

### What's in the box



In multihandset packs, you will find one or more additional handsets, battery doors, chargers with power supply units and additional rechargeable batteries.

WARNING: Always use the line cord, power supply and batteries that came with your phone.



1. Place the base station in a central location near the telephone line socket and electricity socket.






- Connect the line cord and the power cable to their corresponding connectors at the back of the base station.
- 3. Connect the other end of the line cord and power cable to their respective sockets.

#### Adjust earpiece or speaker volume

During a call, scroll to select from level 1 to level 5.

#### Set the ring tone

There are 15 ring tones available on your handset.

- 1. Press menu, scroll to Personal Set, and press Select.
- Scroll to Handset Tones and press Select, then scroll to Ring Tones and press Select.
- 3. Scroll \$\infty\$ to your desired melody. The melodies will play as you scroll to them.
- 4. Press Select to set the ring tone.

A validation tone is emitted and the screen returns to the previous menu.

#### Store a contact in the phonebook

- I. Press Phonebook is highlighted; press Select.
- 2. New Entry is highlighted: press Select.
- Enter Name is displayed. Enter the name of the contact (maximum 14 characters) and press OK.
- Enter Number is displayed. Enter the number (maximum 24 digits) and press OK.
   A validation tone is emitted.

#### Access phonebook

- I. Press <sup>Ph.Book</sup> and scroll ⊕ to browse the phonebook.
- 2. To view the details, press View.

#### Call from the phonebook

- Press Ph.Book in idle mode.
   Scroll to a phonebook entry.
- 3. Press
  - The call is initiated.

#### Listen to messages recorded on the answering machine (for SE455 only)

Press (an on the base station to turn on the answering machine if it was off (the message counter is turned on). The outgoing message is played. Press (play/stop) on the base station to play phone messages (the first recorded message will be played first).

Press (skip) to skip the current message and play the next message.

Press repeat to go back to the previous message (if pressed within I second of current message playback). Press (spear) to replay current message (if pressed after I second of current message

playback). Press (- + to adjust speaker volume during message playback.

Press (erase) to delete the current message.

Long press (erase) to delete all old messages.

Press (an again to turn off the answering machine (the message counter is turned off). Refer to your User Manual for details about the answering machine functions.

### **Troubleshooting**

#### **Problem**

#### Solution

- · There's no dialling tone!
- · No power: Check the connections.
- Batteries are empty: Charge the batteries.
- Move closer to the base station.
- · Wrong line cord used: Use the line cord provided.
- Caller does not hear me clearly!
- · Move closer to the base station.
- Move the base station at least one metre (yard) away from any electronic appliances.
- Searching... is displayed on handset and in icon is blinking!

Caller number is not

displayed!

- · Move closer to the base station.
- · Make sure that your base station is on.
- · Reset your unit and restart handset registration.
- Service is not activated: Check your subscription with your network operator.
