


What's in the Box?

You should find these items upon opening the box.







Connect the FM antenna.

Connect the AC power cord of the system.

Setting the clock

IMPORTANT!

– To set clock in the Eco Power mode, press and hold ECO POWER/ STANDBY-ON \bigcirc on the set for 3 seconds or more to switch to normal standby mode first before proceeding with the procedures below.

In standby mode, press and hold **CLOCK/RDS** on the remote control. \Rightarrow SET CLBEK is displayed briefly. Then, the clock digits for the hours flash.

Press ■ on the remote control to select clock mode. → " 12 TD 24 HDUR" or "24 TD 12 HDUR" scrolls once. Then, the clock digits for the hours continue to flash.

Adjust **VOLUME** -/+ (or press **VOL** +/- on the remote control) to set the hours.

Press CLOCK/RDS again. → The clock digits for the minutes flash.




Adjust **VOLUME** -/+ (or press **VOL** +/- on the remote control) to set the minutes.

Press CLOCK/RDS to confirm the time.

Playing a USB mass storage device

With the Hi-Fi system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this Hi-Fi system).

Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket + on the set.

Press SOURCE once or more (or USB/AUX on the remote control) to select USB.


Play the USB's audio files as you do with the albums/tracks on a CD.

Programming and tuning to radio stations

Press **SOURCE** on the front panel repeatedly (or **FM** on the remote control) to select the FM source.

Press **PROG** for more than two seconds to program all available stations.

Press ALBUM/PRESET ▼ or ▲ until the desired preset station is displayed.





Playing iPod using the dock

- 1 Select the correct dock adaptor supplied, then snap the adaptor into the dock connector (iPod) to provide a snug fit for the player.
 - The indication on the adaptor's back fits specific iPod player.
- **2** Correctly place your player in the dock connector.
- 3 Connect the cables of the dock to **DOCK IN** jacks on the main set correspondingly.
- Press SOURCE on the set repeatedly (or iPod on the remote control) to select iPod source.
 The connected player will play automatically.
 - The iPod battery will be charged in either normal standby mode or power-on mode. The charging will not be available in the Eco power standby mode.
