



### 3 Use your speaker


1 Open the battery compartment and insert 3 AAA batteries with correct polarity (+/-) as indicated.



- 2 Close the battery compartment.
- 3 Connect your device to the speaker.




- 4 Slide the switch to turn the speaker on.

- 5 Adjust the volume and navigate your audio content on your device.
- 6 After use, disconnect your device from the speaker and slide the switch to turn the speaker off.
