Bluetooth Operating Instruction

1. Press " 1 on the front panel or SOURCE on the remote to go to Bluetooth;

2. When select the Bluetooth mode, in display, "bt." starts blinking/flashing.;

3. For pairing with mobile or other Bluetooth devices, search the device named "Philips MMS2200B" and pair it. Once paired, "bt." stops blinking/flashing;

4. Press " ▶I "for continuous 3 seconds from remote in order to force disconnect the Bluetooth.

Note: While using Bluetooth, if external call comes, then speaker system goes in mute mode in order to protect privacy of mobile phone user. Operation resumes once the call is disconnected.

Troubleshooting

Warning -


Problem	Solution
1. No power.	Check if the AC power cord is properly inserted into the AC mains socket.
2. No sound or distorted sound.	Adjust the volume / select the correct source to choose the equipment that you want to hear through the system.
3. The remote control does not function properly.	Reduce the distance between the remote control and the system. Replace the batteries with new ones / Point the remote control directly towards the IR sensor (located on front panel of the subwoofer) / Check that the batteria are loaded correctly / Switch off the system for 30 seconds and then restart
4. Low hum or buzz sound.	Place the product as far away as possible from electrical devices that may b causing interference / Check power supply voltage and consult electrician.
The content of the USB flash drive can not be read.	The USB flash drive format is not compatible with the system. Drive is formatted with a different file system which is not supported by this unit (e.g. NTFS
 Slow operation of the USB flash drive / can not detect USB flash drive. 	Large file size of high memory USB flash drive takes longer time to read and play. / Take out USB drive and insert it again properly.
7. FM not properly tuned.	Match with local frequency.
8. FM reception not good.	While listening radio turn off TV / DVD or other radiation source.
9. BT not working.	Reduce the distance or device is not paired.

- 2 Mute: Press "MUTE " to activate or deactivate mute.
- 3.0-9: Numeric keys with the help of these keys you can select song or track in USB*. In FM, you can key in frequency. i.e. 927 for 92.7.
- 4. SOURCE: AU for audio in. Cd for CD in. 106.4 for FM. bt for Bluetooth. OP for optical.
- 5. BASS-/+: To decrease/increase the bass
- 6. SELECT: Press "SELECT" each time to change LED effect (LED1-LED6-LEDF).
- (works only in USB*/BT mode)
- 7. VOL+: Volume up.
- 8. M/SCN: Short press To play or to pause songs. Long press " M " in FM mode, it will automatically search and save channels. For manual storage, user can press frequency (eg. 106.4) and press " ▶ " station number will flash press " ▶ " or " ▶ " to choose the serial, press " ▶ " again to store the station.
- 9. ♥: Play the previous song by pressing "♥" at USB*/BT mode. Choose previous channel by pressing " **K**" at FM mode. 10. ▶: Play the next song by pressing "▶" at USB*/BT
- mode. Choose next channel by pressing " ▶ " at FM mode.

- 12. TUNE-: To search channel step by step (each step- 0.1 MHz), press "TUNE-" and hold to search previous
- channel, it will stop and play once previous channel been searched. 13. TUNE+: To search channel step by step (each step+ 0.1 MHz).
