
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
Connect the FM and MW antennas.

Connect the composite video cable to a TV.


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Connect the power cords of the system and TV.






(A) To listen to the sound of this DVD Player through your TV, use the audio cables (white/ red-not supplied) to connect LINE OUT (L/R) jacks of the DVD Player to the corresponding AUDIO IN jacks on the TV.



B To listen to the sound of your TV through this DVD player, use a cinch cable (not supplied) to connect AUX-IN on the front panel of the DVD player to the corresponding AUDIO OUT jacks on the TV.






Setting the clock

Important!

- To set clock in the Eco Power mode, press and hold ECO POWER/STANDBY ON on the set for 3 seconds
- or more to switch to normal standby mode first before proceeding with the procedures below.



When the hour digits flash, turn the **VOLUME** -/+ control on the front panel or press **VOL** +/- on the remote to set the hours.

Press CLOCK again and the minute digits flash. Then turn the VOLUME -/+ control on the front panel or press VOL +/- on the remote to set the minutes.

Press **CLOCK** again to confirm the time setting.

Before using the remote control

- 1 Pull out the plastic protective sheet.
- 2 Select the source you wish to control by pressing one of the source
- select keys on the remote control (for example CD, TUNER).
- 3 Then select the desired function (for example ► II, ◄, ►►)



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

Playing a disc

Press **OPEN**•**CLOSE** \triangleq to open the disc tray and load in a disc, then press the same button again to close the disc tray.

→ Make sure the label side of the disc is facing up.

Playback will start automatically. If not press > 11.

Playing a USB mass storage device

With the Hi-Fi system, you can use USB flash memory (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), USB flash players (USB 2.0 or USB1.1), memory cards (requires an additional card reader to work with this Hi-Fi system).

Insert the USB device's USB plug into the socket • con the front panel of the main set.
