

You should find these items upon opening the box.







To deactivate the *Demonstration Mode

*The Demonstration Mode displays various features of MCM760.

Press and hold ■ on the set until DEMO OFF appears



Rear connections





Tuner: Plug & Play

Plug & Play allows you to store all available radio stations automatically (up to 40 stations).

Connect the set to the power supply → RUTO INSTALL – PRESS PLAY appears

- Press **II** on the set to start installation
- → INSTALL TUNER AUTO appears
- → After all stations are stored, the last preset station will then be played

Press the 🛛 or 🕨 buttons once or more until the desired preset station is displayed

Step B Prepare

Setting the clock

On the remote control, press and hold **DISPLAY/CLOCK** until the clock time starts flashing

Press **PROGRAM** repeatedly to change between 12-hour and 24-hour clock mode

Press ◀◀ or ▶▶ repeatedly to set the hour



Press **II** to change to minutes setting, then press **I** or **I** repeatedly to set the minutes

Press **DISPLAY/CLOCK** again to store the setting



To view the clock time,

- a. During playback, press **DISPLAY/CLOCK** on the remote control
- b. In ECO POWER mode (power-saving mode), press and hold STANDBY-ON/ ECO POWER ⊕ to switch the set to standby mode

Helpful hints:


- To learn how to set the timer, see the chapter Timer in the User Manual.
- In standby mode, pressing DISPLAY/CLOCK button will switch the system to ECO POWER mode.



Notes for remote control: - First, select the source you wish to control by pressing one of the source select keys on the remote control (DISC or TUNER, for example). - Then select the desired function

 $(\blacktriangleright II, \bowtie, \blacktriangleright)$ for example).





Playing a USB mass storage device

With the Hi-Fi system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this Hi-Fi system).

Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket + on MCM760

Press **USB** to select **USB** source


Play the USB's audio files as you do with the albums/tracks on a CD











Press **to** stop recording

To find your recorded tracks

You can find and playback the ripped tracks in the album **PHILIPS**

Press USB to select USB source


- Press \blacktriangleleft / \blacktriangleright and \mid / \triangleright to select the desired album _PHILIPS and tracks → The audio CD files have been converted to MP3 format and named as TRXXXXXX.MP3
- → For MP3/WMA files, the track information are retained

Helpful hints:

- MCM760 only supports the filenames in English.
- Only the completely ripped MP3/WMA file can be found and played by MCM760.










