





- 1 LED indicator

 - Transfer the call to your mobile device.
- (3) DC IN
 - Recharge the built-in battery with a USB cable.
- (4) AUDIO IN
 - Connect an external audio device.
- (5) OFF/AUDIO IN/ 0
 - Select Bluetooth or AUDIO IN source.
 - Turn the speaker off.

Attach the string

For easy carrying, attach the supplied string to this speaker as illustrated.



Charge the built-in battery

The speaker is powered by a built-in rechargeable battery.




Vote

- · Before use, fully charge the built-in battery.
- · The micro USB socket is for charging only.
- Rechargeable battery has a limited number of charge cycles. Battery life and number of charge cycles vary by use and settings.

Connect the supplied USB cable between

- the DC IN socket on the speaker, and
- a USB socket of a computer.

Turn on/off

- To turn the speaker on, slide the OFF/AUDIO IN/ 8 switch to 9 or AUDIO IN
 - **9**: Listen to an external Bluetooth device through Bluetooth connection.
 - AUDIO IN: Listen to an external device through an audio input cable.
- To turn the speaker off, slide the switch to OFF.

Use Bluetooth devices

With this speaker, you can listen to audio from Bluetooth-enabled devices and control the incoming call through Bluetooth.

Play from Bluetooth devices



Note

- Make sure that your Bluetooth device is compatible with this speaker.
- Before pairing a device with this speaker, read its user manual for Bluetooth compatibility.
- The speaker can memorize a maximum of 4 paired devices.
- Make sure that Bluetooth function is enabled on your device, and your device is set as visible to all other Bluetooth devices.
- Any obstacle between this speaker and a Bluetooth device can reduce the operational range.
- Keep away from any other electronic device that may cause interference.
- The operational range between this speaker and a Bluetooth device is approximately 10 meters (30 feet).
- If there is an incoming call on the connected mobile phone, music playback pauses.
- - On your Bluetooth device, enable Bluetooth and search for Bluetooth devices that can be paired (refer to the user
- manual of the device).

 When [Philips BT1300] is displayed on your device, select it to start pairing and connection. If necessary, input "0000" as

the pairing password.

→ After successful pairing and connection, the speaker beeps twice, and the LED indicator turns solid blue

- 4 Play audio on the Bluetooth device.
 - → Audio streams from your Bluetooth device to the speaker.

To disconnect the Bluetooth-enabled device:

- Press and hold () for two seconds when it is not during a call;
- Disable Bluetooth on your device; or
- Move the device beyond the communication range.
 - → The LFD indicator flashes blue

To reconnect the Bluetooth device:

- Next time you turn on the speaker, the speaker will reconnect the last connected device automatically; or
- On your Bluetooth device, select "Philips BT1300" on your Bluetooth menu to start pairing.

To connect another Bluetooth-enabled device:

- 1 When it is not during a call, press and hold 6 for two seconds to disconnect the currently connected device;
 - → The speaker enters Bluetooth pairing mode.
- 2 Connect another Bluetooth device.



 - the headphone socket on the external device.



- 2 Slide the OFF /AUDIO IN/ 8 switch to AUDIO IN.
 - → The LED indicator becomes white.
- 3 Play audio on the external device (refer to its user manual).

Adjust volume

During play, use the volume control on your Bluetooth or external device to adjust volume.


