
Philips Portable DVD Player PET941D

Quick start guide

1 Charge your battery

This portable DVD player is designed with a built-in lithium battery to supply power to the player when you are on travel.

1 Slide the **POWER** switch to the **OFF** position (charging of the DVD player only possible in the power-off mode).





- 2 Connect the supplied power adaptor cord (or the car adaptor) to the player and AC mains (or the car cigarette lighter outlet) to start charging.
 - → The CHR indicator turns red.
 - → When the battery is fully charged, the indicator turns off.
- 3 Disconnect the power adaptor cord (or the car adaptor) when the CHR indicator turns off.

Note:

 You can also connect the supplied power adaptor cord (or the car adaptor) to the player and AC mains (or the car cigarette lighter outlet) directly wherever possible.

² Enjoy (Disc operation)



- 1 Open the lid of the player.
- 2 Slide the **POWER** switch to **ON** to switch on the DVD player.
 - → The ^① indicator turns on.
- 3 Slide **OPEN**▶ on the player.
- 4 Remove the protective card (if any) and load a disc with the label side facing up.
- **5** Close the disc door.
 - → Playback will start automatically. If not, press
 ▶II.
- **6** To stop playback, press ■.

Note:


During play, you can:

- Press OPTION to select some play options: audio, subtitle, repeat, and time display.
- Press directly to adjust brightness of screen backlight to match lighting conditions.

² Enjoy (AV OUT)

Connecting additional equipment (TV for example)

- Connect the AV OUT socket on the set to the video and audio sockets on a TV as shown directly.
- 2 Switch on the TV and set to the correct videoin channel.
- → You can consult the owner's manual of your TV. (If your TV does not have Audio and Video inputs, you will need to purchase a RF modulator. Please consult your dealer.)
