

What's in the Box?


You should find these items upon opening the box.






Mounting the stand onto the set

Locate the bottom of the main unit and find the slot, then slide the stand in the slot until it stops, as indicated in the figure.



Rear connections



Connect the cable of the left speaker to **LEFT** (red and black) and the cable of the right speaker to **RIGHT** (red and black).

- To receive optimal radio reception, put the main unit and the antennas as far away as possible from the power adaptor.

Extend the wire antenna and fit it to **FM ANTENNA.**

Insert the MW antenna to **MW ANTENNA** jacks.

Connect the AC power cord to the wall socket.



Setting the clock

Press and hold **STANDBY-ON**/ **ECO POWER** \bigcirc to switch the set to Standby mode.

- → The display shows the set time.
- → -- --:-- -- flashes by default if you have not set the clock.

In the standby mode, press and hold **DISPLAY/CLOCK** on the remote control.

- → 24 HR or 12 HR appears for the initial clock setting. To select 12-hour clock or 24-hour clock,
 - 1. Press VOLUME +/- once or more.
 - 2. Press DISPLAY/CLOCK to confirm.
 - \rightarrow The hours digits start flashing.

Hold down or press **VOLUME +/-** repeatedly to set the hours.

Press DISPLAY/CLOCK to confirm.

Hold down or press VOLUME +/- repeatedly to set the minutes.

Press **DISPLAY/CLOCK** to confirm.

Helpful hints:

- To set the clock automatically by using a time signal which is broadcast together with the RDS signal, see the **User Manual**, **RDS: Setting the RDS clock.**



Playing discs

With this system, you can play all pre-recorded audio CDs (CDDA), all finalized audio CD-Rs and CD-RWs, MP3/WMA-CDs (CD-Rs/CD-RWs with MP3/WMA files)

Press SOURCE once or more to select CD (or CD on the remote control).

Press **DOOR OPEN** to open the CD compartment.



Insert a disc with the printed side facing up. Then close the CD door.



Press **II** to start playback.

To stop playback, press **STOP** .

IMPORTANT!

 Remove the protective plastic tab before using the remote control

Notes for remote control:

 First, select the source you wish to control by pressing one of the source select keys on the remote control (CD or TUNER, for example).

Then select the desired function
(▶II, I◄◄, ▶►I for example).



Tuning to radio stations

Press SOURCE once or more to select TUNER (or TUNER on the remote control).

Press and hold **PROGRAM** until **BUTD** appears

→ Available stations are programmed in order of waveband reception strenght: RDS, FM followed by MW.

Press the **ALBUM**/ **PRESET** buttons once or more until the desired preset station is displayed.

Playing a USB mass storage device

With the Hi-Fi system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this Hi-Fi system).

Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket +>+ on the front panel of the main set.

Press SOURCE once or more to select USB (or USB on the remote control)


Play the USB's audio files as you do with the albums/tracks on a CD

Press **STANDBY-ON**/ **ECO POWER** \oplus to switch off the set


