Programming and tuning to radio stations

Press **SOURCE** (TUNER on the remote) to select tuner source.

Press and hold **PROG** for more than two seconds to program all available stations in order of waveband.

Press $|\langle \rangle$ until the desired preset station is displayed.

Playing a USB mass storage device

With the system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this system).

Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket \bullet on the front panel of the main set.

Press **SOURCE** once or more (or **USB/AUX** on the remote control) to select **USB**.

Play the USB's audio files as you do with the albums/tracks on a CD.
