





Prepare the docking speaker

Pull the stand upwards from the unfixed end.



Connect power




Caution

Built-in Battery

To recharge the built-in battery:

Connect the unit to the power supply.

Turn on

Slide $\mathbf{0}$ on the docking speaker to the ON position.

→ The LED indicator turns on.

The speaker turns to standby mode when there is no audio detected for over 15 minutes.



Load the iPod/iPhone

1 Insert your iPod/iPhone into the dock.



To remove the iPod/iPhone

• Pull your iPod/iPhone out of the dock.

Listen to the iPod/iPhone

Charge the iPod/iPhone

When the docking speaker is connected to wall power outlet, the docked iPod/iPhone begins to charge.



 You can also charge your iPod/iPhone through the built-in battery.

Play from an external device

You can also listen to an external audio device through this docking speaker.

- 1 Connect the MP3 link cable to:
 - the audio in socket (3.5mm) on the back of the unit.
 - the headphone jack on an external device.
- 2 Start to play on the device (see the device user manual).



Adjust volume level

- During play, press VOL +/- to increase or decrease the volume level.
- Slide DBB to the right to turn dynamic bass boost on.
