



- **3** Press LOC/DX to select tuner sensitivity: [LOCAL] (local): Only station with strong signal can be broadcast. **[DX]** (distance): Stations with strong and
- weak signals can be broadcast. 4 Press I or ►►I to tune to a radio station manually.
- \rightarrow The radio station is broadcast.
- To search for radio station automatically, press I≪ or ▶▶I for 3 seconds.

Insert USB device 6




Insert SD/MMC card 7

- 2 Insert the SD or MMC card into the card slot.
- → The unit starts playing from the SD/MMC card automatically.

Control play

- To skip to a track, press I or ►►I.
- To search within a track, press I or ►► for 3 seconds.
- To pause, press **1**>**II**. To resume, press **1**, II again.


