

It easily adds Bluetooth® support to any audio system so you can stream music wirelessly from all your smart devices. Setting them up could not be simpler, just connect it to your system, pair with a smart device and you are ready to stream your music, online radio stations and even online music-on-demand services. It also allows you to pair up to three Bluetooth®-enabled smart devices at the same time, and swap between them in an instant. Listen to whatever you want, using whatever device you want, whenever you want.



Do you know?

The name "Bluetooth" comes from the 10th century Danish King Harald Blåtand or Harold Bluetooth in English. King Blåtand helped unite warring factions in parts of what are now Norway, Sweden and Denmark. Similarly, Bluetooth® technology was created as an open standard to allow connectivity and collaboration between disparate products and industries.

Swap music playback between 3 devices with MULTIPAIR

Pair up to 3 smart devices so you can stream music from whichever device you want, without the hassle of un-pairing and re-pairing. To play a song on a different device, just pick it and hit play. The song on the original device will stop and your new song will take over, perfect for sharing music with friends, parties, or just playing different songs stored on different devices. Let friends and family pair at the same time, so you can swap between each other's music in a flash.





Wireless music never sounded this good

Standard *Bluetooth*® audio uses an SBC codec that is built for basic audio transmission, causing fine details and atmospherics of music to be lost. The AEA2700, however, is armed with *Bluetooth*® aptX® and AAC advanced audio coding algorithms – giving you rich, powerful and crystal clear sound.



Works with nearly all Hi-Fi systems & speakers

Connect the AEA2700 to any standard Hi-Fi or sound system with an analogue RCA or 3.5mm jack. Or connect to high-end audio and home cinema systems using digital coaxial and optical audio outputs.



One touch NFC pairing

Pairing a *Bluetooth*® device used to be a hassle. You had to go into "System settings" on your phone, search for the right device, input a password and confirm it. With NFC, all you need to do is tap an NFC-enabled smartphone or tablet on the NFC area of the adapter for instant pairing. Then, simply start your music.
