




Playing the speakers and subwoofer



System positioning:

The subwoofer is recommended to be put on the floor to get a better acoustic effect.

For best possible surround sound, all the speakers (except subwoofer) should be placed at the same distance from the listening position.

Place the front left and right speakers at equal distances from the TV and at an angle of approximately 45 degrees (horizontal) from the listening position.


Helpful Hint

To avoid magnetic interference, do not position the speakers, too close to your TV.

- The MAINS plug is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.



Bluetooth Operating Instruction


- I. Press SOURCE key from subwoofer's front panel or remote control to Bluetooth mode:
- 2. When selected the Bluetooth mode. in display. "bt" will start blinking and hear an audio tone which indicate in Bluetooth pairing mode.
- 3. For pairing with mobile phone or other Bluetooth devices, search the device named "Philips MMS2260B" and pair it. Once paired, "bt" stops blinking and an audio tone will come up.
- 4. Press and hold "►N " for 3 seconds from remote control in order to force disconnect the Bluetooth connection.

Note: While using Bluetooth, if external call comes, then speaker system goes in mute mode in order to protect privacy of mobile phone user. Operation resumes once the call is disconnected.





1. U ---- Turn on/Stand-by the speaker.

- 2. Mute---- Press "MUTE" to activate or deactivate mute.
- 3. 0-9 ---- Numeric keys, with the help of these keys you can select song or track in USB*. In FM, you can key in frequency, i.e. 927 for 92.7
- 4. SOURCE ---- Select the input/source- AU for Audio-in. Cd for CD. Ud for USB*. Sd for SD*. 88.3 for FM. bt for Bluetooth.
- 5. BASS-/+ ---- To decrease/ increase the bass.
- 6. EO ---- Normal. Pop. Rock, Jazz, Classic, Country mode. (works only in USB*/SD*/BT mode)
- 7. VOL+ ---- Volume up.
- 8. M ---- Short press To play or to pause songs. Long press "M" in FM mode, it will automatically search and save channels. For manual storage, user can press frequency (eg. 106.4) and press " M ", station number will flash, press " M " or " M " to choose the serial, press " | " again to store the station.
- 9. M ----- Play the previous song by pressing "M" at USB*/BT mode. Choose previous channel by pressing "N" at FM mode.
- 10. ► ----- Play the next song by pressing " T at USB*/BT mode. Choose next channel by pressing "▶" at FM mode.
- 11. VOL- ---- Volume down.
- 12. TUNE- ---- Each time to search channel step by step (each step- 0.1 MHz), press "TUNE-" and hold to search previous channel, it will stop and play once previous channel been searched.
- 13. TUNE+ ---- Each time to search channel step by step (each step+ 0.1 MHz), press "TUNE+" and hold to search next channel, it will stop and play once next channel been searched.

Problem	Solution
1. No power.	Check if the AC power cord is properly inserted into the AC mains socket.
2. No sound or distorted sound.	Adjust the volume / select the correct source to choose the equipment that you want to hear through the system.
The remote control does not function properly.	Reduce the distance between the remote control and the system. Replace the batteries with new ones / Point the remote control directly towards the IR sensor (located on front panel of the subwoofer) / Check that the batteries are loaded correctly / Switch off the system for 30 seconds and then restart.
4. Low hum or buzz sound.	Place the product as far away as possible from electrical devices that may be causing interference / Check power supply voltage and consult electrician.
5. The content of the USB / SD flash drive cannot be read.	The USB / SD flash drive format is not compatible with the system. Drive is formatted with a different file system which is not supported by this unit (e.g. NTFS).
6. Slow operation of the USB / SD flash drive / cannot detect USB / SD flash drive.	Big memory size USB / SD flash drive will take longer time to read and play. / Take out USB / SD drive and insert it again properly.
7. FM not properly tuned.	Match with local frequency.
8. FM reception not good.	While listening radio turn off TV / DVD or other radiation source.
9. BT not working.	Reduce the distance or device is not paired.
