

Connect power

- Connect the AC power adaptor to:
 - the DC socket on the main unit
 - the power socket.



2 Setup

Set time and date

- 1 In standby mode, press and hold SET TIME/ AUTO SCAN for 2 seconds
 - → [SYNC ON] is displayed and [ON] begins to blink.
- Press PRESET + ▲/PRESET ▼ to select ON or OFF
 - → If you select [ON], the unit reads the DAB or iPhone/iPod time and sets the clock automatically.
 - → If you select [OFF], the unit turns off the time synchronization.
- 3 Press SET TIME/AUTO SCAN to confirm The time format [24H] or [12H] begins to blink
- 4 Press PRESET + ▲/PRESET ▼ to select 24H or 12H
- 5 Press SET TIME/AUTO SCAN to confirm The hour digits begin to blink.
- 6 Repeat steps 4-5 to set the hour, minute, year, month, and day.

B Set the alarm timer

You can set two alarms which go off at different time

- Ensure that you have set the clock correctly.
- Press and hold AL1 or AL2 for 2 seconds.
 - → The [AL1] or [AL2] icon and the hour digits begin to blink.
- 3 Press TUNING I /TUNING + I to set the hour
- 4 Press AL1 or AL2 to confirm.
 - → The [AL1] or [AL2] icon and the minute digits begin to blink.
- 5 Repeat steps 3-4 to set the minute.
- 6 Repeat steps 3-4 to select whether to ring alarm the whole week, on weekdays, or at weekend.
- 7 Repeat steps 3-4 to select an alarm sound source: Buzzer, iPhone, FM, or DAB.
- 8 Repeat steps 3-4 to set the alarm volume.

2 Setup





- 1 Press AI 1/AI 2 to turn on or off the alarm timer
 - → If the alarm timer is turned on the alarm icon appears.
 - → If the alarm timer is turned off, the alarm icon disappears.

D Repeat alarm


- When the alarm rings, press REP AL/BRIGHTNESS.
 - → The alarm repeats ringing minutes later.

E View the alarm settings


1 Press Al 1 or Al 2



1 Lift up the iPhone/iPod dock cover on the top panel.



Place the iPhone/iPod into the dock.





- **3** Press **iPhone/iPod** on the remote control to select iPod/iPhone source.
 - The connected iPod/iPhone plays automatically.
 - To pause/resume play, press OK/► ■.
 - To skip to a track, press TUNING
 I◀/TUNING + ►I on the remote control.
 - To search during play, press and hold TUNING - I◄/TUNING + ►I, then release to resume normal play.
 - To go back to the previous iPod/ iPhone menu, press MENU. To scroll through the menu, press PRESET + ▲/PRESET - ▼. To confirm a selection, press OK/▶II.
 - If no key is pressed for more than 10 seconds, OK/▶ acts back as the play/pause key.

B Program and listen to radio stations

- In the tuner mode, press and hold SET TIME/AUTO SCAN for more than 2 seconds to activate automatic program mode.
 - → The unit starts to search for radio stations.
 - All available stations are programmed in the order of waveband reception strength.
 - → The first programmed radio station is broadcast automatically.
- 2 Press PRESET + ▲/PRESET ▼ to select a preset number.
