB slots at the back to backup files.

4.4 Keypad lock

(I)Slide up the POWER button to the lock position to lock all the buttons except the 'Record' key. Then the 'Lock lcon' will be displayed on the screen, as shown below.



(2)Slide the POWER button down to the middle position for canceling locking.






