
With this unit, you can enjoy audio from the iPod, other audio devices, or the radio. The radio, iPod, or buzzer can be set as the alarm timer. You can set two alarm timers to go off at different times.

Overview of the main unit

 - Set the alarm timer.

Connect power

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Caution

- Risk of product damage! Ensure that the power voltage corresponds to the voltage printed on the back or underside of the apparatus.
- Risk of electric shock! When you unplug the AC adaptor, always pull the plug from the socket. Never pull the cord.
- Before connecting the AC adaptor, ensure you have completed all other connections.



Note

- The type plate is located on the bottom of the main unit.
- 1 Connect one end of the AC adaptor to the DC IN socket on the main unit.



2 Connect the other end of the AC adaptor to the wall outlet.



Set clock

- 1 In standby mode, press and hold TIME SET/AUTO SCAN for 2 seconds.
 - → The hour digits begin to blink.
- 2 Press TUNING +/- to set the hour.
- 3 Press TIME SET/AUTO SCAN.
 - → The minute digits begin to blink.
- 4 Press TUNING +/- to set the minute.
- Fress TIME SET/AUTO SCAN to confirm.
 - ightharpoonup The week day digits begin to blink.
- 6 Press TUNING +/- to set the week day.
- 7 Press TIME SET/AUTO SCAN to confirm.

Turn on

- **1** Press 也.
 - → The unit switches to the last selected source.

Switch to standby

- 1 Press \emptyset again to switch the unit to standby mode.
 - → The clock (if set) appears on the display panel.

Adjust volume

1 During play, press VOL +/- to increase/ decrease the volume.

Play from iPod

You can enjoy audio from iPod through this unit.

Compatible iPod

Apple iPod models with a 30-pin dock connector:

 iPod classic, iPod touch, iPod nano, iPod 5th generation (video), iPod with color display, iPod mini.

Load the iPod

1 Push to open the dock compartment.





2 Place the iPod in the dock.



Remove the iPod

1 Pull the iPod out of the dock.

Listen to the iPod

- 1 Ensure that the iPod is loaded correctly.
- 2 Press SOURCE repeatedly to select iPod source.
 - → The connected iPod plays automatically.
 - To pause/resume play, press ►II.
 - To skip to a track, press I◀◀/▶▶I.
 - To search during play, press and hold I◄◄/▶►I, then release to resume normal play.

Charge the iPod

When the unit is connected to power, the docked iPod begins to charge.

Play from an external device

You can also listen to an external audio device through this unit.

- 1 Press **SOURCE** repeatedly to select MP3 link source.
- 2 Connect the supplied MP3 link cable to:
 - the MP3-LINK jack (3.5mm) on the back of the unit.
 - the headphone jack on an external device.

3 Start to play the device (see the device user manual).

5 Listen to radio



Note

Only FM radio reception is available on this unit.

Tune to a radio station



Tip

- Position the antenna as far as possible from TV. VCR or other radiation source.
- For optimal reception, fully extend and adjust the position of the antenna.
- 1 Press **SOURCE** repeatedly to select FM tuner.
- 2 Press and hold TUNING +/- for more than 2 seconds.
 - → The radio tunes to a station with strong reception automatically.
- **3** Repeat step 2 to tune to more stations.
 - To tune to a weak station, press TUNING +/- repeatedly until you find optimal reception.

Program radio stations automatically

You can program a maximum of 20 preset radio stations.

- 1 In the tuner mode, press and hold TIME SET/AUTO SCAN for more than 2 seconds to activate automatic program mode.
 - → All available stations are programmed in the order of waveband reception strength.
 - → The first programmed radio station is broadcast automatically.

Program radio stations manually

You can program a maximum of 20 preset radio stations.

- 1 Tune to a radio station.
- Press TIME SET/AUTO SCAN to activate the program mode.
 - → The preset number begins to blink.
- 3 Press PRESET +/- to select a number.
- 4 Press TIME SET/AUTO SCAN to confirm.
- 5 Repeat the above steps to program other stations.



Note

• To overwrite a programmed station, store another station in its place.

Select a preset radio station

1 Press PRESET +/- to select a preset number.

6 Other features

Set the alarm timer

You can set two alarms which go off at different time.

- 1 Ensure that you have set the clock correctly.
- Press and hold ALARM 1 or ALARM 2 for 2 seconds.
 - → ◀" or ◀" and hour digits begin to blink.
- 3 Press TUNING +/- repeatedly to set the hour.
- 4 Press ALARM 1 or ALARM 2 to confirm.

 → ◀□ □ or ◀□ □ and minute digits begin
 to blink

- **5** Repeat steps 3-4 to set the minute.
- 6 Repeat steps 3-4 to select whether to ring alarm on weekdays or at weekend. → "L XX(volume level)" begins to blink.
- 7 Repeat steps 3-4 to set the maximum alarm volume.

Set alarm mode

- 1 Adjust the WAKE TO iPod/RADIO/ BUZZ control to select the source for the alarm
 - → When the alarm time comes, the selected iPod, radio or buzzer turns on.



Tip

 If iPod source is selected but no iPod is loaded, the buzzer is selected automatically.

Activate and deactivate the alarm timer

- 1 Press ALARM 1 or ALARM 2 repeatedly to activate the timer.
 - → If the timer is activated, ¶ □ or ¶ □ is displayed.
 - To deactivate the alarm timer, press ALARM 1 or ALARM 2 repeatedly until is displayed.
 - If the timer is deactivated, ◄¹ □ or ◄¹ □ disappears.

Repeat alarm

- 1 When the alarm rings, press REPEAT ALARM/BRIGHTNESS CONTROL.
 - ightharpoonup The alarm repeats ringing minutes later.



Tip

• You can press **TUNING+/-** to adjust interval to repeat alarm.

Stop alarm ring

- 1 When the alarm rings, press the corresponding ALARM 1 or ALARM 2.
 - → The alarm stops but the alarm settings remain.

View the alarm settings

1 Press ALARM 1 or ALARM 2.

Set the sleep timer

This unit can switch to standby automatically after a set period of time.

- 1 Press **SLEEP** repeatedly to select a set period of time (in minutes).
 - When the sleep timer is activated, the display shows _zz^z.

To deactivate sleep timer

- 1 Press SLEEP repeatedly until [OFF] (off) is displayed.
 - When the sleep timer is deactivated, _{zz}z disappears on the display.



Note

 When the sleep timer is activated, the volume will gradually decrease.

Adjust display brightness

1 Press BRIGHTNESS CONTROL repeatedly to select different levels of display brightness.

No power

- Ensure that the AC power plug of the unit is connected properly.

No sound

Adjust the volume.

No response from the unit

 Disconnect and reconnect the AC power plug, then turn on the unit again.

Poor radio reception

- Increase the distance between the unit and your TV or VCR.
- Fully extend the FM antenna.

Timer does not work

- Set the clock correctly.
- Switch on the timer.

Clock/timer setting erased

- Power has been interrupted or the power plug has been disconnected.
- Reset the clock/timer
