Warnings

- Avoid sustained periods on high-volume use, and do not turn the volume to maximum level while using high output signal, such as Mobile Phone or DVD, etc., as this will cause distortion and may damage the loudspeaker cones.
- Please switch off the system from the wall socket, when not in use.
- Do not open the cover or back panel to avoid electrical shock or any other accidents. No userserviceable parts are inside.
- Only for indoor use.
- Plug the system to the AC outlet with the right voltage marked on the back panel of the Subwoofer.
- The MAINS plug is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.

Accessories

- The product shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the product.
- Batteries shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.
- Attention should be drawn to the environmental aspects of battery disposal.

Care and safety information Avoid high temperatures, moisture, water and dust

- Apparatus should not be exposed to dripping or splashing of liquid.
- Do not place any source of danger on the Subwoofer, and satellite (e.g. liquid filled objects lighted candles).
- · Do not install near heat sources.

Do not block any ventilation opening



Care of the cabinet


 Use a soft cloth slightly moistened to clean the cabinet.



- 1. ϕ : Power or standby mode.
- 2. AUX: Audio in input mode selection.
- 3 USB: USB reader mode selection when enter into USB* mode
 - "▶" means next song; "I◄" means previous song;
 - "NI" means play/pause. press the number " 0-9 " on the remote control. your can choose the Corresponding song, Press " → TUNE+" select one song or all the songs repeating play. (only in USB* mode)
- 4. Press "EQ TUNE-" each time to search FM station step by step (each step (-) 0.1 MHz), press "EQ TUNE-" long time to search previous channel, and play the channel automatically.
 Equalizer: NORMAL. POP. CLASSIC. ROCK. JAZZ. (only in USB*/BT* mode)
- 5. Press VOL+ to increase volume.
- 6. Pressing "I◀ " takes you to previous song/station.
- 7. Press VOL- to decrease volume.
- 8. By pressing the number "0-9" on the remote control you can choose the corresponding song or corresponding FM channel.
- 9. Mute: Turn volume off. Press again to activate sound.
- 10. FM: FM tuner mode selection. When you enter FM mode and press " I "for long time, it searches FM station/channel automatically.
- 11. For pairing with mobile or other Bluetooth devices, search the device named "MMS2141B" and pair it. Once paired, '•'of " bt." stops blinking/flashing. Press "▶I" for 3 seconds, Bluetooth function can be forced disconnected. '•'of " bt." flashes slowly when song is playing.
- 12. Press " → TUNE+" each time to search FM station step by step(each step 0.1 MHz), press " → TUNE+" long time to search next channel, and play the channel automatically.
- 13. Pressing " № " plays/pauses songs alternately.
- 14. Pressing " ▶ " takes you to next song/station.

Bluetooth Operating Instruction

- 1. Press SOURCE key from front panel or remote to go to Bluetooth;
- 2. When selected the Bluetooth mode, in display, '•' of "bt." starts blinking/flashing.;
- 3. For pairing with mobile or other Bluetooth devices, search the device named "MMS2141B" and pair it. Once paired, '•' of "bt." stops blinking/flashing;
- 4. Press " || "for continuous 3 seconds from remote in order to force disconnect the Bluetooth.

Note: While using Bluetooth, if external call comes, then speaker system goes in mute mode in order to protect privacy of mobile phone user. Operation resumes once the call is disconnected.

Troubleshooting

Warning -

Under no circumstances should you try to repair the system yourself, as this will invalidate the warranty. Do not open the system as there is a risk of electric shock. If a fault occurs, first check the points listed below before taking the system for repair. If you are unable to remedy the problem by following hints mentioned in below table. Consult your dealer or PHILIPS APSC for help.

Problem	Solution
1. No power.	Check if the AC power cord is properly inserted into the AC mains socket.
2. No sound or distorted sound.	Adjust the volume / select the correct source to choose the equipment that you want to hear through the system.
The remote control does not function properly.	Reduce the distance between the remote control and the system. Replace the batteries with new ones / Point the remote control directly towards the IR sensor (located on front panel of the subwoofer) / Check that the batteries are loaded correctly / Switch off the system for 30 seconds and then restart.
4. Low hum or buzz sound.	Place the product as far away as possible from electrical devices that may be causing interference / Check power supply voltage and consult electrician.
5. The content of the USB flash drive can not be read.	The USB flash drive format is not compatible with the system. Drive is formatted with a different file system which is not supported by this unit (e.g. NTFS).
6. Slow operation of the USB flash drive / can not detect USB flash drive.	Large file size of high memory USB flash drive takes longer time to read and play. / Take out USB drive and insert it again properly.
7. FM not properly tuned.	Match with local frequency.
8. FM reception not good.	While listening radio turn off TV / DVD or other radiation source.
9. BT not working.	Reduce the distance or device is not paired.
