


### What's in the Box?


Connect the FM antennas.


Connect the composite video cable to a TV.


Connect the power cords of the system and TV.







(A) To listen to the sound of this DVD Player through your TV, use the audio cables (white/red-not supplied) to connect **LINE OUT** (**L/R**) jacks of the DVD Player to the corresponding AUDIO IN jacks on the TV.



B To listen to the sound of your TV through this DVD player, use a cinch cable (not supplied) to connect LINE-IN on the front panel of the DVD player to the corresponding AUDIO OUT jacks on the TV.

# Step B Setup

## Setting up the TV

Press SOURCE (DISC on the remote) to select disc source.

Turn on the TV and set it to the correct Video In channel.





# Setting the clock

Important!

- To set clock in the Eco Power mode, press and hold ECO POWER/STANDBY-ON on the set for 3

seconds or more to switch to normal standby mode first before proceeding with the procedures below.

In standby mode, press and hold **CLOCK** on the system.


When the hour digits flash, turn the **VOL** control on the front panel or press **VOL** +/- on the remote to set the hours.

Press CLOCK again and the minute digits flash. Then turn the VOL control on the front panel or press VOL +/- on the remote to set the minutes.

4

Press CLOCK again to confirm the time setting.



#### Before using the remote control

1 Pull out the plastic protective sheet.


2 Select the source you wish to control by pressing one of the source select keys on the remote control (for example CD,TUNER).


3 Then select the desired function (for example ► II , ◄ ,►►)



# Playing a disc



Press OPEN•CLOSE ≜ to open the disc tray and load in a disc, then press the same button again to close the disc tray.

→ Make sure the label side of the disc is facing up.



Playback will start automatically. If not press ▶ 11.



To stop playback, press .

# Programming and tuning to radio stations

Press **SOURCE** (**TUNER** on the remote) to select tuner source.



Press PROG/ANGLE for more than two seconds to program all available stations in order of waveband.

Press PRESET 
✓ I until the desired preset station is displayed.

# Playing a USB mass storage device

With the Hi-Fi system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this Hi-Fi system).



Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket • on the front panel of the main set.



Press **SOURCE** (or **USB** on the remote control) once or more to select **USB**.



Play the USB's audio files as you do with the albums/tracks on a CD.
