


You should find these items upon opening the box.






# Connection

- **1** For radio reception, connect the supplied FM antenna to the **FM ANTENNA** terminal.
- 2 Connect the speaker wires to the **SPEAKERS** terminals.
- **3** Connect the power cord of the system to the AC power outlet.








# Playing an iPod

Correctly dock your iPod portable player in the cradle.

### 2 Select iPod source.

- Playback starts automatically.
- Press ▶II to start playback, if the iPod is in sleep mode or pause mode.



## Programming and tuning to radio stations

- 1 Select **FM** source.
- 2 Press **PROGRAM** on the remote control for more than two seconds to program all available stations in order of waveband.
- 3 Press I → I on the set (ALBUM/PRESET +/- on the remote control ) until the desired preset station is displayed

#### Tip:

Detailed playback features and additional functions are described in the accompanied owner's manual. Notes for the remote control:

- First, select the source you wish to control by pressing one of the source select keys on the remote control (iPod or AUX, for example).

- Then select the desired function.



# Playing a USB mass storage device

- Press **SOURCE** repeatedly (or **USB** on the remote) to enter USB mode. The LCD display shows USB.
- 2 Plug a compatible USB mass storage device to DC177's USB port marked . If needed, use a suitable USB cable to connect between the device and DC177's USB port. The device will automatically power on.

3 Press ►II to start playback.

4 Press to stop playback.

#### Tip:

Refer to the user manual supplied for the description about compatibility of USB mass storage device, and playability of the files stored on the USB device.
