

Playing the speakers and subwoofer



System positioning:

The subwoofer is recommended to be put on the floor to get a better acoustic effect.

For best possible surround sound, all the speakers (except subwoofer) should be placed at the same distance from the listening position.

Place the front left and right speakers at equal distances from the TV and at an angle of approximately 45 degrees (horizontal) from the listening position.

To avoid magnetic interference, do not position the speakers, too close to your TV.







- 2. NI/SCAN


FM mode: long press to auto search and store radio stations. In FM/AUDIO mode, short press to mute.

Troubleshooting

	Joint on
No power.	Check if the AC power cord is properly inserted into the AC mains socket.
No sound or distorted sound.	Adjust the volume / select the correct source to choose the equipment that you want to hear through the system.
The remote control does not function properly.	Reduce the distance between the remote control and the system. Replace the batteries with new ones / Point the remote control directly towards the IR sensor (located on front panel of the subwoofer). Check that the batteries are loaded correctly / Switch off the system for 30 seconds and then restart.
Low hum or buzz sound.	Place the product as far away as possible from electrical devices that may be causing interference / Check power supply voltage and consult electrician.
The content of the USB flash drive cannot be read.	The USB flash drive format is not compatible with the system. Drive is formatted with a different file system which is not supported by this unit (e.g. NTFS).
Slow operation of the USB flash drive / cannot detect USB flash drive.	Big memory size USB flash drive will take longer time to read and play. / Take out USB drive and insert it again properly.
BT not working.	Reduce the distance or device is not paired.
