A

Audio digital

AVCHD adalah format (standard) bagi kamera video definisi tinggi yang dapat digunakan untuk merakam dan memainkan imej HD resolusi tinggi.

B

BONUSVIEW

BonusView, juga dikenali sebagai "Profile 1.1". Selain daripada ciri main balik asas dan interaktif, pemain BonusView yang diperkenalkan selepas 31hb Oktober, 2007 membolehkan pengguna untuk menikmati 'Gambar dalam Gambar' (PiP) dan ciri audio kedua (berguna ketika memainkan permainan yang menggunakan strim audio tambahan semasa video sedang dimainkan) pada cakera BonusView yang serasi.

C

Cakera Blu-ray (BD)

Cakera Blu-ray adalah cakera video optik generasi masa hadapan yang mampu menyimpan lima kali ganda jumlah data daripada DVD biasa. Kemampuan besar ini memungkinan kita mendapat faedah daripada ciri seperti video definisi tinggi, bunyi surround berbilang saluran, menu interaktif dan sebagainya.

D

DivX Video-Atas-Permintaan

Peranti DivX Certified® inib mesti didaftarkan supaya kandungan DivX Video-atas-Permintaan (VOD) dapat dimainkan. Untuk menjana kod pendaftaran, cari bahagian DivX VOD dalam menu persediaan peranti anda. Dolby Digital

Sistem bunyi keliling yang dibangunkan oleh Dolby Laboratories yang mengandungi sehingga enam saluran audio digital (bahagian depan kiri dan kanan, keliling kiri dan kanan, tengah dan subwoofer.)

DTS

Digital Theatre Systems. Sistem bunyi keliling untuk menyediakan 5.1 saluran audio digital berasingan dalam produk elektronik pelanggan dan kandungan perisian. Ia tidak dibangunkan oleh Dolby Digital.

H

HDCP

Perlindungan Kandungan Digital Lebar Jalur Tinggi (HDCP). Ini adalah spesifikasi yang memberikan penghantaran selamat kandungan digital antara peranti yang berlainan (untuk mengelakkan hak cipta yang tidak diizinkan.)

HDMI

Antara Muka Multimedia Definisi Tinggi (HDMI) adalah antara muka digital kelajuan tinggi yang boleh memindahkan video definisi tinggi dan audio berbilang saluran digital yang tidak dimampatkan. Ia menyampaikan gambar berkualiti tinggi dan kualiti bunyi, bebas dari hingar sepenuhnya. HDMI adalah serasi-undur sepenuhnya dengan DVI. Seperti yang diperlukan oleh standard HDMI, menyambungkan ke produk HDMI atau DVI tanpa HDCP (Perlindungan Kandungan Digital Jalur Lebar Tinggi) akan menyebabkan tiada output Video atau Audio.

J

JPEG

Format gambar pegun digital yang sangat lazim. Sistem pemampatan data gambar pegun yang dicadangkan oleh Joint Photographic Expert Group, yang mencirikan pengurang kecil dalam kualiti imej berbanding dengan nisbah pemampatannya yang tinggi. Fail dikenali mengikut sambungan failnya 'jpg' atau 'jpeg'.

K

Kod rantau

Sistem yang membenarkan cakera dimainkan hanya dalam rantau yang diperuntukkan. Unit ini hanya memainkan cakera yang mempunyai kod rantau yang serasi. Anda boleh menemui kod rantau unit anda pada label produk. Sesetengah cakera adalah serasi dengan lebih daripada satu rantau (atau SEMUA rantau.)

L

LAN (Rangkaian Kawasan Tempatan)

Sekumpulan peranti yang dipautkan dalam syarikat, sekolah atau rumah. Menandakan sempadan rangkaian tertentu.

M

MP3

Format fail dengan sistem pemampatan data bunyi. MP3 adalah singkatan kepada Motion Picture Experts Group 1 (atau MPEG-1) Audio Layer 3. Dengan format MP3, satu CD-R atau CD-RW boleh mengandungi lebih kurang 10 kali lebih data berbanding CD biasa.

N

Nisbah aspek

Nisbah aspek merujuk kepada nisbah panjang kepada tinggi skrin TV. Nisbah TV standard adalah 4:3, sementara nisbah TV definisi tinggi atau TV lebar adalah 16:9. Kotak huruf membenarkan anda untuk menikmati gambar dengan perspektif lebih lebar pada skrin standard 4:3.

P

PBC

Kawalan Main balik. Sistem di mana anda menavigasi menerusi Video CD/Super VCD dengan menu pada skrin yang dirakam pada cakera. Anda boleh menikmati main balik dan carian interaktif.

PCM

Modulasi Kod Denyut. Sistem pengekodan audio digital.

Penyimpanan tertentu

Kawasan simpanan ini digunakan sebagai destinasi untuk menyimpan kandungan tambahan dari BD-Live didayakan BD-Video.

W

WMA

Windows Media™ Audio. Merujuk kepada teknologi mampat audio yang telah dibangunkan oleh Microsoft Corporation. Data WMA boleh dikodkan dengan Windows Media player versi 9 atau Windows Media player untuk Windows XP. Fail dikenali dengan sambungan fail 'wma.'
