







What's in the Box?

You should find these items upon opening the box.














Step A Connect

In standby or view clock mode, press **CLOCK*TIMER** once. In other source mode, press **CLOCK*TIMER** twice.


Press

or

repeatedly to set the hour.

Press or repeatedly to set the minute.

Press CLOCK•TIMER again to store the setting.





Playing a disc

Press OPEN•CLOSE to open the disc tray and load up to two discs on the individual disc trays. To load the third disc, press DISC CHANGE.

→ Make sure the label side of each loaded disc is facing up.


Press OPEN•CLOSE again to close the disc tray.



Use DSC 1/2/3 (or CD 1/2/3 on the remote control) to select a disc for playback and then press ► II to start playback.

To stop playback, press **STOP** ■.





Programming and tuning to radio stations




Press **TUNER** to select the tuner source.

Press PROGRAM for more than two seconds to program all available stations in order of waveband.

Press or until the desired preset station is displayed.





Playing a USB mass storage device

With the Hi-Fi system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this Hi-Fi system).

- Insert the USB device's USB plug into the USB DIRECT *> socket on the set.
- Press **USB** to select the USB source.
- Play the USB's audio files as you do with the albums/tracks on a CD.

Ripping function

- Insert a USB device with sufficient free space to the USB DIRECT ** socket on the set.
- Prepare the source to record from.
- Press USB RECORD to start ripping.
- At any moment, simply press **STOP** to stop ripping.
