


Playing the speakers and subwoofer

User manual



System positioning:

The subwoofer is recommended to be put on the floor to get a better acoustic effect.

For best possible surround sound, all the speakers (except subwoofer) should be placed at the same distance from the listening position.

Place the front left and right speakers at equal distances from the TV and at an angle of approximately 45 degrees (horizontal) from the listening position.

Helpful Hint


To avoid magnetic interference, do not position the speakers, too close to your TV.

General information

Bluetooth Operating Instruction

- 1. Press SOURCE key from subwoofer's front panel or remote control to Bluetooth mode;
- 2. When selecting the Bluetooth mode. "." of "bt." in display will start blinking and you will hear an audio tone which indicates Bluetooth pairing mode. 3. For pairing with mobile phone or other Bluetooth devices, search the device named "Philips MMS8090" and
- pair it. Once paired, "." of "bt." slowly flash and come up with another audio tone. "." of "bt." will stop flash when playing music
- 4. Press and hold " ▶II" for 3 seconds from remote control in order to force disconnect the Bluetooth connection

Note: While using Bluetooth, if external call comes, then speaker system goes in mute mode in order to protect privacy of mobile phone user. Operation resumes once the call is disconnected.


Care of the cabinet

Under no circumstances should you try to repair the system yourself, as this will invalidate the warranty. Do not open the system as there is a risk of electric shock. If a fault occurs, frist check the points listed below before taking the system for repair. If you are unable to remedy the problem by following hints mentioned in below table

Subwoofer back panel

Problem	Solution	
1. No power.	Check if the AC power cord is properly inserted into the AC mains socket.	
2. No sound or distorted sound.	Adjust the volume / select the correct source to choose the equipment that you want to hear through the system.	
The remote control does not function properly.	Reduce the distance between the remote control and the system. Replace the batteries with new ones / Point the remote control directly towards the IR sensor (located on front panel of the subwoofer) / Check that the batteries are loaded correctly / Switch off the system for 30 seconds and then rstart.	
4. Low hum or buzz sound.	Place the product as far away as possible from electrical devices that may be causing interference / Check power supply voltage and consult electrician.	
5. The content of the USB flash drive cannot be read.	The USB flash drive format is not compatible with the system. Drive is formatted with a different file system which is not supported by this unit (e.g. NTFS).	
6. Slow operation of the USB flash drive / cannot detect USB flash drive.	Big memory size USB flash drive will take longer time to read and play. / Take out USB drive and insert it again properly.	
7. FM not properly tuned.	Match with local frequency.	
8. FM reception not good.	While listening radio turn off TV / DVD or other radiation source.	
9. BT not working.	Reduce the distance or device is not paired.	


Top & Back panel operation

In FM/AUDIO mode, short press to mute.


long press to go to semi-auto search. After auto-search, short press to go to previous station.

USB*/BT mode: play/pause, BT mode: press and hold 3 seconds to disconnect BT.

FM mode: press and hold 3 seconds to go to auto search. OP/AU/CD mode: press once to mute, display flash to remind. press again to unmute, display not flash.
