

Make sure you have all these items in the box. For missing item(s), contact your dealer.


In multi-handset packs, you will find additional handsets, chargers, power supplies, and batteries.



Warning:

Always use the cables and batteries provided in the box.

1 Connect




- Insert the plug of the power cord into the socket on the bottom of the base station.
- Insert the plug of the line cord into the socket on the bottom of the base station.
- Plug the power supply unit into your power outlet.
- Plug the line cord into the line socket.

Install

Always use rechargeable batteries.


Insert batteries



- Place the two rechargeable batteries (included) into the battery compartment.
- Slide the battery door firmly into place.

Only use rechargeable batteries

Charge handset for 24 hours



If the batteries are completely exhausted, the handset will not be able to power-on immediately. Handset may get warm during initial charge. This is normal.

Make a call

Answer a call

Press and dial the number.

Press .

TIP: You can predial the number before seizing the line.

During a call, press (spk) to turn on and off the handset loudspeaker.

Adjust the audio volume while on line End a call

Press † or _ to increase or decrease the audio volume.

Press .

Set the handset ring melody in standby mode

- 1. Press and hold (spk) until you see the current melody name.
- 2. Select the desired melody by pressing digit keys 0 to 9.
- 3. Press (spk) to confirm.

Change the ringing volume in standby mode

- 1. Press and hold (spk) until you see the current melody name.
- 2. Press (*) or (-) to increase or decrease the volume level.
- 3. Press (spk) to confirm.

If the ringing volume level is set to \mathbf{OFF} , \mathbf{x} appears.

Save a name and a number in a direct access memory

- 1. Enter the number in standby mode.
- 2. Press and hold one of the direct memory keys or m2 or m3.
- 3. Enter the name.
- 4. Press and hold the same memory key to save the name.

Save a name and a number in an extra memory

- 1. Enter the number in standby mode.
- 2. Press and hold one of the digit keys (1 to 9).
- 3. Enter the name.
- 4. Press and hold the same digit key to save the name.

To insert a pause press and hold (#), P is is shown.

View phonebook memory

Press one of the direct memory keys (m) or (m2) or (m3)

OR

press and hold one of the digit keys (1 to 9).

The name and number will be shown.

Call from phonebook memory

Press while viewing a memory. The saved number is dialed.

If the number is longer than 12 digits, only the last 12 digits are shown on display.

Troubleshooting

For detailed overview see user manual.

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• No dial tone.

Tip

- Check the connections.
- Use the line cord provided in the box.

Poor audio quality.

- Try to place the base station at least one metre away from any electrical appliances.
- No symbol on the display.
- Make sure the product is plugged.
- Charge the batteries.
- The handset does not charge.
- Check base/charger connections.
- Check that the batteries are inserted correctly.
- Caller ID does not display.
- Caller ID service may not be activated. Check with your service provider.
