

What's in the box



Note


- In multi-handset packs, there are additional handsets, chargers and power adapters.
- ** In some countries, you have to connect the line adapter to the line cord, then plug the line cord to the telephone socket.

Caution

• Use only the supplied batteries and power adapter.




Connect the base station



- 1 Connect each end of the power adapter to:
 - the DC input jack at the bottom of the base station;
 - the power socket on the wall.
- **2** Connect each end of the power adapter to (for multi-handset packs):
 - the DC input jack at the bottom of the extra handset charger.
 - the power socket on the wall.
- 3 Connect each end of the line cord to:
 - the telephone socket at the bottom of the base station;
 - the telephone socket on the wall.



Install the handset



- **1** The batteries are pre-installed in the handset. Pull the battery tape off from the battery door before charging.
- 2 Place the handset on the base station to charge the handset. When the handset is placed correctly on the base station, you hear the docking sound.
 - → The handset starts charging.

Note Charge the batteries for 16 hours before first use.

Configure your phone (if necessary)

- 1 When you see the welcome message, press **OK**.
- 2 Select your country, press OK to confirm.
- 3 Set the date and time.
 - → If the time is in 12-hour format, press 🐙 key to select **[AM]** or **[PM]**.
 - ightarrow The phone is now ready to use.

Check the battery level





When the handset is off the base station/charger, the bars indicate the battery level (full, medium and low). When the handset is on the base station/charger, the bars keep scrolling until charging completes.

D

The empty battery icon flashes and you hear an alert tone.

The battery is low and needs recharging.



Call

- To make a call, press \backsim and dial the phone number.
- To answer a call, press \smile when the phone rings.
- To end a call, press 📇

Adjust the earpiece volume

Press $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{1}{2}$ to adjust the volume during a call.


Add a contact in the phonebook

- 1 Press MENU.
- 2 Select [PHONEBOOK] > [NEW ENTRY], then press OK to confirm.
- 3 Enter the name then press **OK** to confirm.
- 4 Enter the number, then press OK to confirm.

Record an announcement (for SE175 only)

- 1 Press MENU.
- 2 Select [ANSW MACHINE] > [ANNOUNCEMENT], then press OK to confirm.
- 3 Select [ANSW.&RECORD] or [ANSWER ONLY], then press OK to confirm.
- 4 Select [RECORD], then press OK to confirm.
- **5** When **[RECORDING]** displays, start recording close to the microphone.
- 6 Press OK to stop recording.
 - → You can listen to the newly recorded announcement on the handset.

Listen to messages recorded on the answering machine (for SE175 only)



 Switch on/off the answering machine: Press Start/Stop listening to the recorded messages: Press >=. (2)(3) Adjust the volume: Press + / -. (4) Skip backward: When you listen to the messages, press 🖊 to listen to the message from the beginning. During the first second of the current message, press *k* to listen to the previous message. (5) Skip forward: Press ▶ to skip to the next message. (6) Delete the current message: Press X.
