

3 Get started

Place

HMP8100 works with the supplied **uWand** remote control. For good navigation and interaction experience, do the following:

1 Place **HMP8100** as shown:



2 If necessary, reduce the distance and angle between **HMP8100** and the remote control.




Tip

- The remote control is using an absolute pointing mechanism which aims at giving an intuitive and predictable experience and enabling faster interaction with the user interface of the player. The cursor always shows on the expected screen position for each angular orientation, even returning from out of the screen. There is no calibration needed as a reference point is always broadcast at the hidden transmitter of the player and therefore the player should be placed in a visible area close to the TV for the best pointing experience.

Install

Connect to your HDTV




- Through an HDMI cable, connect **HMP8100** to a high-definition TV (HDTV).

Connect to an external audio system


For high quality audio, you can connect **HMP8100** to your sophisticated audio system.

Through **R AUDIO L**:






Switch on or off

- 1 To switch on **HMP8100**,
 - ① Connect **HMP8100** to power.
 - ② On the remote control, press **⏻** to switch on.
↳ The power indicator lights up green.



- 2 On the TV, switch to the input source of **HMP8100**:
 - On the remote control of your TV, use the source button to select the input channel of **HMP8100**.



- 3 To switch **HMP8100** to standby mode, press $\text{\textcircled{P}}$ again on the remote control.
↳ The power indicator lights up red.

First-time setup

The first time you use **HMP8100**, do the following setup:

- Select the menu language on **HMP8100**;
- Set up the screen display on your TV;
- Connect **HMP8100** to your home network through an Ethernet cable or Wi-Fi.
- Log in to your Google account.

Follow onscreen instructions to select your options:



To change your setup options later,



Set up the screen display




Set up the network

Connect **HMP8100** to a router (Access Point) through an Ethernet cable or through Wi-Fi. You can connect **HMP8100** to the network that is built around the router.


To connect to the Internet, make sure that the router connects to the Internet directly and no dial-up is required on the computer.

To skip the Ethernet or Wi-Fi setup screen, click **Next**.





Connect through an Ethernet cable

- 1 Use an Ethernet cable to connect **HMP8100** to the router.



- 2 On **HMP8100**, click **Ethernet Configuration**. Select **ON** to switch on the Ethernet connection.
 - ↳ A pop-up screen is displayed for you to set up the network connection through the Ethernet cable.



To use an IP address that the router assigns automatically,

- Select **DHCP**.
↳ **HMP8100** starts to acquire an IP address.



Tip

- If the DHCP (Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol) is unavailable or disabled on the router, manually enter the IP address of the player.

To enter the IP address of the player manually,



- 1 Get the IP address of the router:
 - Consult the user manual of the router; or
 - To check for the settings of the router, enter the IP address (for example, 192.168.1.1) in the web browser (for example, Internet Explorer) of the computer. Get the information in the setup page.
- 2 On **HMP8100**, select **Static IP**. Assign the IP address manually.

- On the player, enter an IP address that allows the player to be in the same subnet as the router:
For example, if the router has
IP address: 192.168.1.1, Subnet mask: 255.255.255.000;
Then, enter the following on the player:
IP address: 192.168.1.XX (where XX denotes a number), Subnet mask:
255.255.255.000.

Connect through Wi-Fi



- 1 On **HMP8100**, click **Wi-Fi Configuration**.
- 2 Select **Wi-Fi settings**.
- 3 Select the option to switch on the Wi-Fi function.
↳ You see a list of Wi-Fi networks in range.



4 Connect HMP8100 to a network:


- ① In the list of Wi-Fi networks, select an option.
- ② On the pop-up screen, enter the password to the network.
 - ↳  is displayed in the status bar when the Wi-Fi connection is completed successfully.
 - ↳ Next time you switch on HMP8100, HMP8100 connects to the previously connected network automatically.



Note

- If MAC address filtering is enabled on your router, add the MAC address of **HMP8100** to the list of devices that are allowed to join the network. To find the Wi-Fi MAC address, go to **Settings > About MediaBox > Status** on the Home screen.
- To refresh the list of networks, select **Scan** at the upper-right corner of the screen.
- If you have disabled SSID broadcasting or hidden the Service Set Identifier (SSID) of the router, manually enter the SSID or public name for the network. Go to **Settings > Wi-Fi**. On the top bar, select **+**.
- If the DHCP (Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol) is unavailable or disabled on the router, manually enter the IP address of **HMP8100**.



Install batteries into the remote control

- ② Insert two AAA batteries (1,100 mA) with correct polarity (+/-) as indicated.

Calibrate the remote control

With the supplied **uWand** remote control, you can navigate and select on **HMP8100** as you do with a mouse on a computer:

- 1 Make sure that you have placed HMP8100 properly (see 'Place' on page 10).
- 2 Go to  **Setupwizard**.
- 3 Follow the onscreen instruction to calibrate your remote control.



