## Call from the phonebook

- I. Press m in idle mode.
- 2. Select a phonebook record you want to call.
- 3. Press 🕑 key to dial out the call.

## ECO mode

The ECO mode reduces the transmission power of the handset and base station. I. Press MENU.

- 2. Select ADV. SETTING > ECO, then press OK to confirm.
- 3. Select the new setting, then press  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{OK}}$  to confirm.

The setting is saved.

**ECC** is displayed instead of  $\blacklozenge$  in standby mode.

 $\bar{\mathsf{W}}$  When the ECO mode is activated, the connection range between the handset and the base station can be reduced.

- Listen to messages recorded on the answering machine (for XL665 only) Press (a) on the base station to turn on the answering machine (the message counter is turned on).
- Press B again to turn off the answering machine (the message counter is turned off). Press O on the base station to play phone messages (the first recorded message will be played first).
- Press  $\searrow$  to skip the current message and play the next message.
- Press 💌 once to replay current message.

Press twice to go back to the previous message.

Press - + to adjust speaker volume during message playback.


