


Install battery

- 3 Close the battery compartment.




Placement

You can place the unit on a flat surface or hang it in your bathroom through the strap.



The strap is detachable.



Turn on

Press \odot to turn on the radio.

Switch to standby mode

Press 🖒 again to switch to standby mode.

Set time

- In standby mode, press and hold TIMER for 3 seconds.

 → The hour digits blink.
- 2 Press +/- to adjust the hour.
- 3 Press TIMER to confirm
 - → The minute digits blink.
- 4 Press +/- to adjust the minute.
- 5 Press TIMER to confirm.

4 Listen to radio

Select FM/MW waveband

- 1 Press \circlearrowleft to turn on the radio.
- 2 Press and hold BAND for 3 seconds to select FM or MW waveband.

Tune to a radio station

- 1 In tuner mode, press TUNE.
 - \mapsto [FM] or [MW] begins to blink,
- $\begin{tabular}{ll} \bf 2 & {\sf Rotate} \begin{tabular}{ll} \tt O & {\sf clockwise} \end{tabular} or {\sf counter-clockwise} \end{tabular} to tune to a radio station. \end{tabular}$
- 3 Press TUNE again to confirm.

Program radio stations automatically



Note

 You can program a maximum of 20 preset FM radio stations and 20 preset MW radio stations.

In tuner mode, press and hold \circ for 2 seconds.

- → All available stations are programmed in the order of waveband reception strength.
- → The first programmed radio station broadcasts automatically.

Program radio stations manually

- 1 In tuner mode, tune to a radio station.
- Press and hold PRESET for 3 seconds.
 - → The number begins to blink.
- 3 Rotate Φ to select a preset number.
- 4 Press PRESET to confirm.
- 5 Repeat steps 1 4 to program more stations.



To overwrite a programmed station, program another station in its place.

Select a preset radio station

In tuner mode, press +/- to select a preset radio station.

Set the sleep timer

The clock radio can be turned off automatically after a preset period of time.

Press TIMER repeatedly to select a time period (in minutes).

To turn off the sleep timer:

Press TIMER repeatedly until [OFF] (off) appears or press \odot .

 O is displayed when the sleep timer is on and disappears when it is off.
