What's in the box




*The black line cord is a 4-pin telephone line cord, and the gray line cord is a 2-pin telephone line cord. Use these as explained in 1 Connect.

In multihandset packs, you will find one or more additional handsets, battery doors, chargers with power supply units and additional rechargeable batteries.

WARNING: Always use the line cord, power supply and batteries that came with your phone.



 Place the base station in a central location near the telephone line socket and electricity socket.




Connect the line cord(s) and the power cable to their corresponding connectors at the back of the base station.

🖨 Note

For 2 line subscriptions, connect the 4-pin telephone line cord (with black cord) to the black TEL LINE 1/2 phone jack and to the telephone wall jack for line 1. Connect the second telephone line cord (with gray cord) to the gray TEL LINE 2 phone jack and to the telephone wall jack for line 2.

If the two phone lines are on one modular wall jack, connect only the 4-pin telephone line cord (with black cord) to the black TEL LINE I/2 phone jack and to the telephone wall jack. (Do not connect anything to the gray TEL LINE 2 phone jack.)

Connect the other end of the line cord(s) and power cable to their respective sockets.





Make a call

Enter the number (maximum 24 digits) and then press $\overline{\mathbb{A}}$. The default line is highlighted. If you want to switch to the other line, scroll . Press $\overline{\mathbb{A}}$ or $\overbrace{}$ Select to call on the highlighted line.

OR

Pick up the handset and press k, and then dial the number to call on the	
(To call on the other line, press 🔽 Line I or 🔽 Line 2 before dialing.))

Answer a call

When the phone rings, \square or \square indicate the incoming call line. To answer, press the appropriate soft key (\bigcirc Line 1 or \bigcirc Line 2).

End a call

To end a conversation, press 2000.

Adjust earpiece volume

During a call, scroll $\textcircled{}{}$ to select from level 1 to level 5.

Setting the ring tones

Follow the procedure below to set ring tones on the handset or base station.

- 1. Press men in idle mode, scroll 🛞 to Personal Set, and press 🏹 Select.
- 2. Scroll (to Handset Tones on the handset or Base Tones on the base and press Select. Then scroll (to Ring Tones and press) Select.
- 3. Scroll (a) to select Line I or Line 2 and press 7 Select.
- 4. Scroll 💮 to your desired melody. The melodies will play as you scroll them.
- 5. Press Select to set the ring tone.
- A validation tone is emitted and the screen returns to the previous menu.

Refer to the key chart in Chapter 6 "Conventions Used in this Manual" of the User Manual for base station keys that correspond to the handset keys appearing in the procedure above. Store a contact in the phonebook

- I. Press menu. Phonebook is highlighted; press 7 Select.
- 2. New Entry is highlighted; press 7 Select.
- 3. Enter Name is displayed. Enter the name of the contact (maximum 14 characters) and press 7 OK.
- 4. Enter Number is displayed. Enter the number (maximum 24 digits) and press COK.
 - A validation tone is emitted

Access phonebook

- I. Press $\stackrel{\text{Ph.Book}}{\blacksquare}$ and scroll $\stackrel{\textcircled{}}{\textcircled{}}$ to browse the phonebook.
- 2. To view the details, press 7 View.

Call from the phonebook

- Press ^{Ph.Book} in idle mode.
 Scroll () to a phonebook entry.
- 3 Press twice
 - The call is initiated from the default line.

Listen to messages recorded on the answering machine

Press $\left(\frac{2\pi}{d}\right)$ to turn on the answering machine. (The 💋 icon is turned off.) The outgoing message is played.

Press (play/stop) to play phone messages (the first recorded message will be played first).

Press - Skip to skip the current message and play the next message.

Press - Prev. to go back to the previous message (if pressed within I second of current message playback).

Press - Prev. to replay current message (if pressed after I second of current message playback).

Press - or + to adjust speaker volume during message playback.

Press (erase) to delete the current message.

Long press (erase) to delete all old messages.

Press $(\frac{2}{3})$ to turn off the answering machine. (The 💋 icon is turned on.)

Problem

· There's no dialling tone!

Solution

- No power: Check the connections.
- · Batteries are empty: Charge the batteries.
- · Move closer to the base station.
- · Wrong line cord used: Use the line cord provided.
- Caller does not hear me clearly!

· Searching... is displayed

- · Move closer to the base station.
- Move the base station at least one metre (yard) away from any electronic appliances.
- · Move closer to the base station.
- · Make sure that your base station is on.
- · Reset your unit and restart handset registration.
- Caller number is not displayed!
