


Power adaptor User Manual Quick Start Guide

1 Connect

A Connect power

Connect the AC power adaptor to:the DC socket on the main unit

• the power socket.





2 Setup

A Set time and date

- 1 In standby mode, press and hold SET TIME/ AUTO SCAN for 2 seconds.
- → [SYNC ON] is displayed and [ON] begins to blink.
- 2 Press PRESET + ▲/PRESET ▼ to select ON or OFF.
 - → If you select [ON], the unit reads the DAB+ or iPod/iPhone time and sets the clock automatically.
 - If you select [OFF], the unit turns off the time synchronization.
- **3** Press **SET TIME/AUTO SCAN** to confirm. The time format [24H] or [12H] begins to blink.
- 4 Press PRESET + ▲/PRESET ▼ to select 24H or 12H.
- 5 Press SET TIME/AUTO SCAN to confirm. The hour digits begin to blink.
- 6 Repeat steps 4-5 to set the hour, minute, year, month, and day.

B Set the alarm timer

You can set two alarms which go off at different time.

- 1 Ensure that you have set the clock correctly.
- Press and hold AL1 or AL2 for 2 seconds.
 → The [AL1] or [AL2] icon and the hour digits begin to blink.
- 3 Press TUNING I◄/TUNING + ► to set the hour.

4 Press AL1 or AL2 to confirm.
 → The [AL1] or [AL2] icon and the minute digits begin to blink.

- 5 Repeat steps 3-4 to set the minute.
- 6 Repeat steps 3-4 to select whether to ring alarm the whole week, on weekdays, or at weekend.
- 7 Repeat steps 3-4 to select an alarm sound source: Buzzer, iPhone, FM, or DAB+.
- 8 Repeat steps 3-4 to set the alarm volume.

2 Setup

C Turn on/off the alarm timer

- 1 Press AL1/AL2 to turn on or off the alarm timer.
 - → If the alarm timer is turned on, the alarm icon appears.
- → If the alarm timer is turned off, the alarm icon disappears.

D Repeat alarm

 When the alarm rings, press REP AL/BRIGHTNESS.
 → The alarm repeats ringing minutes later.



1 Press AL1 or AL2.

A Play from iPod/iPhone

3 Enjoy

1 Lift up the iPod/iPhone dock cover on the top panel.



2 Place the iPod/iPhone into the dock.



3 Enjoy

- 3 Press iPod/iPhone on the remote control to select iPod/iPhone source.
 - → The connected iPod/iPhone plays automatically.
 - To pause/resume play, press OK/▶■.
 - To skip to a track, press TUNING
 I◀/TUNING + ►I on the remote control.
 - To search during play, press and hold TUNING - I◄/TUNING + ▶ I, then release to resume normal play.

 - tion, press OK/> II.
 - If no key is pressed for more than 10 seconds, OK/▶ acts back as the play/pause key.

B Program and listen to radio stations

- 1 In the tuner mode, press and hold SET TIME/AUTO SCAN for more than 2 seconds to activate automatic program mode.
 - → The unit starts to search for radio stations.
 - → All available stations are programmed in the order of waveband reception strength.
 - → The first programmed radio station is broadcast automatically.
- 2 Press **PRESET** + ▲/**PRESET** ▼ to select a preset number.
