
- Push the source selector to a TUNFR

3 Playing a disc


This player plays Audio Discs including CD-R/CD-RW, and MP3-CD.

IMPORTANT: For a disc with CD Audio tracks and MP3 files, only the CD audio tracks will be played.

- a Adjust the **source selector** to CD/MP3.
- b Open the disc door.
- c Insert a disc with the printed side facing up and close the door.
- d Press PLAY/PAUSE ►II to start playback.
- e To stop disc playback, press ■.

Source selector

Slide to select function: CD/MP3-CD or radio.

VOLUME \

Turn to adjust olume level.

K

LIFT TO OPEN

Lift to open the disc door.

Press to stop disc playback, or erase a disc program.

PLAY/PAUSE

Press to start or pause disc playback..

ALBUM+ (up) For MP3-CD c/ilv: Press to select albums

MODE

Press to select different play modes, such as **REPEAT or SHUFFLE** (random order)

TUNING

Turn to tune to a station.

BAND

Slide to select waveband

Telescopic antenna Improves FM reception.

SEARCH

Briefly press to skip to


the beginning of the current/previous/ later disc track: During disc playback, press and hold to find a particular passage backward/forward.
