Install the car audio

These instructions are for a typical installation. However, if your car has different requirements, make the corresponding adjustment. If you have any question regarding installation list, consult your car's audio dealer.

Caution

- This unit is designed for negative ground (earth) 12 VDC operation only.
- Always install this unit in the car dashboard.
- Do not touch the car battery or the terminals of the unit heats up during use.
- To avoid short-circuit, before you connect, ensure that the ignition is off.
- Ensure that you connect the yellow and red wires to the car battery after all other wires are connected.
- Ensure that all loose leads are insulated with electrical tape.
- Ensure that the speaker wires are not connected to the car battery or the terminals of the unit heats up during use.
- Ensure that all ground (earth) leads are run to a common ground (earth) point.
- Use only the supplied mounting hardware for the unit.
- Improper fuse can cause damage or fire. When you need to change the fuse, consult a professional.

Note on the power supply lead (yellow)

- When you connect the power supply lead to the system, ensure that the rating of the car circuit is higher than the total fuse value of all the connected devices.

Note on speaker connection

- Never connect speaker wires to the metal body or chassis of the car.
- Never connect speaker wires with stripes to one another.

Connect wire

Caution

- Ensure that all loose leads are insulated with electrical tape.
- Check the wiring carefully, then do the other connections.

Mount in the dashboard

- Check wire connection before you mount the unit into a car.
- If the car has a fuse, disconnect the fuse when you connect the unit into the car.
- Reconnect the red lead, crosswire to the yellow ones.

- If the car does not have an on-board drive or fuse, connect the negative terminal of the car battery.
- If you disconnect this car battery in a car that has an on-board drive or navigation computer, the computer may lose its data.
- If the car battery is not disconnected, disconnect the car battery from the car. When you need to change the fuse, consult a professional.

- Slide the unit into the dashboard until a click sound is heard.
- Attach the trim plate.
- Connect the negative terminal of the car battery.

Set date and time

- Touch the upper left corner to display main menu.



- If necessary, touch in the middle right side of the screen to display the 2nd screen.

Touch [Setup]

Turn on

Caution

- Before you turn on the unit, adjust settings when you drive.

Touch [Time]

- The OSD language is changed to the selected language immediately.
- To turn off the unit, press [Off] for 3 seconds.

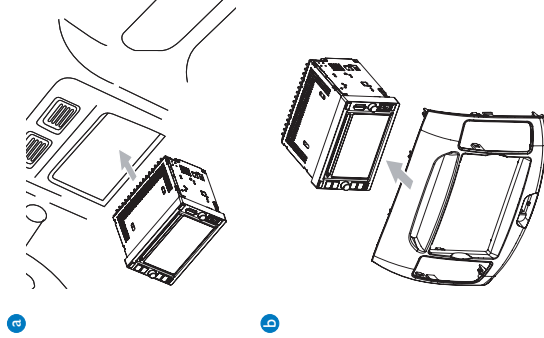
Set time

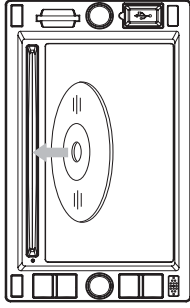
Tip

- When daytime is set, touch [Time] to return to main menu.

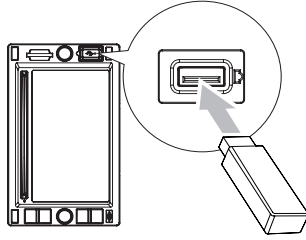

You can play DVD discs with the following region codes:

DVD region code	Country
1	China

- Insert the disc into the disc slot with label side facing up.
- Play starts automatically.
- When the disc is ejected, the unit switches to (Radio) mode.

- To remove the disc, press the [Eject] button.
- When the disc is ejected, the unit switches to (Radio) mode.
- To remove the disc, press the [Eject] button.

Play USB device

- Ensure that the device contains playable content.
- Open the USB door.
- Insert the USB device to the USB socket.
- Play starts automatically.

- To remove the USB device, switch to disc, radio, or other source first.

Play with Bluetooth device

- To connect your Bluetooth device to the unit, you need to pair the unit with the device. You can pair up to eight devices.

1 Search for Bluetooth device with the device.

Or touch [Call] to dial number directly, then touch [Call] to dial.

- Select "CDJ3280" in the pairing list.
- Enter default password "0000".
- If pairing succeeds, phone call record is displayed.



Make a call

- Pair the phone with the unit.
- Touch the upper left corner to display the home menu.
- Touch [Bluetooth]
- The Bluetooth menu is displayed.

- When conversation ends, touch [End] to terminate the call.
- Tip: You can select to receive calls manually by set [Auto answer] to [Off] status.

Adjust volume

- Turn [Volume] clockwise to increase volume.
- Turn [Volume] anti-clockwise to reduce volume.

Mute

- During play, press [Mute].
- To turn the sound back on, press [Mute] again.

Tip

- You can also turn off sound by touching [Mute] on the screen.

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