Tip

- If the Game mode is available on your TV, select the mode to reduce the picture processing time and allow the cursor to move more smoothly.
- To pair a new uWand remote control with HMP8100, refer to "Troubleshooting" (see 'Troubleshooting' on page 48).
- You can also use a wireless mouse with HMP8100.





Text entry

With the onscreen keyboard, you can enter text in multiple languages.

 - Android keyboard:** for multiple languages other than Chinese

- 2 To switch between text input methods during text entry:

Enter text





 - Make sure that the page isn't filled.

- 3 Select and hold an icon or widget until the page is displayed.
 - ↳ The icon or widget is added to the selected page.

Delete items

- 1 Select and hold an item to unlock.



- 2 Drag the item to **x**.

Relocate items

- 1 Select and hold an item to unlock.
- 2 Drag the item to a space on a page.
- 3 Release the item.
 - ↳ The item moves to the space.

Play from online services

Connect **HMP8100** to the Internet. You can enjoy online services on the HDTV.

Install apps

On **HMP8100**, you can install apps from

-  (**Play Store**) over the Internet; or
- other sources, such as other online sources, the internal storage of **HMP8100**, and the USB storage device and SD/SDHC card that you have mounted onto **HMP8100**.

Play Store

1 Log in to or create your Google account to access Google services. To add a Google account, do the following:

- ① Go to  (**Play Store**). Tap  > **Accounts**.



- ② Select **Add account**.
- ③ Follow onscreen instructions to add an account.

2 Search for apps as needed.

- Tap  for keyword search.

3 Download the app:

- Tap the app. Confirm as needed.
 - ↳ When the downloading is complete, installation starts automatically.
 - ↳ Check the status bar to find the status. If necessary, tap the icon to start installation as prompted.



Tip

- To manage your accounts, go to  **Settings** > **ACCOUNTS**. Tap an account to select your options.

Other sources

Allow the installation from unknown sources

- Go to  **Settings** > **Security**. Switch on **Unknown sources**.

Download/ transfer the apps

- To download the apps from online sources, follow the onscreen instructions;
- To transfer the apps from a PC, save the apps to an SD/ SDHC card. Then, mount the memory card onto **HMP8100**.

Start installation

- The downloaded apps start installation automatically. Or, start installation as prompted.
- To find the apps on **HMP8100** or the SD/ SDHC card, go to  **ES File Explorer**. Find the app and select the option to start installation.

Manage apps

You can manage apps on **HMP8100** and the SD/ SDHC card, for example, install/ uninstall apps, stop running apps, or select other options.

1 On the Home screen, press  on the remote control.

- ↳ The options menu is displayed.



2 Select **Manage apps**.



Play movies from a mass storage device

Through the HDTV, play movies from a mass storage device that you connect to **HMP8100**. The mass storage device can be:

- a USB mass storage device,
- an SD/ SDHC card.



- 1 Connect your mass storage device to **HMP8100**:
 - For a USB mass storage device, connect to  on **HMP8100**.
 - Insert an SD/ SDHC card to the **SDHC** slot.
- 2 Go to  **MoviePlayer**. Then, select  or .
- 3 Select a file to start play.

Play media from a PC or NAS device (DLNA)



- 1 Make sure that you have connected **HMP8100** PC to the same network as the PC or Network Attached Storage (NAS) device.
 - Make sure that the UPnP (Universal Play and Plug) function is enabled on the router.
- 2 On the PC, launch the software of DLNA media server. Enable the media sharing function.
- 3 On **HMP8100**, select **Media Center > Media Player**.
 - Find media files on the PC or NAS device.
- 4 Use the remote control to search for and play media files on **HMP8100**.

6 Use the device in corporate networks

You can use **HMP8100** in corporate networks. Install the secure credentials or security certificates before you access corporate networks.

The access to corporate network may allow you to set up your Microsoft Exchange account and add VPN on the device. With the Microsoft Exchange account, you can access your exchange mailbox at work.

Install secure credentials

Ask your network administrator for secure credentials or security certificates.

To install the secure credentials,

- 1 Make sure that you transfer the files of secure credentials from a PC to the SD/ SDHC card that you have mounted onto the device.



Note

- On **HMP8100**, make sure that the secure credentials are saved to the root directory of the SD/ SDHC card, instead of under a folder.

- 2 Install the secure credentials:
 - ① Go to  **Settings** > **Security** > **Install from SD card**.
 - ② Select the file to start installation.
 - ③ Set the password and name for the credentials as prompted.

To apply the secure credentials,

- 1 In  **Settings**, select **Security** > **Trusted credentials**.
- 2 Make sure that the credential is selected.
 - ↳ On **HMP8100**, you allow the apps to use the secure credentials.

Set up your Microsoft Exchange account

- 1 Go to  **Email**.
- 2 Set up your email account:
 - Enter the information about your account, and select **Exchange** as the account type.
 - If you have set up other email accounts, select  > **Settings** on the screen of mail list. Select **Add account**.
- 3 Follow the onscreen instructions to complete the setup.
 - For the server address, enter the web address for your Outlook web access, for example, owa.company name.com or mail. company name. com/owa.
 - For other setup information, such as domain name, user name, check with your system administrator.



