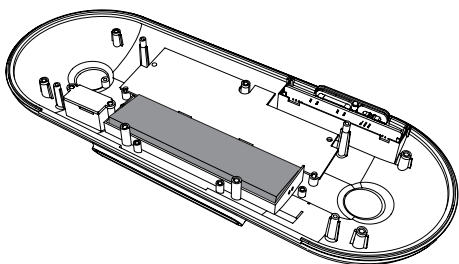

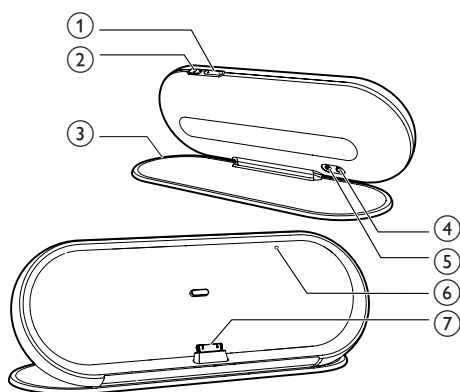

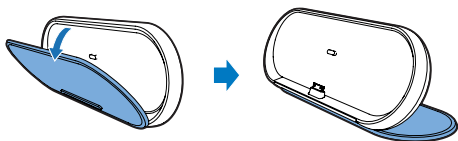

Prepare the docking speaker

- Open the front lid and flip it over as a stand.



Connect power

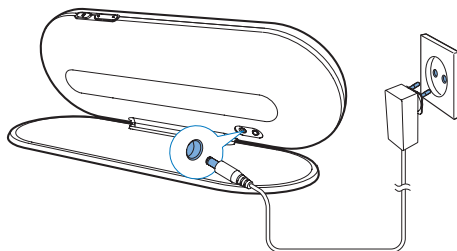


Caution

Built-in Battery

The docking speaker can also operate on built-in rechargeable battery.

To recharge the built-in battery:


- Connect the unit to the power supply.

Turn on

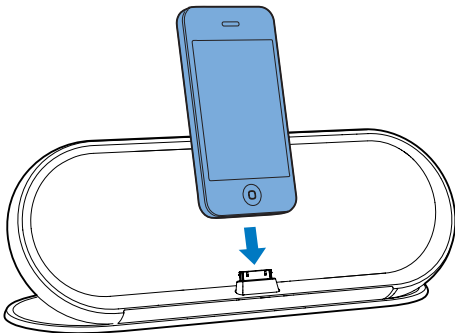

Load the iPod/iPhone

To remove the iPod/iPhone

- Start music play in your iPod/iPhone.
 - ↳ You can hear music from this docking speaker.

Charge the iPod/iPhone

When the docking speaker is connected to wall power outlet, the docked iPod/iPhone begins to charge.

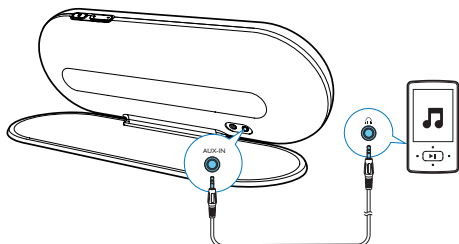

No power

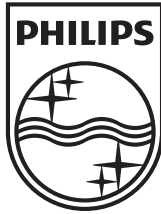
- Make sure that the docking speaker is fully charged.
