What's in the Box?


You should find these items upon opening the box.

















Mounting stand onto the set


Put MCM277 on a flat and firm surface, rear side facing up

As shown, align the stand to the slots at set's bottom, ▼ FRONT facing


Push the stand down into the slots

Helpful hints:

 For wall mounting, please refer to the User Manual, Appendix: How to mount your MCM277 onto Walls. You may need assistance from the qualified service personnel.



Rear connections



Connect the cable of the left speaker to **LEFT** (red and black) and the cable of the right speaker to **RIGHT** (red and black)



Extend the wire antenna and fit it to FM ANTENNA

a. Assemble the loop antenna
b. Fit the plug of the loop antenna to **AM ANTENNA**



Connect the AC power cord to the wall socket

Step B Prepare

Setting the clock



Press and hold STANDBY-ON/ ECO POWER (1) to switch the set to Standby mode

- → The display shows the set time
- → -- --:-- flashes by default if you have not set the clock

In the standby mode, press and hold **DISPLAY/CLOCK** on the remote control

- → 24 HR or 12 HR appears for the initial clock setting. To select 12-hour clock or 24-hour clock.
 - a. Press VOL +/- once or more
 - b. Press DISPLAY/CLOCK to confirm
 - → The hours digits start flashing

Hold down or press **VOL +/-** repeatedly to set the hours

Press DISPLAY/CLOCK to confirm



Hold down or press **VOL +/-** repeatedly to set the minutes



Press DISPLAY/CLOCK to confirm

Helpful hints:

 To set the clock automatically by using a time signal which is broadcast together with the RDS signal, see the User Manual, RDS: Automatic clock setting via RDS.

Step C Enjoy

Playing discs

With this system, you can play all pre-recorded audio CDs (CDDA), all finalized audio CD-Rs and CD-RWs, MP3/WMA-CDs (CD-Rs/CD-RWs with MP3/WMA files)



Press **SOURCE** once or more to select **CD** (or **CD** on the remote control)



Press CD OPEN•CLOSE \triangle to open the CD compartment



Insert a disc with the printed side facing up. Press CD OPEN•CLOSE \triangle again to close the compartment



Press ▶ II to start playback



To stop playback, press **STOP**

IMPORTANT!

 Remove the protective plastic tab before using the remote control



Notes for remote control:

- First, select the source you wish to control by pressing one of the source select keys on the remote control (DISC orTUNER, for example).
- Then select the desired function
 (►II, I◄◄, ►►I for example).





Tuning to radio stations



Press **SOURCE** once or more to select **TUNER** (or **TUNER** on the remote control)

Press the \blacktriangle / \blacktriangledown buttons once or more until the desired preset station is displayed

Playing a USB mass storage device

With the Hi-Fi system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this Hi-Fi system).



Check you have unfolded the control panel



Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket on the set's foldable control panel

Press SOURCE once or more to select USB (or USB on the remote control)



Play the USB's audio files as you do with the albums/tracks on a CD

Press STANDBY-ON/ ECO POWER () to switch off the set
