

What's in the box




The line adaptor may not be attached to the line cord. You may find the line adaptor in the box. In this case, you have to connect the line adaptor to the line cord first before plugging the line cord to the line socket.

In multihandset packs, you will find one or more additional handsets, chargers with power supply units and additional rechargeable batteries.


WARNING Always use the cables and batteries that are supplied with your phone.

Connect the base station

- I. Insert the plug of the power cord into the socket under the base station
- 2. Insert the plug of the line cord into the socket under the base station
- Connect the other end of the line cord together with the line adaptor if necessary, to the telephone line socket and the other end of the power cable to the electricity socket









Configure your phone

- 1. Press $(\)$ and the available country code blinks.
- 2. Press () repeatedly to scroll to your desired country code. (See Country setting table)
- 3. Press (*) and your phone is configured according to your selected country code.



Make a call

Press S and dial the number OR Dial the number and press Answer a call

When the phone rings, press 🕑 .

Listen to new messages recorded on answering machine (applicable to CD145 only) $% \left(\mathcal{L}^{2}\right) =\left(\mathcal{L}^{2}\right) \left(\mathcal{L}^{2}\right) \left$

Press () on the base station to turn on the answering machine, the LED is turned on Press () again to turn off the answering machine, the LED is turned off

Press on the base station, playback of the oldest new message will begin

Press () to skip the current message and play the next message

Press 💌 to go back to previous message if it is pressed within one second of current message playback

Press () to replay current message if it is pressed after one second of current message playback

Press 🛨 to increase or 🗕 to decrease speaker volume during message playback

Press \mathbf{x} to delete the current message

Set the earpiece volume

- I. Press (*)
- 2. Press $\left(\frac{4}{r}\right)$ and the current earpiece volume level settings is displayed
- 3. Press (In) (Iow), (2) (medium) or (3) (high) to select your desired earpiece volume level
- 4. Press (*) to save the settings

Set the ring melody

- I. Press (*)
- 2. Press (5) and the current ring melody is played
- 3. Press one of the digit keys (•) through (?) to select your desired ring melody
- 4. Press $(\mbox{\ensuremath{\$}})$ to save the settings

Store a number in the phonebook

- I. Press (*)
- 2. Press (m) and memory number 0 is shown
- 3. Press (m) repeatedly to select another memory number from 0 through 19
- 4. Enter the phone number. If you enter the number wrongly, press () to erase a digit
- 5. Press (*) to save the number

Problem

No dialing tone

Poor audio guality

Solution

- · Check the connections
- · Charge the batteries for at least 24 hours
- · Use the line cable provided
- Move closer to the base station
- Move the base station at least one metre away from any electrical appliances
- · Register the handset to the base station
- Move closer to the base station
- Try again by disconnecting and connecting the base station power supply and follow the procedure to register a handset
- Make sure the two supplied rechargeable batteries have been inserted into the battery compartment
- Make sure the supplied batteries are charged up
- Check your subscription with your network operator

- The \blacksquare icon is blinking
- The handset LCD displays nothing
