# **General information**

# Warnings


### Care of the cabinet

#### B. LED

# Over view of the speaker

- 1.  $\oplus$  Power on/off and Source selection.
- •Turn the speaker on or off with long press.
- Select source by short pressing Bluetooth/Audio in/FM (Audio in/FM is available only when stereo cable is connected) /USB (USB is available only when USB is inserted.)

# Get started

- Place the speaker on a flat surface.
- Charge the built in battery
  - Notes for charging
  - a) Before use, fully charge the built in battery.
  - b) The micro USB socket is for charging only.
  - c) Rechargeable battery has a limited number of charge cycles.
- Battery life and number of charge cycle vary by use & settings.
- Connect the USB cable between DC in socket on the speaker and USB socket of a computer.

# Bluetooth pairing

- $\bullet$  Long press " $\Phi$  " to turn on the unit, speaker enters in Bluetooth mode, blue LED will quickly flash.
- •Turn on Bluetooth device like mobile, computer and search the Bluetooth name "PHILIPS BT122 "
- Press pair in the device to connect with the speaker, when enter pairing mode it will give out a "Beep" sound while it will give out double "Beep" sound after pairing successfully.
- •Blue light will stop flashing. (Normally no need to provide password, if needed just put " 0000" as the password.)
- •After pairing successfully, the device will connect with speaker automatically next time.
- •Long press ">II \" for 3 seconds to disconnect current device, speaker enters in pairing mode.

# Audio in

- Connect a stereo cable (audio input cable) on both ends to
- Audio in socket of speaker
- •The headphone socket on the external device
- Insert stereo cable to enter audio in mode. Without stereo cable, speaker cannot go into audio in mode.

# USB

•Insert USB, short press "  $\oplus$  " button to choose USB mode, at the same time LED change to light blue. (the speaker cannot convert to USB mode if USB is not fully inserted.)

# FM

Connect and audio stereo cable (Audio cable) and press "⊕", speaker will go in FM mode and LED will flash blue & green alternatively. Long press "▶II↓", speaker will go in search mode & save all FM channels from 87.5 to 108Hz. "-" or "+" with short press will select desired channel. Without Audio cable, speaker cannot go into FM mode.

### Charging

Connetc one side of the micro USB charging cable with the speaker, the other side connected with computer

or a standard charger with 5V 1A for charging.

The speaker inside install over-charging protective circuit, which can be connected to computer or charger for long time, charging time is 5-7 hours.

Working time will depend on the volume user sets up.

#### Handfree phone call function

Blue light will flash when there is an incoming call, the speaker will also come out with 'Beep' sound, press button " $\vdash II \setminus$ " to anwer the phone call. pressing "-"/ "+" to decrease or increase volume, press " $\vdash II \setminus$ " to disconnect.

#### Low power

When it comes to low power, the speaker will come out with "Beep" sound, at the same time volume will be decreased to keep perfect playback, please charge in time, the speaker will shutdown for no power. If you are not using the speaker for long time, ensure that it is being fully charged once every month in order to protect the battery.

#### Warning -

Under no circumstances should you try to repair the system yourself, as this will invalidate the warranty. Do not open the system as there is a risk of electric shock. If a fault occurs, first check the points listed below before taking the system for repair. If you are unable to remedy the problem by following hints mentioned in below table, Consult your dealer or PHILIPS APSC for help.

Problem	Solution
1. No power.	Charge the unit by using USB charging cable.
2. No sound or distorted sound.	Adjust the volume / select the correct source to choose the equipment that you want to hear through the system.
3. Low hum or buzz sound.	Place the product as far away as possible from electrical devices that may be causing interference.
4. No response from the speaker.	Restart the speaker.
5. The audio quality is poor after connection with Bluetooth enabled device.	Move the device closer to this product or remove obstacle between them.
6. Cannot connect with the device.	This product is already connected with another Bluetooth enabled device. Disconnect that device and then try again.
