



- I. Place the base station in a central location near the telephone line socket and electricity socket.
- 2. Place the base station face down so that you can see the bottom of the base station. Attach the base support to your base station by fitting the tabs of the base support into the corresponding slots on the base unit. Push into place until a click sound is heard.
- 3. Connect the line cord and the power cable to their corresponding connectors at the bottom of the base station as shown.
- 4. Connect the other end of the line cord to the telephone line socket and the other end of the power cable to the electricity socket.



- 3. To dial a number from the phonebook, scroll (*) to the phonebook entry and press (**).
