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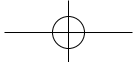

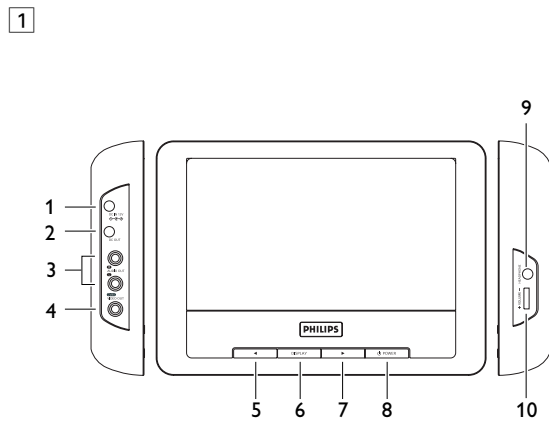

2 General information

Power Sources

This unit operates on a supplied AC adaptor or car adapter.

- Make sure that the input voltage of the AC adaptor is in line with the local voltage. Otherwise, the AC adaptor and unit may be damaged.
- Do not touch the AC adaptor with wet hands to prevent electric shock.
- When connecting with car power (cigarette lighter) adaptor, be sure the input voltage of the adaptor is identical with car voltage.
- Unplug the AC adaptor from the outlet or remove the battery pack when the unit is not used for long periods of time.
- Hold the plug to disconnect the AC adaptor. Do not pull the power cord.

Hearing Safety

Listen at a moderate volume.

- Using headphones at a high volume can impair your hearing. This product can produce sounds in decibel ranges that may cause hearing loss for a normal person, even for exposure less than a minute. The higher decibel ranges are offered for those that may have already experienced some hearing loss.
- Sound can be deceiving. Over time your hearing "comfort level" adapts to higher volumes of sound. So after prolonged listening, what sounds "normal" can actually be loud and harmful to your hearing. To guard against this, set your volume to a safe level before your hearing adapts and leave it there.

To establish a safe volume level:

- Set your volume control at a low setting.
- Slowly increase the sound until you can hear it comfortably and clearly, without distortion.

Listen for reasonable periods of time:

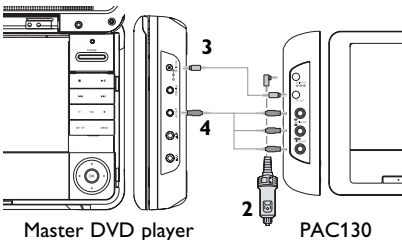
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3 Connection

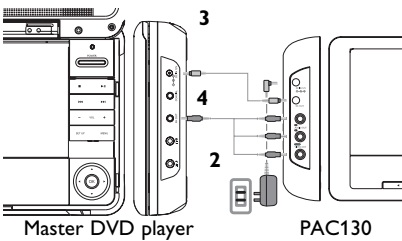
Make sure that the master DVD player; slave LCD screen and any other electrical equipment are off before connection.

- 2 Connect the car adapter power plug to the PAC130
- 3 Connection the power source to the master DVD with the power cord
- 4 Connection the video and audio signal to the devices

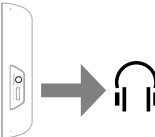
3.2 Use at home



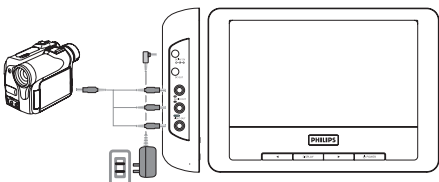
- 1 Connect the AC/DC adapter power plug to the PAC130