Note

- The device can work with Microsoft Exchange 2003 and 2007.

Add VPN

Virtual private network (VPN) allows you to connect to private networks through secure access.

Sometimes, you need VPN access to connect to corporate networks.

To add VPN on the device

- 1 Ask your network administrator for the configuration information.
- 2 From the Home screen, go to  **Settings** > **WIRELESS & NETWORKS** > **More** > **VPN**.
- 3 Configure the VPN as prompted.
- 4 Install the secure credentials as needed.

To connect to the VPN,

- 1 Make sure that you have connected **HMP8100** to the Internet.

- 2 Go to  **Settings** > **WIRELESS & NETWORKS** > **More**.
↳ A list of VPNs is displayed.
- 3 Select the VPN to start connection.

7 Settings

To select your settings,

- 1 At the base of the screen, click an icon of setup status. On the pop-up screen, select .
 - Alternatively, go to  **Settings** from the Home screen; or
 - On the Home screen, press  on the remote control. Select **System settings** from the options menu.
- 2 Use the remote control to select options.

WIRELESS & NETWORKS

Wi-Fi

In WIRELESS & NETWORKS > Wi-Fi, select your Wi-Fi settings on the device (see 'Set up the network' on page 14).

Network notification

Switch on **Network notification**. At the base of the screen,  is displayed when an open Wi-Fi network is available.

- 1 In **Wi-Fi**, select **ON** to switch on.
- 2 At the top bar, select  > **Advanced** > **Network notification**.



Portable hotspot

HMP8100 can work as a Wi-Fi hotspot. Through HMP8100, you can have your wireless devices connected to the Internet.

To connect to the Internet through HMP8100,

- 1 Connect **HMP8100** to the Internet.
 - 2 In **Portable hotspot**, select the checkbox to switch on **Portable Wi-Fi hotspot**.
 - 3 Go to **Set up Wi-Fi hotspot** to check and edit the network name (SSID) and password.
 - 4 On your wireless devices, search for and connect to **HMP8100**.
-

Ethernet

In **WIRELESS & NETWORKS > Ethernet**, select the settings for network setup through an Ethernet cable (see 'Set up the network' on page 14).

DEVICE

Sound

In **Sound**, select sound settings for **HMP8100**.

Volume

- Select the volume level for media and notifications.

Click sounds

- Select your click sounds on the screen.

Digital audio output

- If you use TV speakers for audio output, select **PCM**.
- If you use external amplifier for decoding, select **SPDIF passthrough** or **HDMI passthrough**.

Equalizer

- Select your equalizer options for the sound output.
 - The function may not be supported by some apps that you install on **HMP8100**.

Display

In **Display**, select your display settings:

Wallpaper

- Set the wallpaper of the device.

Application request to change orientation

- Allow you to select whether to change the orientation of the display.

Sleep

- After the selected time duration, the screen switches off automatically.

Output mode

- Select the video resolution that your TV supports. See your TV manual for details.

HDMI auto output mode

- Allow the output resolution to match the best resolution of your TV automatically.

Display position

- Position the screen display as needed.

Font size

- Select font size for the onscreen display.

Storage

In **Storage**, learn the space information about the internal memory on your **HMP8100**.

Apps

In **Apps**, manage the apps on **HMP8100** and the SD/SDHC card. You can install/uninstall applications, or select other options.

Security

Device administrators

Apps in corporate networks require the rights of device administrator, such as the email under your Microsoft Exchange account.

Before you uninstall such an application, disable the rights of device administrator:

- In **Device administrators**, select an app.
 - ↳ The rights of device administrator are disabled.

↳ You cannot sync data for the application.

Unknown sources

On **HMP8100**, you can install applications that you download from  (Play Store), or from sources other than .

- For the apps from sources other than , select **Unknown sources** to allow installation on **HMP8100**.

Language & input

Language

In **Language**, select the language for the onscreen instructions of **HMP8100**.

Personal dictionaries

In **Personal dictionaries**, add or remove words or phrases to/ from the user dictionary. You can customize the word suggestions that are displayed on the pop-up screen during your text entry on the Android keyboard.

To add a word or phrase,

- Select **+** to add a word or phrase.

To edit a word or phrase,

- 1 Select the word or phrase.
↳ A pop-up screen is displayed.

- 2 Edit the word or phrase.

To remove a word or phrase,

- 1 Select the word or phrase.
- 2 Select .

Keyboard & Input methods

In **KEYBOARD & INPUT METHODS**, select your input methods. To switch between text input methods during text entry, click  at the base of the screen.



Mouse/Trackpad

On **HMP8100**, you can install a wireless mouse. The wireless mouse can work as the remote control.

In **Pointer speed**, set the speed for the pointer of the mouse.

uWand remote control

On your TV screen, calibrate the cursor of your uWand remote control.

reset
